Around Culcheth's village green, forty colourful gazebos will link the two Gift and Craft Christmas Fayres taking place in the Parish and Methodist Halls, with another link to more stalls and a cafe in the Scout Centre on Jackson Avenue and then on to The Culcheth Centre Art exhibition. The market stalls and surrounding shops will showcase the local traders' fabulous Christmas wares as well as presenting exciting craft and produce stalls from further afield. Jewellery, collectables, antiques, cakes, fabrics, crafts, gift wrapping, boxes, ornaments, flowers, pet supplies, toys, Christmas hampers, winter warmers and much more will be available in a traditional market setting. To beat the cold, hot food stalls, mulled wine, and chestnuts will be available outside, while several cefer, and local while several cafes and local hostelries, will provide indoor warmth and traditional cheer- and, of course, you will find Santa in his Grotto. Across the village there

will be exciting entertainment throughout the day with children's roundabouts, music, including The Infernal Twangers ukulele band, The Culcheth Village Choir, hand-bell ringers and a traditional barrel organ. There will also be a display of police memorabilia and uniforms to try on - plus refreshments and children's crafts at the Scout Centre.

There will be Community Carol Singing in the Methodist Church and the day ends in style at 4.30 when the Parish Council Chairman, helped by Santa, switches on the Culcheth and Glazebury Parish Council Christmas Lights.



TALKS are ongoing in a bid to set up a new neighbourhood forum following the demise of the Warrington East Area Board.

The loss of neighbourhood boards has left a hole in the connectivity enjoyed in the community in the Warrington East area and at the last meeting ever of the East Area Board those present discussed a possible way forward.

way forward. A proposal has been tabled to find out everyone's thoughts on a different approach with many of the advantages that the old board format provided.

The proposed East Neighbourhood Forum would act as a conduit between residents, parish councils, established community groups, the council, police and other stakeholders such as the fire service and NHS. This would allow feedback to be sent to the council and also act as a way of the council and emergency services effectively communicating information to communities and parish councils.

effectively communicating information to communities and parish councils. There is a lot of support for this approach and it is now planned to take the concept to the council and see if it fits in with their way of thinking. It was agreed that a forum seemed like a good way to improve communication between the councils and the community groups so that the area.

Local businessman Paul Taylor said, "There has been a dearth of information and effective communication since the boards were dissolved. They have been changed into a single group that meets four times a year just to deal with the distribution of the Community Initiative fund, and only has councillors and one member of Warrington Voluntary Action Group sitting on it.

Action Group sitting on it. "Taylor Business Park has offered to pay for any admin costs of these meetings as they are at the moment but we hope that it will be a model that the council approves of and may roll out to the other areas that previously held Neighbourhood Board meetings.

may roll out to the other areas that previously held Neighbourhood Board meetings. "The boards were a vital channel of communication and helped to direct local groups towards funding available available through the Community Initiative Fund. There is £60,000 available in grants from £50-£3,000 but not many organisations are aware of the changes that have taken place. "Community groups and charities in Culcheth in particular did very well out of the neighbourhood board's funding and they were invaluable

 With the colder weather and
decrease of natural foods wild birds will need feeding regularly, especially with high calorie fatty foods
Simon Bax, Plant Area Specialist

- There are a surprising number of plants that perform well over the winter period, often they are well scented - examples include Sarcococca, Hamamelis and <u>Mahonia</u>
- Areas of the border, that are currently empty, can be dug over and enriched with blended manure for next year's planting
- Cut down any herbaceous plants that have finished flowering and that do not have a strong winter structure. Weed and fork gently between them
