Éditor's Comment

IT seems somewhat ironic that if the super new £28 million Culcheth High School had never been built, and staff and pupils were still soldiering on in the old building, there would now be nothing standing in the way of what the governors clearly see as the next stage in the school's development - academy status.

Last September we reported that the school's bid for academy status could only go ahead if agreement could be reached on the repayment of a £600,000 loan from Warrington Borough Council.

Now it seems that agreement cannot be reached - so the proposed conversion to an academy has had to be put on hold.

If the new school had not been built, the loan would not have been

Road safety operation

POLICE joined forces with other agencies to target vehicles travelling along the A574 Warrington Road at Culcheth. The operation lasted for four hours and involved public protection officers from the borough council, HM Customs and Excise and the Vehicle and Operator Services Agency. Vehicles were given a thorough examination during the operation led by local police officers. The aim was to make sure motorists are complying with road safety legislation. PCSO Steve Dodd, said: "We were checking the road safety of vehicles, driving without wearing a seatbelt, drivers using a mobile phone while driving as well as tax discs and insurance. "A total of 19 vehicles were stopped for drivers not wearing their seat belts and dealt with accordingly and one car with no insurance was seized."

Re-surfacing work to start - at long last! WORK has started on resurfacing one of Culcheth's bumpiest roads -after a wait of three years.

Borough council contractors were due to start work in Lodge Drive, between Common Lane and Culcheth Hall Drive, on March 5. The project is expected to take about five weeks but to minimise disruptions

to residents, motorists and shopkeepers, it will be carried out in phases, between 8.30am and 4.30pm, Monday to Friday. Lodge Drive is pitted with potholes, largely caused by the last two severe winters. A diversion will be signposted via Common Lane and Warrington Road, Letters have been sent to residents and businesses in the immediate area and information boards also erected on site.

Labour campaigner Chris Vobe says he has been fighting for three years

to get the work carried out. He said: "This work is long overdue and much deserved for residents along Lodge Drive and the surrounding area. For years, we have had to suffer with a patchwork of pot holes that have left this part of the village looking unkempt and uncared for."

Alan contracted a virus at the age of 18 while at university in the early 70s and the consequences resulted in life viewed from the confines of a wheelchair.

Members were amazed at Alan's positive and jovial attitude. He even said he was glad disability had struck at the age of 18, as 'teenagers have a much more optimistic view of the future! Primary school teaching was

his chosen profession until retirement and he told numerous highly amusing tales relating to the children's attitude to his disability. There were also many stories about life in general for wheelchair users, the prime example - where people talk to the "carer", rather than to the person in the chair, although Alan did say that this attitude is not as prevalent as in the past. He also stated that in general everyone was extremely kind and helpful, even was the most unlikely members of society, and that disabled facilities had extensively improved over the years.

Novel experience for youngsters


YOUNGSTERS at Culcheth High School were inspired to create their own Gothic graphic novel when they were visited by a local author.


