RivFest17 returns to support River Reeves F

Various bands and artists including Maximo Park, Billy Bragg and Eliza and the Bear will play at this year's music festival set up by the family of Warrington musician River Reeves, who tragically died last year.

RivFest, the annual music festival set up by the family of the late Viola Beach guitarist River Reeves will take place on Saturday, September 2 at Priestley College. All four members of the band attended Priestley College.

The four members of Viola Beach – Reeves, Kris Leonard, Tomas Lowe, Jack Dakin – and their manager Craig Tarry were all killed when their car left a bridge in Sweden in February 2016.

Tickets for the event are on sale now via a variety of methods at www.riverreevesfoundation.org/rivfest-2017

Organisers say that for every ticket sold, £1 will be donated to the We Love Manchester campaign set up by the British Red Cross and Manchester City Council in support of victims of the recent terrorist attack in the city.

Proceeds will also go to The River Reeves Foundation, which will be working with bus company Arriva NW to build over the coming years a school to school bus fleet that will include a recording studio bus, animation bus, theatre bus, dance bus, and a creative arts bus as well as single decker buses, providing mental health support for youngsters across Warrington's schools as part of the Future in Mind initiative.

The buses will tour schools and provide inspiration to youngsters, many from disadvantaged backgrounds as well as wider support for those struggling to access mental health support.

Following their tribute to Viola Beach at Glastonbury in 2016, Coldplay have been passionate advocates of the charity and are lending their support to the bus project and other ambitious plans the charity has.

Coldplay will have their images over the buses

and have issued the following statement to encourage people to buy a ticket and attend this year's RivFest17: 'If you live anywhere near Warrington, please buy a ticket for Rivfest17 on Saturday 2nd September. It's a fantastic line up, a top day out and a wonderful cause — raising money to realise the dreams of upcoming local talent, all in memory of the great River Reeves.' Coldplay.

Whilst Coldplay won't be performing at this year's RivFest17, the festival organizers are daring to dream that a performance by the band at a future RivFest might one day happen.

The aims of the foundation are to help young people realise their dreams as actors, writers, artists, directors and musicians through school to school support, grants, donations and other payments.

Ex-Mansun frontman returns to the

This summer sees the return of one of British rock's most singular and distinctive voices. This summer, former Mansun frontman Paul Draper released his long-awaited debut solo album Spooky Action. Crafted with the same idiosyncratic songwriting and production that made him a 90's cult hero, the album comes with a more personal perspective, and newfound lust for life.



At the peak of their powers, Mansun were one of the UK's most renowned rock exports - inspiring undying devotion in their fans with a sound so bold it would influence a generation of misfits to pick up guitars and push the envelope. A number one debut album (Attack of the Grey Lantern), a hugely acclaimed boundary pushing

follow-up (Six) and numerous radio-hugging singles (brought together on the peerless Legacy collection). Then in 2003, while recording their fourth album Kleptomania, the band split amid great tension and musical differences. Years of legal battles and strife would follow, but having been in bands since he was 10-years-old, Draper kept on writing.

"We were a Britpop version of the Sex Pistols," says Draper. "Great while it lasted but then imploded magnificently."

However Draper, remained active - writing and producing with the likes of Skunk Anansie's Skin, Menace Beach, The Joy Formidable, as well as his long-term and acclaimed collaborator Catherine AD (aka The Anchoress). However, when he lifted his head above the parapet, the world wanted more - leading fans to start a petition for Draper to unearth his own unreleased tracks and solo material.

"Someone recently told me 'I really loved Mansun because you were like a prog-musical version of The League Of Gentlemen'," laughs Draper. "Make of that what you will. I was just a working class product of the art school system from a small Welsh town. People just think we had good songs. We did so many EPs, played 200 gigs a year, we shook every hand. We never took any fan for granted. Those fans never went away."

Riding on the wave of goodwill, last year saw Draper release two wellreceived EPs through Kscope whilst gaining accolades for his work on the award winning Anchoress album, Confessions of a Romance Novelist.

Now with a huge sold out tour on the horizon, Draper is proud to announce his debut solo album Spooky Action - his most accomplished and autobiographical work to date.

"I had a lot to write about," he admits. "I wrote down all of my thoughts about what happened to me in Mansun, and what happened to me afterwards. It was just another form of therapy.

"It's been a cathartic process. I don't work in a professional manner, I do it to heal something whatever that is. I got a lot of anger out and I'm on the other side of it now. It's taken a lot to get there."

Spooky Action was a project born out of the death of Mansun, shelved as Draper went on to work behind the scenes with like-minded artists. The online fan petition - reported across the music press – forced Draper to revisit dusty solo material. With some older tracks and others written recently in collaboration with Catherine AD, Spooky Action is a portrait of an artist coming to terms with his past but with his heart very set on the future.

"I've dealt with the past; the music was just one of many processes that helped repair me as a person," says Draper. "The music started out quite vengeful and ended in a happy place, just feeling happy and privileged to be able to make an album."

So much so, that Draper is already looking ahead to touring and a follow up solo album. But for now, Draper's just excited to get this record out there and enjoy the 'whole new world' of music in 2017.

"Someone once told me that people in the music industry used to say, 'Don't sign musicians like Paul Draper any more; just get people from stage school backgrounds'. But if you do that, you end up with homogenized music. Where's the fun in that?"

Where indeed? It's so good to have him back.

Top 5 Legal Tips for Holiday Photographers

It's holiday time and that means a lot of what is seen and what is experienced is about to be captured. Holiday photos are not just taken for personal enjoyment, but also some are intended to be used commercially. Because of this, a lot of travellers are on the hunt for the perfect holiday snap. But be warned — different countries, different rules! Soon after their trip, a lot of photographers can get in trouble for not having the proper permission to use their perfect holiday photos. Copytrack have put together the five most important tips that any on-the-go photographer needs to pay attention to!

Tip One "Permission is best: When photographing individuals"

It doesn't matter if you're snapping the holiday makers of Italy or even those hiking in the Carpathian Mountains. In Europe, everyone has the right to private and personal life according to The European Convention of Human Rights (ECHR). Meaning photos that are defamatory towards the individual in public places or in



situations where an individual has reasonable expectation of privacy cannot be made public without their consent. However, the meaning of "Public Places" can vary. Fundamentally, you should always ask for permission before taking a holiday snap — and that's worldwide.

Tip Two "Caution when taking pictures of children"

You have to be extra careful when you want to photograph minors. If you want to reproduce the photo or use it commercially the permission of the parents is needed. You also have to ask the boy or girl for their consent. This applies when he or she is seven years or older and can be legally allowed to make decisions. A court in the UK decided that a publicly made image of a child could interfere with their private life when used without permission, even when the parents are part of the image.

> Tip Three "Attention: Not every tourist attraction can be photographed"



Whoever happily clicks the camera freely should inform themselves of which sites are forbidden to be photographed. Photos of the Eiffel Tower for example can't be shared when it's lit up, as the light installation is legally protected. Here, the socalled "Freedom of Panorama" applies that allows photographers to take pictures in public places. The freedom of panorama varies country to country, so it's always best to check the country's rules before travelling. Each country also has special regulations. In many museums photos are forbidden, like the Van-Gogh-Museum in Amsterdam, as well as similar sites such as the Sistine Chapel. So, keep it in mind to ask before getting the camera out. Military sites are also very well protected. No photos can be taken of army barracks or general military places. In Russia, photos of train stations and airports are a taboo for instance.

Tip Four "Be aware of Aniconism in Muslim countries"

You should inform yourself before travelling to Muslim countries because the Aniconism in Islam forbids photographic representation of people or animals. The interpretation of the forbidden photos differs strongly between each individual land and region — from a complete refusal to a restricted approval. Even if the ban isn't everywhere, before you take any photographs, you should always have the rules in the back of your mind, and ask before taking any photos. Also, be aware: It is not allowed in Arabic countries to take

photos of the Imperial Palace as well as the Imperial Family itself.

Tip Five "Hold the trigger before snapping your holiday treat"

The freshly caught fish is arranged beautifully on the plate, the cocktail is a work of art, the tortillas looks delicious. It's already clear that these photos are going to be uploaded to social media quickly, to make anyone left at home jealous. However, that can cause some trouble! First, because it can be forbidden when it is lavishly displayed. That's because the cook is the copyright holder of the



artwork. You can photograph the art and share it on your social media, but only with the chef's approval. And secondly, due to their code of conduct, it can be forbidden to take photographs in restaurants. In this situation, the camera would be better off staying in your bag.

Celebrating ancient m





Warrington's Paddington Meadows were the venue of a special event when more than 100 local people turned out to help celebrate and raise attention to the UK's meadows, 97 per cent of which have been lost since the Second World War.

The sun shone, families turned out and children were entertained with treasure hunts, quizzes, bug hunts and a display of bats in the area by bat expert Harold Green of the Merseyside and West Lancashire Bat Group. A pipistrelle bat put in an appearance. The highlight for many was the flying of a drone above the meadows linked to a computer.

It attracted a local buzzard into the air fearing a rival, but it was soon satisfied that the drone was harmless and landed.

Interest in local history was satisfied with a photographic display from the New Cut Heritage and Ecology group while tours of the meadows led by rangers to see the oldest water meadow hedge in Cheshire were much appreciated.

Ecology group press officer Anne Price said: "This was the first public event we have organised on the meadows and it was marvellous to have so much public support. The group were pleased that the importance of these ancient meadows is being recognised both locally and now much further afield."

Top 10 worst holiday destinations for illness and accidents revealed

It's that time of year again when many people are jetting off to sunnier spots – however spare a thought for those North-West residents travelling to Spain this summer.

A new study has revealed the top ten worst destinations in Europe for illness and accidents. Spain topped the list as the worst European holiday destination for North-West residents for both sickness and accidents, with over a million cases. This was followed by France and Greece with 472,000 and 458,000 incidents, respectively.

With over 4 million North West residents becoming injured or sick on holiday every year, Manchester-based solicitors, Michael Jefferies Injury Lawyers, found that over half of respondents had suffered from illness or injury whilst holidaying across Europe and a staggering 70% of all incidents took place there.

The top ten places where North West residents got sick and suffered accidents abroad in Europe were:

- 1. Spain 43%
- 2. France 13%
- 3. Greece 12%
- 4. Portugal 9%
- 5. Italy 7%
- 6. Cyprus 4%
- 7. Germany 4%
- 8. Turkey 4%
- 9. Malta 3%

10. Bulgaria – 1%

On average, North West holidaymakers lost over a day and a half of their time away due to sickness and accidents. They expect to be able to claim back an average of £188 for sickness abroad caused by food poisoning. For a minor accident abroad in the hotel or pool they would expect to be claim back an average of £212 in compensation and £471 for a major accident.

Over 40% of respondents who had fallen ill, had done so on an all-inclusive holiday. Michael Jefferies Injury Lawyers receives the majority of its food poisoning claims on package holidays, all-inclusive holidays and cruises, as this is when large groups of holidaymakers are staying together within a contained space. On cruise ships or in holiday resorts, there is also a higher chance of groups of people suffering from food poisoning at a similar time after visiting the same food outlet, or spreading the bug more easily between themselves.

Over 55 most at risk

Interestingly the survey found that from the North West, those who were over 55 were most at risk on holiday with over 1.4 million falling sick and 197,000 having an accident while abroad.

Michael Jefferies, managing director of Michael Jefferies Injury Lawyers comments: "For many of us, going on holiday is the highlight of our year, something we spend months looking forward to. Unfortunately, suffering an injury or becoming sick while away on holiday can ruin the experience and the results show that these are regular occurrences for North-West residents. If this applies to you and your holiday was in the last three years, you may be able to make a claim for compensation and for any time off work you had to take."

Top tips on what to do if you fall ill or have an accident away

- 1. Keep hold of all documentation, such as any receipts for medical expenses and a copy of your medical report from the doctor.
- 2. Make sure you get the details of any witnesses to your illness/injury.
- 3. Report the incident to a travel representative or the hotel manager if it happens in your hotel.

Shakshuka is a dish of poached eggs in a sauce based from tomatoes, chilli ,peppers and onions.

2 Cloves garlic crushed

1 Red pepper and 1 orange pepper thinly sliced

2 Spoons chopped coriander Seasoning / salt fresh pepper

1 Teaspoon chilli flakes (less if want)

kidney beans

1 Stick celery, chopped

1 Big Sweet potato peeled, chopped Half bag washed chopped kale 100g hot chilli cheddar cheese, cubed 170g thick chunked cooked ham (optional for vegetarian)
Six large fresh eggs.
