Editor's Comment

WE are all familiar with the various devices used to break bad news. The most obvious, is to try and make it sound like good news - and some of these can be quite funny.

But the borough council's the impending description of changes to the parking arrangements in Lymm as "an improved parking experience for shoppers" would be hilarious if it did not have such potentially serious consequences.

The changes are detailed elsewhere in this issue, but put shortly, they mean there will be no free parking in the village centre

until after 3pm.
When we broke the news in our online editions (www.lymmlife. co.uk) we were inundated with emails from worried and angry villagers.

There were dire predictions of

"the death of the village", threats to stop shopping in the village, accusations of the borough using Lymm as a "cash cow" to subsidise free car parks elsewhere and even to subsidise car parking for council

One presumably facetious suggestion was that the shops should stay closed until 3pm after which the car parks would be free.

It is easy to over-react in a situation like this but two things are clear - the changes will not bring an improved parking experience for shoppers and they will certainly not help village shopkeepers. Some already struggle and some may find they have to close.

An extra £1 on the shopping bill may not deter someone spending £40 or more on a weekly shop, but Lymm does not have too many of those. It relies more on "top-up" shoppers who may go elsewhere, thus reducing footfall in the village centre generally.

Ironically, when Lymm is probably at its busiest, in the evening with restaurants and wine bars full of people enjoying a night out and spending enough for a £1 parking fee to go unnoticed, the car parks are, and will continue to be, free.

Town crier wins Rotary club's special award

THE winner of this year's Lymm Rotary Club's annual Cyril Bell award for services to the community, was Town crier Peter Powell.

"Peter deserves recognition for outstanding public service for the Lymm community. For many years he has transported senior citizens shopping, to church, hospital and the doctors for appointments.

"Peter is a member of the Ancient and Hoppy usely Guild of Town Criers.

"Peter is a member of the Ancient and Honourable Guild of Town Criers and is best known for his unique role as the Lymm Town Crier, which he has held for 22 years and, probably, makes him the best known Lymm personality at national and local events. His work as a Town Crier is charitable. He introduced the role to Lymm and has represented the village in competitions.

He is a long serving member of the Lymm Parish Council – he was Chairman in 2012 – and currently serves on the Finance, Allotments and Village Hall committees.

Peter is Treasurer and a hard worker for Lymm in Bloom, helping with the planting and labouring in the village. A trustee of the Lymm Clothing Charity. A helper at Oughtrington Luncheon Club and, as a volunteer, helps to keep Oughtrington churchyard tidy.

He is a member of the Dickensian Charity committee and leads the Carols around the Cross on Christmas Eve. For 30 years he has worked with members of the Lymm Festivities committee. It was while trimming Christmas trees in 1998 that his loyalty to the people of Lymm resulted in him losing a tinger – the ultimate service!"

At a recent meeting, Club President, Sue Tupman, presented Peter with the Cyril Bell award – a cut glass rose bowl which he retains for a year – a signed Certificate, and a cheque for £500 made payable to Peter's chosen charity, "Alzheimer's Research UK". The award is made in memory of Cyril Bell, a member of Lymm Rotary Club, who died during his Presidential year.



FORMER Lymm High School pupil Greg Horne has secured his dream place at Oxford University after successfully challenging his English Literature exam result - and having it unargued

for after the Priestley College student questioned his B in English Literature it was upgraded to an A – securing him a place at Oxford

- securing him a place at Oxtora University.

"I was a little bit surprised by the original mark, but when you have been waiting eight weeks for the results every possibility goes through your mind," he said.

Greg now joins his friend Holly Roach as the second of Priestley's Class of 2016 to secure a place at Oxford Oxford.

He will be studying Law whilst Holly focusses on Biochemistry.

"It is great that we both made it," said Greg, from Thelwall.

"We became friends after visiting Oxford University with Priestley so it seems fitting."

Greg set his heart on studying Law at university after witnessing the Hillsborough inquests in

the Hillsborough inquests in Warrington from the public gallery. He had wanted to see the legal process in action and after attending the inquests at Bridgewater Place he knew the profession was for him.

At Priestley he took The Graduate, which is designed to



to apply for places at Russell Group universities, and during the course visited Oxford.

"The buildings were beautiful, the professors were unbelievably intelligent and the place just felt magical," he said.

Greg was called for an interview at Oxford in January and was offered a place within weeks.

On results day he secured an A*

in Politics, A in History, B in English and a C in Maths, but that still was not good enough.

However, after tutors and staff at Priestley helped him pull together every mark from the past two years he successfully had his grade reviewed.

"It has been an emotional few weeks, but I am glad it worked out the way it did," said Greg.

Retired solicitor's human rights mission to the West Bank

RETIRED solicitor John Booth from Lymm has flown out to the Israeli-occupied West Bank to work as a volunteer human rights monitor, under the auspices of the Ecumenical Accompaniment Programme in Palestine and Israel

[EAPPI].

John's role as an ecumenical accompanier will involve the daily monitoring of human rights abuses on the West Bank, as well as providing a protective presence to local communitie.

Prior to becoming a solicitor, John worked for the British Council in the Middle East. He is a Quaker

in the Middle East. He is a Quaker and an Arabic speaker.
He said: "My primary aim is to do what I can to help improve the daily lives of local people in the Tulkarm and Qalqiliya areas of the West Bank, where I will be working. With so many appalling events taking place elsewhere in the Middle East, this conflict is easy to forget. I want to help ensure that that does not happen and that we do all we can to support the realisation of the two-state solution.

The EAPPI is a World Council of Churches sponsored programme and has been running since 2002. It is supported in the UK by many major churches and aid bodies. Ecumenical accompaniers come from more than 25 countries in total. They work in groups of four or five in locations around the West Bank and in East Jerusalem.

John said: "This is a huge challenge. The situation in Israel and the Occupied Palestinian Territories is very complex. Many Palestinians are living under intolerable circumstances, younger generations of Israelis are themselves equally victims of a situation which they did not themselves create. One of the greatest tasks for the EAPPI programme is to show Israelis that we are not either pro-Palestinian or anti-Israeli. We are there to promote the observance of human rights and social justice by both sides. Ultimately, that will improve the lives of people on both sides of the fence and contribute towards a just peace"

Upon his return to the UK in December, John will be giving talks and hosting events with any interested groups. 

high at 99 per cent.



Morris men keep ancient tradition of Lymm Rushbearing alive



LYMM Morris men helped keep the ancient tradition of Rushbearing alive in the village after the official event was cancelled due to highway closure costs.

Members of the Morris group were joined by a handful of members of the public who were carrying bulrushes.

Fóllowing a performance of

the traditional Lymm Rushbearing dance, the group walked up Rectory Lane to St Mary's Church, laying the bulrushes at the church

They then retired to the Church Green for refreshments, before performing again on the pub car

The official event, which normally includes members of the parish council and community group's was

council and community groups was called off by local organiser Chris Limb, after Warrington Borough Council insisted on charging over £1,000 for highway closures.

Lymm Rushbearing was reborn in the early 1970's (having probably died out in the early years of the century, possibly during the First World War) and for the last several years has been held on the second Sunday in August, although it has over the years been held it has over the years been held on other days. For many years in the twentieth century Rushbearing Monday was a local bank holiday.

history of Cheshire refers to the festival taking place in many communities on or near to the feast of the parish's patron saint - hence Lymm's tradition of having the festival during the summer holiday period and close to the feast of the Assumption of Saint Mary.

Although the carrying of fresh rushes to church (normally on a horse-drawn cart) was a central feature, and the replacement of the old rushes upon the earthen church floor a very practical necessity in former days, this gathering of locals also involved festivities including not only the procession and Morris

dancing but also sports, fairground stalls, and very full public houses!

Until 2015 the route started from Pepper Street and then processed via The Cross up Eagle Brow, left into Brookfield Road and left into Church Road to arrive at St Mary's Church. After a short service the procession returned via Rectory Lane to the Village Hall for light refreshments, judging of the rushbearing garlands, and more Morris dancing.

The procession normally includes

Morris men, people carrying Rushbearing garlands and rushes, the Chairman of the Parish Council and the Mayor of Warrington, the May Queen and various local groups. It is medieval in its origins and Lymm is one of a very small number of communities which have



Free parking to end for shoppers

FREE parking for shoppers is to end in Lymm as Warrington Borough Council moves to deliver what it describes as "a better experience" for motorists.

The changes are expected to take place in November, after which the free one hour period on all council car parks in the village will end.

Pepper Street car park will charge £1 for up to two hours, £2 for two to four hours and £10 for more than four hours but there will be no charge after 3pm.

The other car parks will charge £1 for up to three hours and £2 for more than three, while parking will again be free after 3pm.

"Cashless parking" is also to be introduced but the ban on returning to a car park within two hours will be removed.

The changes will also be introduced at Stockton Heath – but not at other council-owned car parks in other parts of the borough.

The council says it believes the changes will "improve" the parking experience for shoppers in Lymm and Stockton Heath and give them more time to shop.

But opponents of the changes believe the real aim is to make a profit on the Lymm and Stockton Heath car parks to subsidise free parking in other parts of the borough...

Drivers will still have the option to "pay and display" as ticket machines will still be available on

all car parks.
If drivers choose to use "cashless parking" they will be required to set up an account and have parking fees automatically debited from their bank. They will receive text messages telling them how much they have been charged, as well as reminders when their tariff is due to

expire. Cllr Hans Mundry, the council's lead member for highways, transportation and public realm, said: "These plans will help make parking services in Lymm and Stockton Heath more responsive to the needs of motorists, giving them increased flexibility and choice. "It's part of our plans to deliver

better parking experiences in every part of Warrington, making life easier for thousands of residents,

shoppers and visitors, as well as parents on the school run."

The council is confident the free after 3pm offer will enable parents to park and safely drop off and pick up children from nearby schools and provide free parking for residents during late afternoon and throughout the evening, which it feels may help relieve some of the congestion caused by on-street parking.


