# Editor's Comment

IT is tempting to fall back on all the old jokes beloved of newspaper headline writers when tackling the subject of public toilets in Lymm.

But in fact it is a serious subject, for the viability of a shopping centre can be seriously affected by the absence of public conveniences. Some people of a certain age may hesitate to visit such a shopping centre and Lymm can ill afford to lose even a small proportion of the people who currently shop here.

Those with long memories will know that Lymm has had toilet troubles in the past. In the early Eighties, the village centre toilets were, quite literally, washed away by floodwater from the Dam.

It took some 15 years of campaigning before they were replaced by the present facilities, which were hailed as "superloos"

when they were introduced in 1996. Shopkeepers were among 1996. Shopkeepers were among the most vociferous campaigners, so clearly they believed trade was being hit. At one stage, they threatened to withhold their rates. Few would argue that the "superloos" are ideal, but they are better than nothing and if, as we report elsewhere in this issue, their thurs is in doubt serious thought

future is in doubt, serious thought needs to be given to some form of alternative provision.

In Stockton Heath, a similar problem has been, to some extent, solved by persuading some pubs, restaurants and other premises to allow the public use of their toilets. Such a solution is bound to be suggested for Lymm. But would it be right for the borough council to, in effect, say to traders: "We can't afford to maintain public toilets -



you do if for nothing"?
Some types of business might benefit from the increased footfall an "open" toilet would bring, but whether there are enough of them in Lymm, and whether they are in the right locations, is far from certain.

Careful thought needs to be given to the problem because if the right solution is not found it could be highly "inconvenient". There – I resisted it until the last

### What is Financial Risk?

According to research recently carried out in the UK, the public has a fairly basic understanding about the risks of saving and investing. This research was done by Prof Sharon Collard at the Open University Business School and the full report can be viewed following the link below:

### The risk of 'reckless conservatism'?

This is covered on page 3 of the above report, and goes on to state "while taking little or no financial risks with their money may be absolutely the right thing for some consumers", academics and industry commentators point to the risk of reckless conservatism – the reluctance of many people to take investment risk which in turn may jeopardise their longer-term objectives (like retirement planning).

What I found particularly disturbing in this report was that 52% of people interviewed said they would prefer to miss their savings goals than take investment risk. Quite profound really, as if you could imagine how people would react if they were to miss their flight — we have seen tantrums many times on TV in airport programs, and yet, the worst case scenario is that you arrive a day or so later and possibly a few hundred pounds lighter. But if you miss your savings goal on your retirement planning for example, then this could have a **catastrophic effect** on the rest of your life. Think about what it would be like to not have enough money in your retirement years, and how miserable it is likely to make you feel not being able to afford the things you could afford, whilst you were working. Yet over half of the people in this report say they would put up with

that, and refuse to take investment risk.

So, what is making these people think this way? I personally think that it is down to people not having a true understanding and meaning of investment risk, or as I sometimes describe it volatility. To a lot of people, according to this report they don't know the difference between a cautious and a balanced portfolio. And to be fair how many people would. But consider this, our own aggressive portfolio here at Simple Solutions, which is virtually all invested in shares, has 12 different investment funds within its portfolio. Inside each of these investment funds, you have 12 different fund manager's possibly investing in around 70 different companies all over the world. So in total over 840 different global companies. So for the portfolio to lose all of its money, then simply all of these 840 companies would have to go bust. It is possible, but probably highly unlikely. If we looked at a cautious portfolio only around 40% is invested in shares with the remainder investing in safer assets, so less risk is taken with the funds and fund manager

Lymm Cruising Club which is celebrating its own 60th anniversary hosted the event.



# Village gets on board for Historic Transport Day

WHEN organisers sat down to plan this year's Transport Day they realised they need have no concerns about attracting exciting exhibits for 2015.

Such was the success of last year's event that the whole show was booked out before the end of February with plenty of new features lined up including a large display of Traction Engines in the market car park.

The major challenge was to manage the logistics of an event that now involves 10 venues and thousands of people spread over a wide area.

By the time the team had mapped it all out they realised that they would need 150 volunteers on the day – a seemingly impossible target- especially on a day when many local groups like churches and the community centre are already involved in their own fundraising as part of the event

### High school roof repairs approved

PLANNING chiefs have given the go-ahead for proposals to recover flat roofs at Lymm High School which have deteriorated over the years.

Members of Warrington's planning committee approved the scheme which involves recovering the roofs with a built-up telt system, including insulation and renewal of rainwater goods in powdered coated aluminium and facing concrete fascias with a fibre-cement board.

The committee also granted Listed Building consent as part of the school comprises the former Oughtrington Hall, a Grade 2 listed building dating from around 1830. Although the listed building is now surrounded by modern buildings and car parks, the listed structure can still be seen among the flat roofed, utilitarian school buildings, the committee was told,

The work will involve an increase in the height of the roof by about 130mm but, planning officers said, minimal impact on the listed building provided the work was carried out sensitively and with traditional materials.

Landmark tree is set to get the chop

ONE of the three landmark planetrees which adorn the cobbled area around Lymm Cross is set to get the chop – and some residents are not happy about it.

set to get the chop – and some residents are not happy about it.

The tree's root system is said to be causing a trip hazard – and could potentially cause damage to the foundations of the nearby chemists' shop.

Lymm Parish Council has been debating the matter for about 12 months and has finally decided the tree must go – and be replaced with another.

They consulted the Lymm in Bloom group, the borough council and others – although, apparently, not enough others. For the final decision – that the tree be replaced by a hornbeam – has not gone down well with some residents.

One has gone so far as to attach a notice on the tree describing the hornbeam as a "lollipop" tree unsuitable for the location and alleging there had been insufficient consultation on the issue.

consultation on the issue.

They suggested a flowering cherry or a mountain ash – trees with small root balls and a similar shape to the existing trees.

Another resident contacted Lymm Life claiming a lack of consultation with the public and expressing fears that the other two planetrees at The Cross could be at risk.

They also argued that the existing tree could be retained without affecting the shop foundations, or causing a trip hazard, if its roots were pruned.

Cllr Sheila Woodyatt said the parish council had consulted widely on the issue before deciding on a hornbeam. The borough council arboriculturist had recommended a yew tree but the parish council was sticking to its original position.

"I have only heard of two people who oppose a hornbeam," she said.

Cllr Bob Barr said: "Unfortunately the tree has to go.

It would seem that many years ago, when they were planted, insufficient thought was given to how large they

### Is the writing on the wall for the "superloos"?

THE writing could be on the wall for Lymm's public toilets – which were hailed as "superloos" when they were installed nearly 20 years ago.

Borough council chiefs are consulting local councillors about the future of the automated toilets on the

Pepper Street car park and at Lymm Dam after revealing that the cost of "spending a penny" has risen to tens

if not hundreds of pounds per visit.

Clir Bob Barr, who has been consulted as a ward councillor, said: 'The cost of spending a penny has

The problem facing the borough is that if the toilets – which cost about \$20,000-a-year to rent – are closed, there will be no public facility in the

One solution might be to ask local pubs and restaurants to make their toilets available to the public, or even the village hall, church halls or Lymm Youth and Community Association. A similar scheme is operating successfully at Stockton Heath.
Cllr Barr said: "We need to have a

public discussion about this. We have

to try and find a way of pleasing everyone - and that won't be easy.

The history of public conveniences in Lymm goes back many years. In the early 1980s toilets near the Lower Dam – in what is now the sunken garden – were washed away by a flash flood.

For some 15 years, the village had no facility other than a temporary toilet on the Pepper Street car park – a facility residents regarded as an eyesore.

The present "superloos" were installed in 1996 – but only after local traders threatened to refuse to pay their rates. Even when installed, the new, automated toilets were condemned by nearby residents who claimed they looked like Dr Who's Tardis and demanded they be screened by bushes.

Now they are under threat on cost grounds. They are not used enough to justify the high rental costs Cllr Barr added: "Apparently

the cost of each visit is tens, if not hundreds of pounds."






