WHEN Lymm schoolgirl Ellie Dibben was given a session in a recording studio as a birthday present by her parents last June, they all thought it was just a bit of fun.

But the birthday gift could turn out to be a ticket to fame for the 11-year old who loves to sing.

The tracks she recorded sounded so good, they were passed from family to friends. Just months later her CD was picked up by two radio stations and she's been talent spotted by 1960s music legend PJ Proby. He asked to meet Ellie in

September, after a relative sent him the CD, and invited her to rehearse with him at the studios in his house in the Cotswolds

Now she'll duet with him at a Christmas dinner for The Heritage Foundation at The Marriot Hotel, in London on November 21, alongside other stars from the era. Ellie's mum Carolyn said: "Ellie has

always loved singing, ever since she was a toddler. We haven't particularly pushed her in that direction but it's all she wants to do.

"As soon as she gets home from school, she's downloading backing scribol, site s advantaging backing tracks and practicing lyrics – after she's done her homework of course! We bought her a session in a recording studio for her birthday because we thought she'd enjoy it but it just snowballed from there.

If just snowbailed from inere. "She has a good voice for country music - it has a Dolly Parton twang -but she likes pop too. Her favourites are Taylor Swift and Miley Cyrus." PJ Proby, who has performed with greats like Johnny Cash and Buddy. Holly, was moved by Ellie's version of

"Butterfly Fly Away" – a duet which Miley Cyrus sings with her dad Billy Ray. They'll sing the duet at the concert as well as the Everley Brothers' "Bye Bye Love" and Ellie will

also sing three solo songs. It will be the first time Ellie has performed live in front of an audience performed live in front of an audience that isn't family and friends. Instead, the audience will be packed with music industry insiders including Robin Gibb, of the Bee Gees. Carolyn said: "PJ thinks Ellie will be spotted by an agent when she sings in London. We have been approached by a managament

in London. We have been approached by a management company already and we're meeting with them soon to see what they have to sav

Ellie is also busy writing some of her own songs but she hasn't recorded any yet.



It was in June last year that the family - Tony, 36, Natalie, 34, Molly,8 and Sam, 5, set out on the biggest adventure of their lives, without a clue to what

lay ahead. They are back now - with new baby Poppy and the book, which tells of a crazy, hilarious summer spent Down Under.

It is described as the true story of a burnt out family, bitten by the credit crunch, bogged down by nanny state legislation, collapsing under the burden that your life is flying by with your kids growing up fast, together with the realisation that your career has stalled, while knowing that you only have the duration of the school holidays to play with! 





A56 safety campaign gathers pace

THE campaign for a safer A56 Higher Lane through Lymm is gathering momentum.

Numerous Higher Lane residents attended a meeting of the parish council and heard Coun Ian Marks leader of the borough council - agree that a residents' group could work with the parish council and the highways department on ideas to slow down traffic when the road is resurfaced next year. A number of measures have

already been agreed. A 40mph limit is to be introduced between Oughtrington Lane and the boundary with Cheshire East.

Other speed reductions are proposed at the Jolly Thresher junction (B5'159).

The campaign group has put forward a number of ideas for

improving safety. These include "gateways" indicating the change from a country to a residential road at both ends of the village, a pedestrian crossing, requests to residents to ensure hedges are kept cut back to ensure the full width of pavements can be used, requests to visitors and tradespeople not to obstruct pavements with their vehicles and a check on drains before the resurfacing is carried out. Mini roundabouts at the junction of Oughtrington Lane and, possibly, Grammar School Road, to slow down traffic. The residents' aroun has set up a

planning consent for the shutters.



Search for piece of missing history

LYMM Royal British Legion president Ray Massey (pictured inset) has appealed for help in tracing a bit of the village's history, which has 'gone missing'.

It was a brass plaque which used to hang in the old drill hall in Booths Hill Road and bore the names of members of "H" (Lymm) Company of the 3rd Volunteer Battery of the Cheshire Regiment who served in the South African War, 1900-1902

Many years ago, Ray acquired a photocopy of the plaque and discovered it recently when looking through some old Legion memorabilia. The drill hall dated from before World War 1 and was also used for local dances and it was

there that Ray's father, Arthur, met his mother,

Gladys. Ray has a photograph of himself with his parents, taken 81 years ago, when they were on holiday in Blackpool. The drill hall had many owners, according to Ray, including Mr and Mrs Fox, from Oughtrington, who later converted into a cinema cinema.

As a youngster, Ray used to go to the cinema on a Saturday afternoon to what was called the

"Five Penny Rush." After the cinema closed it became a health club and later the building was largely destroyed by fire. It was rebuilt and is now a pre-school.

But it is the missing plaque that concerns Ray. He believes it should hang in St Mary's Church with other plaques from the two World Wars, etc

erc. The photocopy shows that the plaque bore the names of Corporal John Clare, Private Harry Leigh, Lance Corporal James Ogden, Private James Gilberts, 2nd Lieutenant T. Ridgway, Private Harold Clare and Private William Lowndes.

It was unveiled by Colonel A.E. Ommanney, officer commanding the 22nd Regimental District on July 17, 1903. Ray recalls that James Ogden and William Loundes were related and lived in Rushgreen Road. They were builders and built a "Bible Changel" on Purch Crace Perced which is pour a Chapel" on Rush Green Road which is now a house

If the old plaque cannot be found, Ray wonders if anyone could make and engrave a replica which could be hung in the church.




