# <u>Editor's Comment</u>

WE started the year in this column by complaining at the ease with which waste disposal companies appear to be able to manipulate planning law – and the borough council – to obtain permission to carry on tipping on sites which should have been closed and restored to nature.

Our complaints then were directed at Biffa, who should have completed the Risley Landfill Site last October but who, despite losing an appeal which cost the borough council £75,000, have managed to gain another three years to complete and restore the site.

Now another similar manipulation of the planning system has come to light on our doorstep - this time by Collier Waste, at their site off Moss Side Lane, Rixton.

They should have restored their site to nature by January but, because it is not completed have been granted

another 12 months for the almost unbelievable reason that they need the extra time to prepare an application for another six years!

#### Objections

This despite the objections of nearby residents sick and tired of noise, dust, disturbance, etc.

Planners argue that the companies should be given extra time because the tip is not completed and cannot be left as an eyesore. Well, that is true, of course.

But the waste disposal companies



know from the day they win planning consent the date by which they must finish. In the case of Collier Waste, they have known since 1996. In the absence of a shortage of materials to tip, it is clear companies fail to get the job done on time in the sure and certain knowledge they will be granted extra time.

Surely the planning authorities should be monitoring progress on landfill sites and have the power to enforce closure within the approved timescales?

They are quick enough to act when Joe Bloggs extends his house by an inch or two too much.

## Council opposes prison plan

CULCHETH and Glazebury Parish Council has added its voice to the chorus objecting to any plan for a prison on the giant Omega development site.

Members agreed to write to the borough council calling for the original vision for Omega - as a high tech business park - to be retained.

# Skiing boost for Samue

#### A CULCHETH boy with cerebral palsy is boosting his skills and strength by skiing trips partly funded by a local charity.

Four years ago Samuel Kletz, 12, went on a ski course to Austria with the help of a grant of about \$500 from Culcheth Educational Trust - which offers small grants for educational purposes to individuals living in the village.

In February, he received a further £250 grant from the charity, to make a second trip to Schladming in Austria to improve his skills.

His parents Robert and Miriam, of Bent Lane, went on the trip with him and his sister went on a school skiing trip to a different resort.

Samuel, a pupil of Birchwood High School, went on his first ski course in Austria with the Uphill Ski Club - now called Disability Śnowsport UK. Robert said: "Samuel did very

well on that course. He did so well, in fact, that the following year we went on an ordinary holiday, thinking he would be fine '-but he lost his nerve.

About 18 months ago Samuel had an operation to lengthen the tendons in his leg and had a bone graft in his ankle. He recovered well and had skiing lessons with Disability Snowsport in Manchester.

"We considered Robert said: consolidating what he learned with another foreign trip with Disability Snowsport but they were expensive." The family found an independent

adaptive ski school in Austria, and

arranged a private holiday for February half term. "Of course, with the appalling value of the pound these days, the cost of the holiday proved to be equally appalling " acid Pabat appalling," said Robert.

The family contacted Culcheth Education Trust and it helped with a second donation, meaning the family could afford the trip "without too much scrimping." Miriam said Samuel enjoyed his

recent trip to Schladming and the



family is "really grateful" to the trust. She said: "The trip was absolutely brilliant and Samuel has made excellent progress. He can now ski with us.

"Skiing is good for his personal development, co-ordination, balance and stamina.


# Anger grows over 'selfish' parking

ANGER is growing among residents of Shaw Street, Culcheth, over selfish and irresponsible parking outside their homes.

Motorists are parking both sides of the road and blocking driveways of an evening sometimes "trapping" people in their own homes. A number of complaints have been made to Culcheth and Glazebury Parish Council with some residents calling for yellow lines to be introduced to stop all parking. Coun Sue Bland said: "The situation can get quite bad at night. Motorists are parking

on the pavement, causing obstructions for pedestrians. Some people have found themselves unable to get off their own drivers because of inconsiderate parking. One of the solutions being looked at is the introduction of yellow lines."

The parish council has raised the issue with Warrington Borough Council.



# 'shared vision

"We see a parish plan as providing significant benefits to Culcheth and Glazebury.

"We will be having a stall on Community Day and after that we will hold a public meeting to get things moving. Other areas have benefited greatly from having parish plans and we think Culcheth and Glazebury will also benefit.

The parish council has had a presentation from Bron Kerrigan, parish plan development officer with Cheshire Community Action, which will help with the scheme. Warrington Borough Council is also willing to support the project, which will be a "first" for the borough.

A steering group will be set up,

made up of volunteers' from the community and representatives of local organisations. The plan will take about two

years to develop a shared vision for the future , resulting in an action plan.

In other areas, parish plans have resulted in villages benefiting from developments varying from a new £250,000 village hall to launching parenting classes to combat youth hooliganism.

#### In the greenhouse
