

Two thirds of foreigners choose UK holiday destinations based on film locations

New research conducted by a UK holiday company has revealed that more than half of foreign tourists visit London because of the magical flick, Harry Potter. Furthermore it was found that 67% stated filming locations effect where they go on holiday.

A new survey has revealed the most popular destinations in the UK for foreigners from different countries to visit with two thirds of them choosing where they go based on film and television locations.

The team at www.BlueChipHolidays.co.uk polled a total of 2,345 individuals from countries outside of the UK for the purpose of their research, carried out to find which destinations in the UK were the most popular for those living abroad and why. Each individual polled was aged 18 or over and had been on a holiday to the UK within the past 2 years. Those polled were also spread out across multiple different countries and continents to get a more detailed grasp on UK holiday preferences.

Participants were first asked which UK holiday destination was their favourite to visit, below are the top five most desirable locations given in order:

- 1. London-28%
- 2. Cornwall -22%
- 3. Lake District 11%
- 4. Edinburgh 7%
- 5. Wiltshire 4%

Researchers then wanted to find out if the nationality of the respondents impacted where their favourite locations in the UK are. They discovered that of the 321 Germans polled, over a third (34%) said Scotland was their favourite place

to visit in Great Britain. Americans on the other hand preferred to visit the London with 67% of them stating this was their favourite location and the French seemed to prefer Cornwall with 49% taking a preference towards the county.

Respondents were then asked how they decided where they wanted to visit in the UK, and were allowed to supply more than one answer if relevant; the following were the most popular responses:

- The location was featured in a movie/television series I watch – 67%
- 2. Beautiful scenery impacted my decision 58%
- 3. I like there to be a lot of tourist activities 48%
- 4. Nightlife is a really important factor 39%
- 5. There has to be a lot of history and historic sites for me to visit 33%

Tori Kirwan-Taylor, Brand & Communications Manager of bluechipholidays.co.uk, made the following comments regarding the findings of the study:

"Great British holidays can really be exciting for foreigners due to the rich history so many of our holiday destinations have. However we found it very interesting to see that different countries seem to prefer certain places over others."

She continued: "We also found it interesting that so many chose to go on holiday at certain destinations because of film locations! We're really lucky in the UK to boast so many different types of scenery which makes us one of the best places to film. It's really great to hear that it's helping our tourist industry and I hope this continues into the future!"



The Royal Yacht Britannia commemorated Her Majesty The Queen's 63 years' loyal service to her country with a spectacular fireworks display on the evening of the 9th September.

Britannia's Chief Executive Bob Downie says, "The Royal Yacht Britannia played a significant role during Her Majesty's reign and it is fitting that we marked this historical occasion in this way."

The Queen has now reigned for more than 63 years, breaking the record held by her great great grandmother Queen Victoria. The Royal Yacht Britannia was in Royal service for 44 years of Her Majesty's reign, from 1953 to 1997.

The Royal Yacht played a key role during The Queen's reign. Throughout four decades of Royal service, Britannia supported The Queen as ambassador for British business, sailing over one million nautical miles on 968 State visits, entertaining world leaders and promoting trade and industry. As well her formal role, the floating Royal residence allowed the Royal Family some privacy away from their public duties, with The Queen famously describing Britannia as "the one place I can truly relax."

Situated in Edinburgh's historic port of Leith, The Royal Yacht Britannia is now an iconic five-star visitor attraction and evening events venue, allowing visitors to enjoy a fascinating insight into The Queen's former floating palace, and the lives of those who lived and worked on board.

Rianne crowned World Champion and best

Former Warrington Collegiate student, Rianne Chester, is celebrating at the double at the WorldSkills International competition in São Paulo, Brazil, after taking a gold medal for Beauty therapy.

Rhianne also gained the illustrious Albert Vidal medal which recognises the best of best, the first time the UK has ever won the prize.

Following an intense and high spirited 43rd WorldSkills Competition, the Closing Ceremony of WorldSkills São Paulo 2015 brought to an end the largest competition in WorldSkills history and the first ever held in Latin America.

An estimated 9,000 competitors, experts, delegates, sponsors and partners, and supporters shared an emotional evening centred on recognising the excellence of the 1,189 competitors from around the world.

The competitors with the highest points at the competition receives the Albert Vidal Award. Rianne received the award jointly with Jeong Woo Seo, Korea, Automobile Technology and Luis Carlos Sanches Machado, Brazil, Automobile Technology.

They each received a trophy from WorldSkills and a Brazilian cultural piece of art from WorldSkills São Paulo 2015.

Lesley Hill, Curriculum Leader in Beauty Therapy at Warrington Collegiate, the instigators of Rianne's journey to international success said:"We are so proud of Rianne and her fantastic achievement. She completed her Level 2 and Level 3 Beauty Therapy with us at the Academy at Warrington Collegiate. At an early stage tutors recognised that Rianne has something special, a hidden talent. At college Rianne blossomed into a confident level 3 therapist and an excellent role model for others. She took part in UK Skills competitions during her studies and was successful in winning her regional heats. We have always kept in contact with Rianne throughout her journey and the academy became a base for some of her intense training. Rianne will be coming back to inspire our current students with her story in the near future.

Rianne is the second world champion to have trained at Warrington Collegiate. In 2013 Bricklaying apprentice, Ashley Terron, won Gold at WorldSkills International 2013, Leipzig, Germany..

Carole Stott, chair of Find a Future, which manages the UK's entry into the WorldSkills competition, said: "WorldSkills São Paulo gave Team UK the opportunity to showcase the UK's vocational and FE system on a global stage.

"The hard work they have all put in over the last two years to prepare for the competition, alongside their committed training managers has really paid off and we are thrilled with the results they have achieved.

Keeping You Safe on the Road

For a clear view this autumn

At this time of year visibility becomes even more important than ever. Being able to see clearly through your windscreen in wet and dark conditions will minimise your risk of accidents out on the road, keeping you and your family safe.

Checking your windscreen wipers in autumn should be a basic pre-winter check. If your wipers judder, make a noise or leave unwashed margins or bands of rain it's time to replace them.

Clean your windscreen inside and out. Greasy smears can seriously impair your vision in low winter sun. For stubborn marks try dishwasher powder dissolved in a little water and dry with clean kitchen towel.

Make good use of your air conditioning for faster demisting and to reduce condensation on cold windows.

Make sure you switch wipers off in the park position as the risk of freezing increases. This will avoid wipers freezing to the screen and causing damage to the wiper motor or blades when you start the car again.

Now is the time to top up windscreen washer fluid with added anti-freeze to reduce the chance of freezing. Don't use engine anti-freeze as this will damage your paintwork.

Claire thinks big in search for answers

A former Priestley College student is at the forefront of scientific investigations into some of the tiniest organisms on the planet.

Dr Claire Stanley, who left Priestley with a passion for sciences and As in the subjects, is now conducting research at ETH Zurich – one of the leading international universities for technology and the natural sciences.

During a return visit to college she met her former tutor Jan Costello and explained what she was doing now.

"It is fundamental science because no one has done it before," said Claire, who grew up in Birchwood.

"We are manipulating fluids on a micro scale and in this controlled way we are able to look at the development of antibacterials."

Claire's research is into the development of technologies in microfluidics, which involves studying the reactions between bacteria, fungi



and nematodes, which are microscopic worms found in soil.

Claire and her colleagues are looking to develop potentially life-saving antibacterials as well as investigating ways their methods could help with safe crop growth.

"One of the next steps for me will be encouraging and mentoring the next generation of scientists," said Claire. "I would also love to lead my own research group one day."
