# Editor's Comment



**EVERYTHING comes to those who wait! At long last a lower speed limit is to be introduced on a Culcheth road which has been a constant source of danger for many years.**

Borough Council highways chiefs have agreed to a request from Culcheth and Glazebury Parish Council to extend the 30 mph speed

limit on Broseley Lane beyond Broseley Bridge where, currently, it is 40mph.

For years, the parish council and nearby residents have been asking for the limit to be reduced because of the number of motorists travelling at 40mph - and probably faster - who fail to negotiate a tricky bend and end up in a field.

We understand one long-suffering resident has a veritable archive of photographs of vehicles which suffered this fate!

The problem will not be completely solved, of course. There are plenty of drivers who think speed limits are there to be broken and they will probably continue to end up in the

field. But the evidence is that more drivers observe, or nearly observe, a 30mph limit than do a 40mph one. So things should improve.

The work is due to be carried out within the next three or four months - and it can't come too soon.

## Work experience

CULCHETH and Glazebury Parish Council is to consider taking on a young person for work experience.

The council has been told of a scheme where people aged 18-24 who have been unemployed for 12 months can be given work experience with parish councils.

They are to investigate funding opportunities.

Culcheth, Croft and Glazebury are covered by three PCSOs - Sarah Bradburne, Stephen Dodd and Maurizio Lucchesi and they have all become familiar figures in the area.

PCSO Dodd gave a report on the monthly crime figures at the meeting. There were 11 instances of anti-social behaviour, one burglary, nine thefts and 17 instances of suspicious activity - including one unfortunate resident who was reported after being spotted climbing back into his own house after accidentally locking himself out!

During the month, more than 40 motorists were caught exceeding the speed limit in Warrington Road, Common Lane and Mustard Lane.

## Village green drainage plan hits snag

**THE £33,000 plan to improve drainage on Culcheth's village green has run into a snag.**

Environmental charity WREN has turned down Culcheth and Glazebury Parish Council's application for a grant - leaving the council some £23,000 short of being able to fund the project.

It had been hoped work would start shortly after Community Day.

Coun Keith Bland (right), chairman of the council's environment sub-committee said: "This is bad news."

"We have about £10,000 in the bank for the work but it is not enough. This is work which, quite frankly, needs to be done."

Flooding has been a major problem on The Green for some years. At one time a "pond" formed which even attracted ducks!

Sodden turf has frequently caused

difficulties on Community Day.

The council is now to seek funding from other sources.

But if none is forthcoming they will consider increasing the local precept to pay for the work.

Coun Bland said: "We would consult with the village before doing anything, however. It would probably cost each council tax payer about £5 for one year and we already have one of the lowest precepts in the borough."

"But we would still ask the people before going ahead."

## Homes approved on youth club site

PLANNING chiefs at Warrington have given the go-ahead for a controversial development opposed by nearby residents even though it will remove an eyesore building.

Members of the borough council's development control committee have approved proposals for 10 two-storey dwellings in Church Lane, Culcheth.

The site involved is currently occupied by buildings formerly used as Culcheth Youth Base which are now unoccupied and in a state of disrepair.

Nearby residents complained bitterly about noise and general disturbance caused by the youth club when it was in operation.

But some also objected to the proposed new development because of parking and traffic issues, high density building on a small site and a loss of privacy.

Culcheth and Glazebury Parish Council also opposed the scheme.

Outline planning consent was granted two years ago but detailed permission has now been approved.

The committee was told finance generated by the original scheme had been used to help fund a replacement youth facility at the new Culcheth High School, giving social and community benefits.

As well as improving the character of the area with the removal of the existing, unsightly buildings, the proposal would not give rise to significant crime or safety concerns nor have any great impact on the living conditions of nearby residents.

## THE STYLES FILES styles and co

### Budget 2010

Alistair Darling's Budget on 24 March may not have been the most eventful and, depending on the outcome of the General Election, might soon be superseded early in the new parliament.

However in this edition of Styles Files, we cover two relevant tax reductions which were announced and one tax increase which warrants investigation to see if the tax charge can be mitigated:

#### 1) Increase in Annual Investment Allowance

From 6 April 2010, businesses can get 100% tax relief per annum on their first £100,000 of qualifying capital expenditure, up from £50,000 previously. Qualifying expenditure of over £100,000 will receive capital allowances at the normal 20% rate.

This increase in the allowance is clearly intended to encourage businesses to commit to capital expenditure programmes and business owners should take this accelerated tax relief in to account when calculating the real cost of investment in qualifying assets.

#### 2) Entrepreneurs' Relief

Also from 6 April 2010, capital gains on the disposal of qualifying businesses, shares or those assets used in business will be subject to an effective rate of tax of 10% on the first £2 million of gain. The limit (which is a lifetime limit per individual) was previously £1 million.

This change is expected to encourage entrepreneurs to operate in

the UK rather than overseas.

#### 3) Increases in national insurance

The Labour Government's proposal to increase both employers' and employees' national insurance by 1% will be introduced in April 2011. The Conservative Party have indicated that the increase will not be introduced at all if they come to power.

However, whatever occurs over the coming months, national insurance is and will remain a significant cost of employment. There is scope for employers to reduce national insurance liabilities, which are payable by both themselves and their employees, through salary sacrifice schemes. Such schemes need to set up compliantly and include the payment of pension contributions by the employer on behalf of the employee, as a sacrifice of salary, thereby saving the national insurance.

The above are only examples of the matters covered in the Budget and a full review of you or your business's tax affairs may be appropriate.
