

Spitfire flypast confirmed for Lymm Historic Transport Day

A Spitfire fly past has been confirmed for the 5th annual Lymm Historic Transport Day which has a record line-up.

Organisers are putting the finishing touches to this year's event which has quickly become such a firm fayourite on the local calendar as well as drawing in thousands from further afield.

The show on Sunday June 25, now has confirmation of the RAF Spitfire flypast which will be at the early time of 11.25am This will follow on from the drive-in parade which passes through the village centre from 10.30 till 11 am.

Some exciting late additions to the line-up include Fred Dibnah's famous steam engine "Betsy" (pictured below) which is being brought to the show by Fred's son Roger. The newly built Whitfield Light Railway will also be making only its second public appearance at this year's show along a narrow gauge track on the May Queen field.

Other highlights during the day will be the drive in parade at 10.30, the dinosaur walkabout on the field at 12.30pm and 2.30pm and the appearance of the baby Triceratops at 1.30pm. The whole day wraps with the Historic Sail past at

In between times there is simply masses to see and do, classic vehicles, traction engines, historic boats, Lego transport expo, model railways, remote control car racing,

a full-size replica Spitfire, aircraft cockpits and large model planes.

The show also features an exciting new venue in the shape of Lymm Heritage Centre. Their team have been pulling out all the stops to be open in time for the Festival and are putting on an exhibition entitled "A Quiet Revolution" a fascinating ocal history of cycling featuring an amazing collection of historic bicycles kindly loaned by Walton Hall Cycle Museum.

With free parking and a vintage

bus ride thrown into the ticket price of just £5 for an adult. £3 for a child or £12 for a family of four the whole day certainly seems to live up to its motto of being "One Amazing Day

Garden to open for charity

A LYMM garden is to open to the public as part of the National Garden Scheme – which supports a number of charities. Mike and Gail Porter have been opening their garden at 10, Statham

Avenue, Lymm for a number of years.

A beautifully structured, south facing quarter acre plot, it is described as peaceful, with pastel shades in early summer. It is carefully terraced and planted as it rises to the Bridgewater Canal towpath.

There is a formal clay paved courtyard with cordoned peach trees and a

working greenhouse.

Rose pillars lead to established herbaceous beds and quiet shaded areas, bordered by azaleas and rhododendrons.

The garden will be open on Saturday and Sunday, July 1-2 from 11am to 5pm, when the admission charge will be £4, children free.
Teas will be served with homemade cakes and meringues with fresh fruit.



Former Lymm Post Office set to be new home for St Rocco's charity shop

LYMM'S former village centre Post Office is set to become a new home for St Rocco's Hospice, who are vacating their existing charity shop premises after 30 years.

St Rocco's will be leaving the premises near to the canal bridge and taking up residence in the site previously occupied by Harrisons and the Post Office next to the Lower Dam.

St Rocco's retail Manager Eric Russell said: "Our fantastic volunteers work so hard to make our shop in Lymm a success and they are very excited that they will soon be operating in a retail unit which is so much more fit for purpose.

"Not only are there very steep steps up to the entrance of the existing shop, but also a set of narrow steps inside which make moving the stock around a challenge for the volunteers."

The new location will see a marked improvement for all those in Lymm and the surrounding areas that support St. Rocco's by donating their pre-loved clothing or household items. The short stay car parking spaces outside the shop will make it much easier to drop things off.

It will also offer shoppers a better retail experience as there will be more space to display items and better lighting. As the entrance and the shop itself are all on one level, access should no longer be an issue and members of the public who have pushchairs or use wheelchairs

will hopefully have no problem getting in and out.

It is not the first time that St. Rocco's have relocated in the village. The shop began life on the site of Lloyds Bank before moving round the corner.

"All the shop helpers and their families worked their socks off to get the shop ready to open," recalls Angela Coates, one of the original volunteers.

The task is similarly herculean this time round, but with everyone working together they are sure that they will be ready in time to open the doors during this year's Lymm Festival.

"We've always enjoyed a challenge in the Lymm shop," said Volunteer Link Manager Betty Hughes, who has volunteered for the hospice since the beginning. "We are so pleased to be moving in to a shop where we can set to and make an even bigger contribution to ensuring that St. Rocco's, a charity that we all love, is there for people when they really need the specialist care that it offers."

The volunteers will be opening the doors on Friday, June 23 and are promising a special welcome to all visitors during the first weekend in the new shop.





May Queen Festival washed out by hea

LYMM May Queen Festival was cancelled at the last minute after

heavy overnight rain turned the May Queen field into a quagmire. Event chairman Steve Harper made the tough decision after realising the field was too dangerous to use due to the soggy

conditions.

He said: "When we went on the field in the morning, to start setting up, it was just too boggy. It would

up, it was just too baggy. It would have been too dangerous and caused too much damage to the field if we had proceeded."

It is believed to be the first time the festival, which dates back more than 100 years, had been cancelled due to the weather.





Village fights to save its last bank

THE village of Lymm is fighting to save its last bank following the decision by the Lloyd's Banking group to close its local branch on July 4.

The parish council has applied to Warrington Borough Council to register the branch at Lymm Cross as an "asset of community value."

Cllr Graham Gowland said: "A

working bank is really important working bank is really important for a thriving community and I hope the borough council can see this. We want the premises protected." Lloyd's became the only bank in Lymm – population 12,000 – when Barclay's closed their branch last

Before that a number of other banks and building societies closed in the village – and earlier this year the village centre post office closed suddenly.

So far, efforts to find premises where a new post office could open have proved unsuccessful.

Cllr Gowland appealed to villagers to email the borough council at Devcontrol@warrington. gov.uk quoting 2017/30258, telling them why the building needs to be kept as a bank.

In addition, he asked locals to email Lloyds directly on customerserviceswestyorkshire@ lloydsbanking.com telling them why the branch should be kept

Cllr Gowland added: branch has seen a drop in trade since Warrington Council changed the car park charges, but this is being overturned in June, and we hope the village economy will start to recover.

"But with the closure of our post

office, we call on Lloyd's to support the village – helping Lymm prosper by keeping this important asset open. In return, we hope locals can support the branch and use it

regularly."
The Asset of Community Value application can also be commented

https://tinyurl.com/lloydslymm At the time they announced the closure, Lloyd's said the branch had only 18 regular weekly personal and business customers.

If the property is registered as an asset of community value it means the owners have to give sixth months notice if they wish to stell it. If a local group then wishes to buy it they can then trigger a moratorium for six months to give them time to raise the money. But there is requirement for the owner to reduce the price.




