From struggling graduate to entrepreneur

Former Fashion Student Rebecca Scott decided to tackle the recession head on by transforming her university project into a real online business.

Her brand “NEU Apparel” is a trend led, affordable online gym wear for women.

After graduating from The University of Huddersfield last June and spending a summer away, 24 year old Rebecca from Appleton, Warrington, struggled to find a job within fashion, and after three months with no luck and knock back after knock back, she decided to turn her final year project into a reality.

“I was beginning to give up on my dream of working within fashion marketing after countless declined applications and offers of unpaid internships,” said the fashion marketing graduate. “It was then when I chose to not let it stop me and decided to make a go of it on my own.”

Rebecca had previously created NEU Apparel as a project in her final year of university, after discovering there was a gap in the market for affordable but fashionable gym wear. ‘I am really into fitness myself, and find that gym wear is so overpriced and unappealing, this is what made me look into starting my own gym wear brand which won’t destroy your bank balance but is on trend and fashionable. There’s nothing else like it out there’.

Rebecca used her wages doing temp work to set up NEU Apparel, buying in wholesale garments and having them altered and printed.

She even managed to score a free professional photo shoot by calling in favours from a friend of a friend who kindly offered to help, and used her friend’s fitness studio as a set.



The brand was all set up on minimal funds and Rebecca (pictured top right) has relied on social media to get it out there and build up a following.

Best friend, Stacy Doyle, an interior design graduate, has now also come on board as the creative director. The pair have high hopes for NEU Apparel, and are already working on their summer collection.

Shedding light where there was darkness

Time was when you could tell how bright a light bulb was by its wattage.

You could choose from a 40, 60, 75 or 100 watt bulb and have a rough idea of how bright it would be.

That was when we all used the, apparently, inefficient incandescent light bulbs. The introduction of Halogen, CFL and LED technology has made things a little more confusing however.

So its time to say goodbye to the Watt and hello to the Lumen.

A Lumen is a standard unit of light as perceived by the human eye. Essentially, it tells you how

bright something is, unlike a watt, which is actually a measurement of energy consumption or output.

The lighting industry has standardised ways that it measures the total emission of light from a produce and included it on most packaging.

But for the benefit of those who find the changes confusion, a quick and easy guide to shed light on the problem is as follows:

The old 25 watt bulb is equivalent to 200 lumens, a 40 watt bulb equals 400 lumens, 60 watts equal 700 lumens and a 100 watt bulb equals 1300 lumens.

A Bloomin' Lovely Pudding

Now spring is in bloom, this pretty as a picture dessert is simple yet elegant, with a bouquet of sweet potato and lavender flavours.

Created by celebrity chef and sweet potato lover Felice Tocchini, the recipe makes enough sponge puddings to feed the whole family, and could be a delightful end to a roast dinner on Easter Sunday. Bunches of flowers can be replaced with a subtle sprinkling of dried lavender to help to decorate the table with the colours of spring.

Sweet potatoes are also low in fat, high in fibre, and are full of anti-oxidants, vitamin A, C and beta-carotene, making this pudding much more virtuous.

The Love Sweet Potatoes campaign is designed to tell consumers about sweet potatoes and of all the different ways they can be used in everyday meals. The North Carolina US farming family at Scott Farms is behind the campaign and has been growing sweet potatoes for over four generations. They are now the largest importer of sweet potatoes into the UK.

Sweet Potato and Lavender Sponge Pudding

Makes 6 (¼ pint/140ml puddings)

Per serving: 453kcal, 5.4g protein, 26g fat, 11.2g saturates, 53.2g carbs, 28.1g sugar, 1.6g fibre, 0.6g salt, 451mcg vitamin A

Ingredients:

100g butter, plus extra for greasing
75g caster sugar
75g brown sugar
50ml vegetable oil
2 eggs
150g self-raising flour, plus extra for dusting
½ tsp chopped dried or fresh lavender
200g sweet potatoes, grated

Method:

1. Grease 6 pudding basins with butter then dust with flour, shaking out any excess.
2. Beat together the butter, sugars and oil.
3. Add the eggs, one at a time, beating after each addition.
4. Fold in the flour and lavender.
5. Add the sweet potatoes and combine.



6. Pour the mixture into the prepared pudding basins. Cover each pudding with aluminium foil and cook in a steamer for about 40-45 minutes or until cooked (if using a single large basin the cooking time will increase to about 1 hour and fifteen minutes).
7. Remove the puddings from the moulds and serve with a dollop of crème fraîche.

Tips:

- Lavender can be replaced with any other spice that you like.
- These freeze well, and can be warmed up in a microwave.
- If you do not have a steamer cover the bottom of a deep roasting tray with kitchen paper, place the puddings on the paper and fill the tray with water half way up the pudding moulds. Cover the tray with foil and place in a preheated oven 180°C/gas mark 4 for 40-45 minutes.

Note: Felice owns two award-winning restaurants in Worcestershire, works at the Novelli Academy alongside Jean Christophe Novelli, and has appeared on a number of TV programmes such as The One Show.

'A future continually breaking the boundaries of fused glass design' is how Mark envisages his progression in the art world.

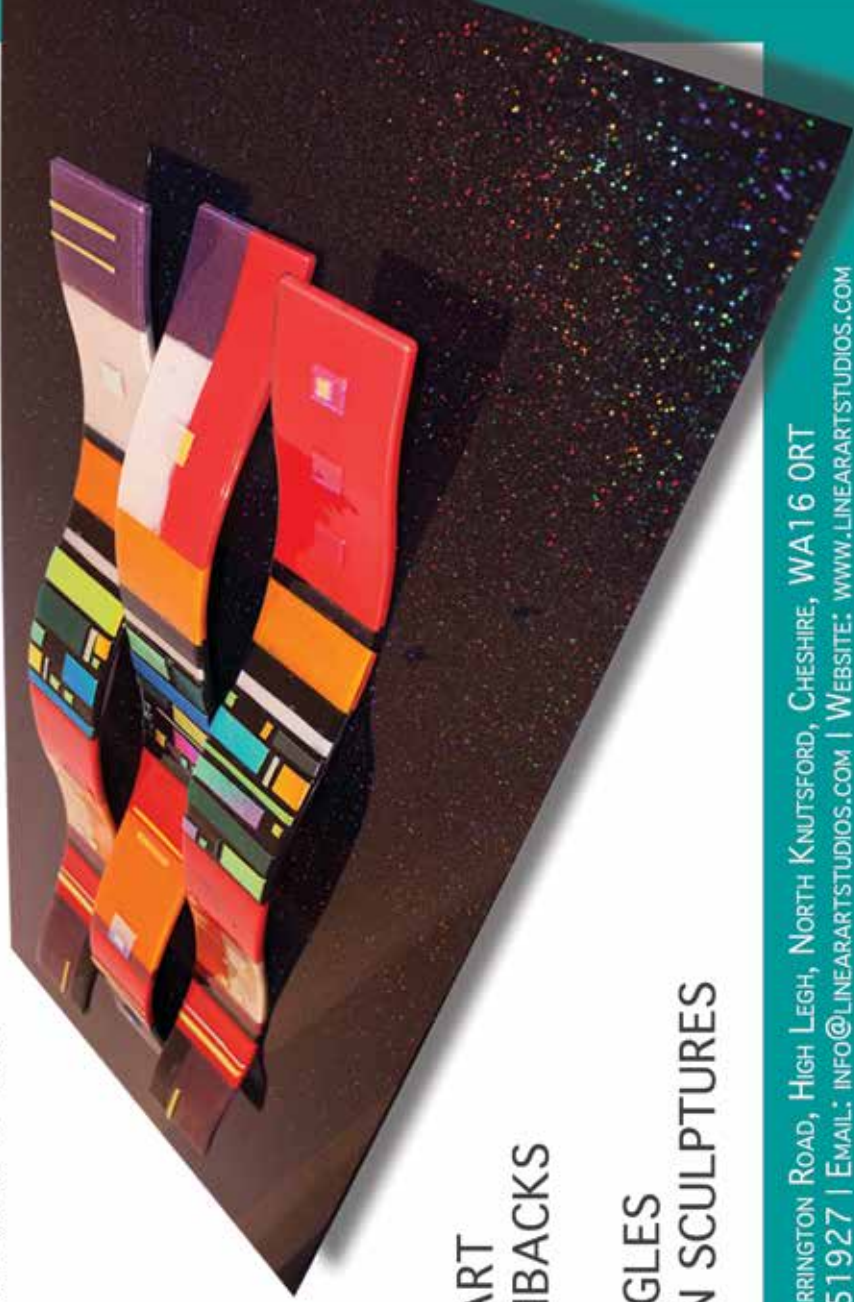
His art auction value continues to increase to levels above even Marks wildest expectations and one customer in 2009 enjoyed a 300% return on one of his pieces.
