Editor's Comment

THE Boundary Commission's proposals for Lymm have caused a few raised eyebrows locally – and this is hardly surprising.

Splitting the parish in two, with the northern part taking in most of Thelwall and part of Grappenhall is a radical proposal and, quite frankly, seems to make little sense.

It takes no account of local communities and would result in the village being served by two parish councils. There would be five borough councillors with an interest in Lymm

councillors with an interest in Lymm instead of three as at present.

The Boundary Commission is an independent body set up by Parliament and consists of six members and a chief executive with a fair scattering of professors, doctors, knights of the realm and people with the interest of the second professors. letters to their name among them. So far we can ascertain, none have any local knowledge.

Their recommendations seek to

achieve electoral fairness, based on the average number of electors per councillor across the whole borough. Thus, they are concerned with the mathematics rather than local communities, geographical boundaries, etc., although they do claim to take these matters into account.

Party politics are not supposed to enter into the equation although there will always be the suspicion that they could. But in this case, it appears that all our local politicians are of a similar view. None of them like the proposals!

The Commission says it is satisfied it has achieved good levels of electoral fairness across Warrington, with none of the proposed wards having an electoral variance of greater than

10 per cent from the average for the

This may be so, but as far as Lymm is concerned – and probably Thelwall as well – there have been no suggestions of unfairness anyway. Everyone seems happy with the way things are.

the Fortunately Commission's proposals are not set in concrete. Anyone who wants to make representations can do so provided they do so before October 19. We

suggest they do just that.

Cotebrook House facing closure threat

ONE of the oldest and best-loved care homes in Cheshire – Lymm's Cotebrook House - is facing the possibility of closure because of a funding crisis.

Members of the management committee at the Oughtrington Lane home are desperately trying to find ways of keeping the home open for

its 30 residents.

Some of the residents have lived there for more than 50 years and, in the event of closure, would have

to move elsewhere.

Chairman of the management symmittee Ann Scales said: "There committee Ann Scales said: is really nothing we can say at the moment, except that we are exploring a number of options to keep Cotebrook House open. No

decisions have been made.

"The welfare of the residents is paramount. They must come first."

Cotebrook House, formerly the country home of the Dewhurst family, became a home for physically disabled adults in 1946.

It stands in attractive, wooded grounds with accessible pathways to enable wheelchair users and others to use a purpose built summer house and other facilities. All residential accommodation is on the ground floor. It is understood the home has run

at a loss for the last two years. If it is forced to close and the building is sold, the proceeds must go to

A number of suggestions have been put forward, including sale by auction, sale to a private healthcare company on the understanding the residents would stay there,

or a "take over" by Warrington Borough Council.

Many of the highly trained staff have worked at Cotebrook for

One said: "A meeting has been held with regard to redundancies, but not one member of staff is interested in the package due to them. The future welfare of the residents is all they are concerned about."

It is understood the home is 72.3 per cent full, but needs to be 93 per cent full to cover costs.

Although no decision has yet been taken, Social Services chiefs at Warrington have been assessing the situation and, in the event of a closure, are trying to ensure that residents who are friends could be kept together.

Ann McCormack, assistant director for quality assurance at Warrington Borough Council, Warrington Borough Council, said: "The council is working with the Cotebrook committee regarding their proposals for a planned closure but as yet no decision has been made.

"We appreciate that this can

be an unsettling time and we are working closely with staff, residents, and relevant authorities and will be keeping all interested parties updated. I want to reassure the residents of Cotebrook, their families and friends, that their welfare and wellbeing remains our number one priority at this time."



School celebrates opening of new £30k wildlife centre

YOUNGSTERS at Statham Primary School in Lymm are returning to nature this term when a brand new wildlife activity centre is put to use for the first time.

Pupils from all year groups will benefit from the purpose-built, outdoor teaching space, which is set within the grounds of the school.

It includes a 42m sq environmentally-sustainable cabin, with running water and electricity as well as an outdoor story-telling circle, set under a timber canopy area next to the school's pond. The centre will extend the school's commitment to pupils' learning about the wildlife and the natural environment.

Statham youngsters already

take part in weekly Forest School sessions, held in woodland at the rear of the site. A gardening club also runs on Tuesdays - the school entered its own display into 'Lymm in Bloom' this year.

The £30,000 activity centre was paid for by PTA fundraising, along with funding from a lottery grant. Work was completed in July 2015 ready for the new 2015/16 school year.

Jane Rooney, co-head teacher at Statham Primary said: "The wildlife activity centre has been designed to help our pupils further explore the natural world around them and

learn more about the environment.
"It's been a dream for a long time and we've been planning its design for over two years. Now that dream is a reality.

"We feel it's a fantastic use of the outdoor space that the school has. The children will gain so much from it. It will add a new dimension to their outdoor studies. The teaching staff can't wait to start using it this autumn term."

Lymm to be split in two - and 'take over' Thelwall

LYMM would be split in two under proposals put forward by the Local Government Boundary Commission – and would "take over" most of Thelwall and part of Grappenhall.

A new Lymm North and Thelwall ward would consist of the northern half of Lymm, most of Thelwall and part of Grappenhall.

The ward's northern boundary would be the Manchester Ship Canal, while its western boundary would follow Cross Lane before turning south along Knutsford Road turning south along Knutsford Road and joining Massey Brook.

This ward would have three councillors on Warrington Borough

Council.

But the proposals are being opposed by Lymm councillors and contradict proposals for minimal change put forward by Warrington Borough Council with cross party

support. Under Commission's proposals, Lymm South would consist of the southern half of Lymm,

with the northern boundary of this ward being the Bridgewater Canal. To the west, the boundary would be Massey Brook. This ward would be represented by two councillors.

The Boundary Commission is an independent body, set up by the Government. It is carrying out an electoral review of Warrington Borough Council because the council currently has high levels of electorial inequality, with some councillors representing many more

or many fewer voters than others.

This means the value of each vote in the borough council elections varies, depending where the voter

Overall, 41 per cent of wards across the borough have a variance of more than 10 per cent from the average – the maximum recommended variance.

The Boundary Commission says it has an open mind and wants to hear alternative suggestions from

the public by October 19.

Council "Warrington forward a proposal for minimal change. This was the right thing to do because there is huge uncertainty over housing numbers in the Commission's base year of 2021. Any major revision should be delayed until we have more clarity on housing numbers. "The borough ward proposals

affect parish councils too and cause unnecessary complications between borough and parish representation.

Cllr Ian Marks former leader of the borough council and a long term parish councillor at Lymm, added, The Commission has three criteria for setting boundaries – electoral equality, community identity and effective and convenient local government. We cannot deny that their proposals improve electoral and its but they for it missing the set of the control of the cont equality but they fail miserably on the other two. Lymm is a distinct community with its own identity and lumping it in with Thelwall makes no sense at all.
"Common sense has gone out the

window because it is much better if

borough and parish councillors are representing the same areas.

Community interests identities are surely more important than arithmetic equality based on an exercise done by people using maps and population numbers but no real local knowledge."

Cllr Sheila Woodyatt said: "To take a chunk of Thelwall and add it to Lymm is nothing short of criminal. Lymm has been a separate, distinct community since Roman times.

"I have been a councillor for 36 years and have dealt with 41,056 issues - and nobody has every complained about being underrepresented.

"Boundaries should respect local communities, not the mathematical calculations of someone in an ivory tower in Westminster."




