Ironman Ian takes on his biggest challenge

CULCHETH businessman Ian Barker, who has raised thousands of pounds for charity by taking part in marathons and other endurance tests is to tackle his biggest challenge yet - Ironman UK.

Ian, owner of Le Brunch sandwich bar, will be raising money for the Scope disability charity.

Ironman UK is a testing one day event consisting of a 3.8km swim, 112-mile bike ride and a full marathon. It takes place at Bolton on July 22.

Ian said: "I will be raising money for Scope because I like to raise money for a different charity each time I test my body."

"The reason I do this is because I am fortunate not to be directly linked to a charity as all my family have a clean bill of health."

Over the last four years, Ian has taken part in 10k runs, half marathons, marathons and triathlons raising money for charities such as East Cheshire Hospice, Leonard Cheshire Disability, Bobath Centre, Steve Prescott Foundation, Christies, St Rocco's Hospice, Alzheimers and Willowbrook Hospice.

In total he has raised about £5,000.



Residents fight to save building society

HUNDREDS of people have signed a petition to try and save the Culcheth branch of the Cheshire Building Society.

The petition, launched by newsagent Janet Lee, calls on the society to reconsider its decision to close the branch on Jackson Avenue.

Among those signing the protest was borough and parish councillor Chris Vobe.

He said: "Cheshire Building Society is a well-used facility here in the village. The decision to close this branch is just barmy! That's why this petition is so important, because it shows the strength of feeling from people here against these plans.

"I'm pleased to have added my name, and I'd encourage everyone to take a few moments to add

theirs when they visit the Jackson Avenue shops. In these tough times, it is important that we make sure services and facilities are not taken away from our community.

"We can't force Cheshire Building Society to change their minds, but we can certainly make the case."

Cllr Vobe pledged to write to Cheshire Building Society to ask them to reconsider their decision, and also called for one of their senior representatives to visit the village to accept the petition.

Petition forms are available for Culcheth, Glazebury and Croft residents in shops throughout the village.



Jim, 80 this year, seeks old school pals



A RETIRED police officer who was a wartime pupil at the old Culcheth Secondary Modern School is trying to get in touch with any old school pals who may remember him.

Jim Sutton, who is 80 this year, left the school around 1945 and later left the village to join the Royal Navy, where he served for 12 years.

His family lived in Warrington Road while his grandparents lived in Withington Avenue.

Jim made a pilgrimage to the old school when he attended a reunion shortly before the old building was demolished. But he didn't meet up with anyone he knew - nor anyone of his generation.

He joked: "I suppose they could all be in the

graveyard now. But if there is anyone still around in Culcheth who remembers me, I would love to meet them."

He remembers pupils named Green, Clark, Unsworth, Whitfield, Taylor, Mort and Lewis.

There were also the Andrews Sisters - but not the singers, he jokes.

Whether your taste is for a Bird's Nest special, stir fried Char Sui in Szechuan Sauce or the Chef's Special pan friend Sea Bream, you are in for a treat.

Add to that the friendly welcome from Matthew and his staff and you have the ideal place for an enjoyable evening out.

The menu is expansive and, of course, includes all the traditional Chinese favourites. Everything is freshly cooked and tastefully presented so you won't go far wrong whether you go for an old favourite or discover something different.

For two or more people there are set two and three course banquets which offer a chance to sample a variety of dishes but for those who want new experiences there are the Chef's Specials, a range of Bird's Nest dishes, Malaysian Satay, Kung Po - a variety of stir fried sweet and spicy dishes with nuts - and Spicy Singapore Vermicelli Noodles.

An ice cream dessert rounded off an enjoyable meal.
