FEELINGS are clearly running high in the village over the future of Lymm Library.

Campaigners are calling on LiveWire and Warrington Borough Council not to impose and further cutbacks at the village library - and indeed any other library services across the borough.

The library in Lymm is clearly popular and I would be extremely surpirsed if it had to close completely, although it is currently one of five "under threat!" LiveWire have been instructed to

find around $\pounds300,000$ in savings across their services in the whole of Warrington.

vvarrington. As Lymm Life was going to press the consultations were ongoing and more than 2,500 people have signed a petition to "Save Lymm Library," which means it should

get discussed in full at a meeting of Warrington Borough Council in

December. Meanwhile some people have suggested putting an extra charge on the parish precept to help protect the service and avoid any cut backs.

In these times of austerity it is getting more and more difficult for local authorities to balance the books - a few extra pounds on the parish precept to keep Lymm Library going for future generations to enjoy would be a small price to pay in my opinion.

But we also have to accept that younger generations are reading fewer books and spending more time on mobile phones and tablets and our library srevices need to keep up with the times and adapt to the changing world we live in.



am confident LiveWire and the borough council will consider the issue seriously before making any final decisions - and that Lymm Library will survive in some way - possibly with some kind of voluntary support from the local community - Grappenhall library is and or and a support one such example.

If we want to keep our library, most importantly we must use it and hope it doesn't become another victim of austerity. Maybe the council could donate some of the parking charges to help fund it!

Lymm Library campaigners to challenge council over closure

MORE than 2,500 people have signed a petition challenging any

proposed closure of Lymm library. With petition numbers climbing by the day campaigners in Lymm have exceeded the 1,500 required to force a council debate and will now present their case for keeping the Library open to a full meeting of

the Council on December 5. Local Parish Councillor Graham Gowland, who has been co-ordinating the campaign, said: "We are keen to present our arguments for keeping our fantastic local Library open. It has been run down in recent years by Livewire, but we still have a higher level of loans per resident than most parts of the country. We have plans to build on the current service. We don't want the library run just by volunteers because we want a professional library service.

"We have investigated ways to enhance what we already have but we need Livewire and Warrington Council to deliver the service they should do.'

The campaign met its initial targets within a couple of weeks, but local campaigners are pushing to collect even more support before the hearing on December 5.

The Lymm campaign supports the wider Warrington campaign to maintain a local, quality library service throughout the Borough.

Although not the work of the official campaign team, a number of eyecatching "road" signs have sprung up in the village.

Borough councillor Ian Marks said: "These are the work of someone in the village who feels very strongly about the issue. I must stress they are not part of the 'official' campaign!"

Meanwhile LiveWire has extended the consultation until Friday October 21 to allow more LiveWire

"We will ensure all the comments and suggestions received are used to give a full report to the council on the feedback from these proposals."



STRESS, anxiety, depression, self-harm, suicide, bullying, eating and sleep disorders, substance abuse, happiness, emotional resilience, mindfulness – all words that are now used on a daily basis in the madia media.

media. Consider some facts (via Young Minds, Mind, the Mental Health Foundation and the Samaritans): 1 in 4 of us will face a mental health problem in our lives; 1 in 5 women aged 16-24 reported self-harming in 2014; 1 in 10 suicides in the UK are by those aged 15-24; Half of all lifetime cases of mental illness begin at 14; Rates of anxiety amongst teenagers have increased by 70% in the past 25 years; 55% of children bullied develop depression as adults; 70 million depression as adults; 70 million work days are lost each year due to mental health problems costing employers approx £2.4billion a

year. The stats go on and on....and are scary! Take any child you know, then add in a group of their friends and do the maths. Modern

triends and do the maths. Modern society is challenging! On Thursday, November 10, Colony Community, part of The Colony Networking Group, will run 'Think Family Mental Health' to bring local experts to local people, during an evening of presentations covering family well-

being, happiness and our young people's 'mind health'. The event is timed exactly one month after World Mental Health Day (10 Oct) which will undoubtedly see added attention following the launch of Heads Together (a Royal initiative which unites several leading

Heads Together (a Royal initiative which unites several leading support charities). The speaker panel includes: Jo Howarth, author and owner of The Happiness Club; Katie Hughes of No Rain No Rainbows; Toni Mackenzie, author and owner of Inner Depths; Debbie Hayes, Coach and Goulding Sleeptalk Consultant; Roz Edlin of StressWatch; Natacha Thompson of Accord Counselling Services; and Helen Jones of Mindgift. Almost 25 years to the day after it opened, Margaret and Rod King and staff of The Rosebank Centre welcomed past families and staff to their celebration. Thanks to the talented Rosebank team, children enjoyed activities both inside and outside of a physical and creative nature with nursery staff and an entertainer. Sessions included bulb planting, face painting, dance and music. Past children who first met at

Rosebank came to 'find themselves' in the many photo albums, and enjoyed watching videos from the early days. Everyone socialised and chatted whilst children played ...it was wonderful!

There was a fantastic buzz the whole day, friends meeting up and enjoying the grounds, teenage past children planning to come back to help after school as part of their Duke of Edinburgh Award Scheme.



Bell ringers celebrate special occasion

ST Mary's Lymm was one of 12 church towers in Cheshire to open their doors to visitors during Heritage Open Day weekend recently - when their RingMaster also tied the knot. A band of six ringers at the church responded to the call for a kinging memory when toward

a 'ringing' moment' when towers across the country were asked to ring prior to the weekend event. This was followed by an open practice.

Then at the weekend there was a steady stream of visitors. Some stayed at ground level and read about the bells, others ventured up to the ringing chamber, from where the bells are rung, on to the clock chamber where they saw the mechanism of the clock, given to the Church in 1891, and then up again to see the bells themselves, the heaviest of which weighs more than 29cwt.

The centre piece of the weekend, coincidentally, was the wedding of the tower captain Ringing Master, lan Daniels, who tied the knot with

Maureen Lees. A band of 10 ringers took it in turns to ring Lymm's eight bells before and after the wedding.


