

# Centre friends need to raise the roof!

A LOCAL Community Centre has launched an appeal to find friends and raise £35k to safeguard its future after freezing weather damaged its roof beyond repair.

Unless it can raise enough cash for a new roof, Oughtrington Community Centre may have to close, leaving many of the clubs and facilities it provides under threat.

The Centre's management team wants to replace the roof and re-hang the original bell in the tower but quotes from local traders have come in at around \$356.

interiorism local traders have come in at around £35k.

Andrew Wilson, chairman, said: "The roof has come to the end of its natural life and the recent frosty weather has done a lot of damage. Tiles are now falling off. It's going to be a big problem soon."

He said: "It's a common misconception that we're entirely funded by Lymm Parish Council. We're not. We receive a grant of around £5k a year, which just about covers the heating bill. Our running costs alone are over £18k a year.

"It's difficult to ask the local community for more money as they've already been very generous, helping us to raise £15,000 for urgent repairs last year.

"But if people don't mobilise now, there is a chance that this facility won't be here in the future. That will affect everyone in the community, from the older residents who meet at the lunch club twice a week to ladies who take dance classes there, as well as the Scouts and Beaver groups.

who take dance classes there, as well as the Scouts and Beaver groups. "This could also mean the end of the pre-school and Sure Start meetings. This not only impacts parents and children who use the Centre now but those who may be relying on this facility in the future "

relying on this facility in the future."
"Now they hope to set up a network of 'Friends' – a bank of willing volunteers who can help with the fundraising as well as tidying up and basic maintenance

and basic maintenance.

Andrew said: "We're looking for all levels of involvement –from those who can offer a couple of hours a month to someone who would like to take on a proactive role in coming up with ideas and leading the fundraising. We will also be arranging the first regular monthly Sunday morning "working party", for early Feb 09."

Around 50 people have already expressed an interest in joining and will meet on January 20 at a Burns Night-themed event to come up with ideas.

The event will also be an opportunity to say goodbye to Duncan Scott, one of the founder members of the group of locals who bought the centre and raised the money to extend the West End.

# Charity pioneer receives MBE

A LYMM mum has been awarded an MBE in the New Years Honours list in recognition of over 30 years of work for children born with lower limb conditions.

Charity pioneer Sue Banton set up a helpline in her attic after her son Daniel was born with club feet. Seven years later STEPS became a national

years later STEPS became a national registered charity.

Now in its 30th year, the charity supports 2,000 families a year who are affected by a lower limb condition (including Developmental Dysplasia of the Hip (DDH) and Club Foot) and would otherwise have nowhere to turn.

The helpline has now grown to include a wealth of information, a family contacts register and doctor database. plus the www.steps-charity.org.uk, hosts an invaluable forum where stories are

swapped, fundraising events are organised and support is given.

Sue has been a driving force in ensuring children get the most appropriate treatment and continues to be the strategic mind behind the charity.

Sue said: "30 years ago I battled alone to support my son and challenge the accepted procedures and attitudes. Dan had his first operation when he was just seven weeks old and I felt very alone and decided I didn't want another parent to feel that way.

"I am honored to receive this MBE but I could not have done it without the dedication and hard work of everyone involved with STEPS. As we celebrate our 30th anniversary we



will continue to help families not only in the UK, but around the world, and ensure they are supported in their time of need.

Another Lymm woman Donna Marie Hough, also received an MBE for services to health care in her role as Dental Workforce Development lead for Dental Care Professionals.

# Parking ban proposed

WARRINGTON Borough Council proposes to make an order prohibiting parking on a stretch of the A56 at Lymm.

parking on a stretch of the A56 at Lymm.

The order will affect the south side of Booths Hill Road from its junction with Highfield Road for a distance of 225 metres in an easterly direction. Parking will also be prohibited in Highfield Road from its junction with Booths Hill Road for a distance of 13.7 metres in a southerly direction.

Details of the proposals, together with plans showing the restricted areas, can be seen at the council's legal services section at Quattro Building, New Town House, Buttermarket Street, Warrington.

Any representations, either in support or objecting to the proposals, must be made in writing to the legal services section by January 21 and objections must specify the grounds on which they are made.

### Taking your pet abroad - some notes

Now that Christmas is over, many of you will begin to start thinking about your summer holidays in order to banish the winter blues. Did you know that the pet travel scheme allows you to take your beloved pet on holiday with you?

Your pet must conform with all the conditions outlined below:

- A microchip must be implanted under the skin- this ensures your animal can be permanently identified.
- Vaccination against rabies is required with an approved
- A blood test must be taken 1 month after vaccination- this is to make sure your pet has responded to the vaccine. If the animal does not respond then it can be re vaccinated and tested again.
- · Your pet can't enter the UK from abroad until six months after a successful blood test was taken.
- A PETS passport is required signed by a DEFRA appointed vet that confirms the conditions have been met.
- ALWAYS PLAN AHEAD, it will take at least 8 months to comply with the requirements of the scheme.



Check carefully with the import requirements of your destination. The DEFRA website is useful: www.defra.gov.uk.

If you decide to take your pet abroad then bring them down to Lymm Veterinary Surgery where we can get them started on the scheme. Happy travelling!



They hope to build a purpose built Scout and Guide Community building and Barclays have offered to pay an additional £750 towards their total.






