

Margaret's mission to keep WWII memories alive

LATCHFORD resident Margaret Shaw is on a mission to encourage Warrington folk to join her on an annual event celebrating friendships forged between North West soldiers and the Dutch people during WWII.

The yearly commemoration from September 14-19, pays tribute to veteran servicemen, which included her father Frank Collopy, a lifelong resident of Latchford who served with the first airborne division during operation "Market Garden" the "Battle for the Bridge Too Far" in Arnhem. Frank, along with other veterans from Warrington looked forward to travelling back to Arnhem for the commemoration week

Although Frank passed away in 2007, Margaret is determined to keep the commemoration trip going until at least 2019 which will see the annual gathering mark its 75th anniversary.

He served as a medic as part of the 133 Para Field Ambulance. He was taken prisoner to Oosterbeek while caring for 14 wounded soldiers and served the war out at the infamous Stalag X1B prisoner of war camp at Fallingbostle, Germany until the cliberated in May 1945. camp was

Margaret explained: "Over the years the Mersey Arnhem Veterans' Club has subsidised travel, but funds are now almost expended. Basically, the more people who travel with us the cheaper it comes to fund the coach,".

The journey, via coach and ferry from Hull to Rotterdam and on to Arnhem is described by Margaret as a "laugh a minute". The party is made up of veterans, members of the Liverpool Parachute Regiment Association, next-of-kin, relatives, carers and supporters.

"The coach has been running for more than 30 years and started off with around 20 veterans, but now only two of the original group are still living.

"We are only two years away from the 75th Commemorations

in 2019 and we aim to keep this trip going until then. It would be really fantastic if we could keep it going beyond that date. The stay in Arnhem is amazing, everyone is welcomed with open arms and the warmth and hospitality is so touching," added Margaret.

"My father's ashes were interred Óosterbeek War Military Cemetery. It is important to keep this trip going for as long as is possible to pay our respects to Dad and to the thousands of soldiers who did not make it home in September 1944." Said Margaret.

Margaret is also keen to attract sponsorship that would help to keep the annual trip going.





Pupils at The Manchester Grammar School (MGS) have, once again, been highly successful in securing coveted offers from the Universities of Oxford and Cambridge.


This year, 22 pupils received offers from Oxford and Cambridge, of top academic schools nationally. Pupils received offers to study

Fit2Tackle celebra

LIVEWIRE and The Warrington Wolves Foundation's Fit2Tackle programme has been a fantastic success.

Starting as a 12-week pilot scheme it has now been running for two and a half years. It has proved both popular and successful with all courses of 40 men and 40 women becoming booked up rapidly and the participants can boast an astounding accumulative weight loss of over 500 stone. Livewire fitness instructors Tom Kearney and Paul Corless arrange

three times a week exercise sessions which are held at the Halliwell Jones stadium on Mondays and Wednesdays and at The Orford Park Jubilee Hub on Saturdays. Additionally, there are talks from dietitians and cardiologists along with health and wellbeing sessions. Tom said: "The people who

come on the course need to have a BMI of over 28 and the aim is to lose 5% of body weight over the 12 weeks course. We have a great success rate."

All participants who complete at least 75% of the course become entitled to a free 6 week Livewire gym pass.







Making Tax Digital

Firstly, WatkinsonBlack wish all readers a very happy and prosperous New Year. Late? Not at all. Accountants have three New-Years: 1st January, 1st February and, finally, 6th April.

We are now in a new tax ve are now in a new rax year, and now have less than 12 months until "Making Tax Digital" starts in earnest. From 6th April 2018 many of you will find yourself in the position of needing to submit



not one tax return each year but six, or eleven, or even 16! The government have shown almost total immobility in their The government have shown almost total immobility in their aim of introducing this massive change in the tax system in April 2018. This despite their failure to tell us, their customers, even now exactly what needs to be reported and when. This despite the fact that the House of Lords Economic Affairs Committee has expressed themselves to be "very puzzled" by the governments estimate of what this measure will cost you, the taxpayer (They said that the estimate of the cost to the taxpayer were based on "a very elegant piece of analysis and modelling" but not on "facts"). This despite the fact that the final submission under HMRC's pilot (test) will not be made until 9 months after Making Tax Digital is introduced, making the pilot as much use as a snowball in hell. snowball in hell.

One thing that has become clear over the past few weeks is that taxpayers caught by this new regime will see the reports that they are required to submit to HMRC increasing from one a year to at least six! Besides the much-heralded quarterly reports, it now become clear that an "End of Period Statement" is required followed by a "Final Declaration", making six in total. However, another thing that has become clear is that the quarterly reports and End of Period Statement will need to be submitted by a taxpayer for each source of income. So a sole submitted by a taxpayer for each source of income. So a sole

trader will need to submit 6 reports. That same sole trader with

trader will need to submit 6 reports. I hat same sole trader with rental income will need to submit reports separately for his sole trade and his rental income, making a total of 13 reports. Add another source, add another 5 reports, and so on. As usual, there will be penalties for any taxpayers failing to make their reports on time. It is doubtful whether there will be compensation for HMRC's failure to deal accurately and timely with the avalanche of information that they will receive, a fear expressed by the House of lords. expressed by the House of Lords. So much for tax simplification!


