

Having the courage to make a change

Twelve months ago, Warrington-born Lucy Jackman was working as a communications manager in the financial services industry. After five years in a fantastic role, the long commute, long hours and pressure of the industry started to take its toll. She was ready for a change and began to consider what the next step in her career might be.

Top of her priority list was a job that offered her a better work/life balance. Coming a close second was to do something she was really passionate about. Lucy had always secretly wanted to be her own boss; talking about it was one thing but actually doing it was another.

"When I started to think about what to do next, the thought of going to work for someone else really didn't fill me with excitement. I'm a creative person and wanted to try something completely different – to really make my mark on the world."

After considering a number of options, including re-training as an interior designer, Lucy decided to forge ahead with setting up her own communications business.

"When I handed in my notice before Christmas with no other job lined up, my colleagues all said I was very brave. I didn't feel brave. It just felt like the right thing to do. I was the happiest I'd been in ages."

"I set up Comma Sense to share my skills and experience with other business owners. People have amazing business ideas but often struggle to explain what they do on their website, social media or in their brochure. That's where I can really help businesses to grow and connect with their customers."

Through creative copywriting, proofreading and editing services, Lucy supports businesses to tell their story through blogs, newsletters, web copy and a whole host of other materials.

She also works with individuals to help them take the next step in their career by writing CVs, covering letters and LinkedIn profiles.

"I've worked with a range of people, from students to experienced professionals, and had some great successes tailoring CVs for specific roles. One client was recently shortlisted from



over 100 applicants and went on to get the job of their dreams. Another job I'm really proud of is a student who had been struggling for a year just to get shortlisted for interview. I re-wrote her CV and tailored it to the sector she wanted to get into. A month later, she'd had three interviews and received two job offers. I appreciate there's still a lot of work to do at interview stage, but just playing a small part in helping people get to this stage is really rewarding."

So if you're thinking of making a change in your life, what advice can Lucy offer?

"Whether you're applying for a new job or planning a complete change of career, make sure you do your research first. I spoke to a lot of friends who own their own businesses before I made the decision to leave my full time job. Their advice has been invaluable. A supportive network helps a lot too. I wouldn't have had the courage to make the change without knowing my husband, family and friends were 100% behind me."

Analysis of My Car Check data for the first half of 2016 has revealed the UK used cars most likely to have been written-off. Nearly a quarter (23.67%) of all searches returned a write-off warning, with the riskiest models being the Peugeot 208 Active and the Ford Fiesta Edge 60.

Head of My Car Check, Roger Powell, said: "Any previously written-off vehicle must be viewed with caution, especially when inspecting the quality of repairs. The implications of being involved in a further accident in a car which has not been properly repaired don't bear thinking about. Even leaving the safety aspect aside, previous write-offs should generally cost a lot less than a like-for-like non-accident damaged vehicle. In a survey a couple of years ago, 79% of My Car Check customers said they wouldn't buy one. The flipside is that some buyers are happy to look at category C or D write-offs and use the data to push for a price reduction."

With information from the police, DVLA, insurers and finance houses, My Car Check holds comprehensive data on every vehicle on UK roads – things that buyers should be aware of before making an offer.

The humble garden shed may hold the key to contentment. 96% of shed owners in the North West say their shed makes them happy, according to the Waltons Great British Shed Survey.

For 'sheddies' (people who love their shed), the shed is much more than a place to store gardening tools - it's the ultimate retreat. In the North West, over 50% of people surveyed say they love sheds so much they'd happily spend a country break staying in one, and one in four say they would even live in their shed.

Shed owners in the North West eagerly anticipate the time they spend in their shed: 22% say it's better than going to the pub and 48% say it's better than doing almost anything in the house. 6% of those surveyed prefer 'shed time' to sex and a further 6% of North West sheddies confess to actually having had sex in their shed.

Secret sheds

Be it a 'she shed' or 'man cave', the garden shed is a haven for many. 39% use their shed as a hideaway,

with 15% seeking time away from partners and others using it as a secret hidey hole for chocolate, cigarettes, alcohol, and even love letters from exes.

All shed cons

Far from the damp draughty stereotype, the modern garden shed often has all the mod cons. Most sheddies surveyed have electricity in their shed, 32% have heating, and 39% have WiFi.

Sanctuary

40% of sheddies in the North West go to their shed to relax, with 16% playing music and 14% meditating. Other sheddies retreat to their garden hideaway for dinner, to watch a film, read, write, sleep, and even to enjoy a sauna.

"My shed is a retreat", one respondent says. Another comments: "I love to be in the shed on my own or with my grandchildren making and inventing things."

²² lifestyle October 'Definitive' YES line-up to reform for UK tour

Long-time YES fans, rejoice! Jon Anderson, Trevor Rabin and Rick Wakeman are proud to announce that after a hiatus of 25 years, they are to reform the definitive YES line-up as – Anderson, Rabin and Wakeman (ARW).

Since they last played together in 1990 on the highly successful YES 'Union Tour', there have been various hybrid versions of the band. However, none featured the iconic voice of Jon Anderson, the outstanding guitar talent of Trevor Rabin, and the keyboard wizardry of Rick Wakeman. The aim of the band will be to restore the standard of excellence in performance that they established with their 1990 shows - which saw YES members past and present come together for the first (and only) time of the legendary band's career.

"To be able to sing and perform with Rick and Trevor at this time in my life is a treasure beyond words," explains Jon. "I'm so excited to create new music and revisit some of the classic work we created many years ago, it's going to be a musical adventure on so many new levels."

"Trevor and I have wanted to play Yes music together since the Union Tour," adds Rick. "And as for so many of us, there is no Yes music without Jon. The 'Holy Trinity of Yes' is for me, very much a dream come true."

"After 18 years of immersing myself in film scoring, I couldn't be happier to be going out on tour with Jon and Rick," says Trevor. "After we worked together for the first time on the Union tour in the 90's, we were determined to play together again. It's a dream to be going out with Jon and Rick after so many years. We are all completely dedicated to this project."

The most successful prog rock group of all time, YES was co-founded by Jon Anderson and the late Chris Squire in 1968 and went on to sell millions of units with releases such as Fragile, Close to The Edge, Tales From Topographic Oceans, Going For The One and 90125, as well as embarking on several record-breaking world tours.

While Rick is associated with the '70s "prog era" of the band (which saw YES become a worldwide stadium headliner) and Trevor associated with the '80s "pop era" of the band (which furthered the

band's popularity - including the band's biggest chart success), Jon is the bridge between both factions (as he was a member of both eras).

Not content to rest on past glory, Jon, Trevor and Rick are working on new songs, which are currently being recorded. The band will make its live debut in North America in October/ November, followed by the Rest of the World in 2017.

The Rest of the World Tour will be coming to the UK in March 2017, where ARW will be playing nine shows starting at the Cardiff Arena on the 12th and finishing at the Manchester Apollo on the 25th. Additional dates may be added.



Now is the time for your pre-winter safety checks

WITH the dark nights and early mornings fast approaching visibility becomes even more important than ever.

Now is the time to check your windscreen wipers are up to scratch.

Being able to see clearly through a windscreen in wet and dark conditions will help minimise the risk of accidents out on the road, keeping you and your family safe.

This should be the start of a basic pre-winter check. If your wipers judder, make a noise or leave unwashed margins or bands of rain it's time to replace them.

Clean your windscreen inside and out. Greasy smears can seriously impair your vision in low winter sun. For stubborn marks try dishwasher powder dissolved in a little water and dry with clean kitchen towel.

Make good use of your air conditioning for faster demisting and to reduce condensation on cold windows.

Make sure you switch wipers off in the park position as the risk of freezing increases. This will avoid wipers freezing to the screen and causing damage to the wiper motor or blades when you start the car again.

Now is the time to top up windscreen washer fluid with added anti-freeze to reduce the chance of freezing. Don't use engine anti-freeze as this will damage your paintwork.

"One of the best days of my life' is how Thelma Mannington described the day when she welcomed hearing dog Jessie into her life.

It marked the end of 16 difficult months for Thelma following the death of Emi, her constant hearing dog companion and best friend for nearly 11 years, and who helped her overcome many of the challenges of living with deafness.

"Jessie has given me my life back," said Thelma, from Mid Cheshire. "Bringing her home was definitely one of the best days of my life."

The pair are now inseparable with Jessie helping Thelma, who has been deaf since childhood, to live a safer and more fulfilled life.

"She wakes me up in the morning, lets me know when the telephone rings and alerts me to all noises by tapping my hand with her paw. She's also trained to tell me if there's someone at the



door, on the telephone or if the fire alarm goes off. She's a real Godsend and helps with the most important thing of all – living an independent life."

As Thelma explains, losing Emi after eleven years was devastating. "You come to rely so much on a hearing dog. You become dependent but they're not just helpers, they're true friends and it was such a blow to lose her."

Thelma was immediately put on the waiting list for another hearing dog and it was 16 months before she got the news she'd been waiting for,

Jessie undertook her specialist training at The Hearing Dog's for Deaf People training centre in East Yorkshire and it was in January this year that Bryn Richards, Chairman of the Cheshire branch of Hearing Dog's for Deaf People invited Thelma to meet Jessie at the centre for the very first time.

"The continued support from Bryn has been overwhelming and has helped Jessie and I bond incredibly quickly."

The pair have worked together intensively, getting to know each other in the home and helping Deafness Support Network (DSN) with its hearing dog fundraising activities. "Jessie is always the star of the show, and has already helped raise awareness of DSN by helping Terry Webb give talks about our work" said Gill Reeder, DSN's Operations Executive.

Thelma continued: "We have bonded into a wonderful partnership. I cannot thank enough all those who have cared for and trained Jessie. She is my sunshine: the love we have is beyond words and I feel so safe having her around."

"She is devoted, loving and the truest friend I could ask for, she is always there for me when I need her - I couldn't have hoped for a more faithful friend".

"With Jessie by my side, I've realised that laughter is the best medicine and that we must enjoy each day to its fullest, which is what she's helping me do once again".



Warrington disability gymnast Natasha Coates, who suffers from a rare condition which makes her allergic to exercise, is celebrating after being crowned 2016 All Around British Champion at Lilleshall.

She was crowned champion in three events, the Beam, Floor and Vault and came 3rd on Bars during the British Championship event – making a total of 19 British titles in two years and the AA Champion for the 3rd year running!

A delighted Natasha, from Appleton, Warrington, said : "I can not thank everyone enough for their encouragement and support! I couldn't do it without you all."

Natasha, 21, who was named Disabled Sportsperson of the Year 2015, suffers from Mast Cell Activation Syndrome (MCAS). MCAS is a rare condition that causes an over-sensitive immune system. MCAS sufferers have regular, sometimes life-threatening, allergic reactions to a range of triggers from food to fragrances to exercise.

The first is Mast Cell Action, a new charity set up to support sufferers of MCAS. The condition is not currently recognised by the NHS so it is very hard for MCAS sufferers to get diagnosed and treated in the UK. Mast Cell Action works to raise awareness and improve treatment of MCAS.

The second organisation supported by Natasha is Birtenshaw, a local charity which provides education and care services for children and young adults with special educational needs and disabilities. Their services include a school, a college, children's homes, adult care services, and short breaks.

Trainspotters in Warrington were given a rare treat when the famous 'Flying Scotsman' made an appearance passing through town.

The iconic steam locomotive was captured by local photographer Eddie Whitham passing through Winwick, on its way to The East Lancashire Railway at Bury.

The exact details of the engine route were kept secrete due to earlier incidents causing safety problems.

Often described as the world's most famous steam locomotive the Pacific steam locomotive was built in 1923 for the London and North Eastern Railway (LNER) at Doncaster Works to a design of Nigel Gresley.

It was employed on long-distance express East Coast Main Line trains by the LNER and its successors, British Railways Eastern and North-Eastern Regions, notably on the London to Edinburgh Flying Scotsman train service after which it was named.

The locomotive set two world records for steam traction, becoming the first steam locomotive to be officially authenticated at reaching 100 miles



per hour (160.9 km/h) on 30 November 1934 and then setting a record for the longest non-stop run by a steam locomotive when it ran 422 miles (679 km) on 8 August 1989 while in Australia.

It retired from regular service in 1963 after covering 2.08 million miles.
