Editor's Comment

THE decision by Lymm High School's new head teacher Angela Walsh to stamp her authority on the school with new look uniforms certainly seems to have caused a storm of protest.

Lymm Life magazine and warrington-worldwide website have been inundated with comments, the vast majority opposed to the new ouffits.

If the school's consultation with parents has been anything like its response to Lymm Life's attempts to get any comment regarding this major issue, I can only say it must have been

pretty appalling.
Despite several phone calls and messages left with reception and email communication, the school and Miss Walsh have remained tight lipped on this issue – well that was the case by the time we went to press – when they had had the best part of a week to respond to our messages.

Pupils have already staged several sit down protests and I know for a fact many parents have contacted the school to raise their concerns.

While pupil's opposition to the style of the proposed new uniforms is one thing, more importantly the school could actually be in breach of competition laws if they press ahead as the sole distributors of the uniforms.

I am not a legal expert but from my own research I have discovered that "Schools or retailers that have exclusive contracts with suppliers may in principle be subject to enforcement action under Chapter I of the Competition Act 1998, on the grounds that these exclusive agreements may restrict competition between retailers to supply uniform."

If anything we have reported is inaccurate the school have only

themselves to blame!

Joe is well known in the village for his work with lymm History Society and the Lymm Festivities Committee.







Things that you should remember

IF you are planning on bringing a new puppy or kitten home this summer, there are some things that you should remember to do:

Vaccination

Vaccination

All puppies should be vaccinated at 8 weeks with a booster vaccination at 10 weeks. Kittens should be vaccinated at 8-9 weeks and 12 weeks. Annual vaccination should be carried out thereafter.

Worming

Worming

Both puppies and kittens should be wormed with a reputable product once a month for the first six months of their life. Routine worming should then be carried out once every three months. Treating your pets for worms is particularly important as worms can be passed on from pets to humans.

It is easy to treat your new pet with a spot on flea treatment which usually only needs to be applied once every six to eight weeks (depending on the brand). Preventative treatment will stop infestations and spread of the parasites around the house and to other pets.

There are many varieties of pet foods available. The best advice is to choose a complete pet food and stick to it. Dry foods are better than wet varieties in that they are better for digestion, help keep teeth cleaner and help make smaller, firmer stools (which are easier to clear up).

Insurance

If the unthinkable happens and your bet becomes ill or injured in any



way, treatment costs can add up to a significant amount. Many people find it helps to insure their pet so they can give their pet the best treatment should illness or injury

Microchipping

A small microchip can be implanted safely under your pets skin. This acts





It was superbly cooked and presented.

My wife chose homemade salmon and dill fishcakes, served with spicy tomato chutney and rocket salad and pronounced it delicious.

There were two delicious looking There were two delicious looking vegetarian choices on the menu, Goats Cheese and Spinach Frittata and Penne Pasta with Mushroom, Rosemary and Marsala Cream, plus a homemade curry of the day served with rice and poppadum plus a number of specials on the blackboard which change daily.

We noted an interesting range of

children's meals and that on Sundays a roast lunch is available.

There was also a variety of sandwiches, Grilled Panninis, salads and Jacket Potatoes on offer for those

Threat to boycott new uniform

PARENTS and pupils are threatening to boycott proposed new school uniforms at Lymm High School.

Pupils at the school have already staged several sit down protests against the proposals which have been drawn up by the school's new head teacher Angela Walsh, who joined the school last September.

Several hundred pupils have signed a protest petition while pagents

signed a protest petition while parents have been writing letters of objection to the Head Teacher and school governors.

Parents claim they were not properly consulted, with a meeting to discuss the proposals taking place during the working day. Others are complaining that the school is creating a 'monoply' by only having the school shop as an exclusive point of sale.

In a letter to parents Miss Walsh

says the current' uniform is of poor quality and not worn properly with too many different variations. She also says' any family facing financial



difficulties will be 'fully supported.'
But 14-year-old pupil Rachel Frith,
who has collected a petition signed
by nearly 300 pupils, claims they
were not properly consulted and
should have been given the option to

vote for retaining the existing uniform.
"The school has failed to take into consideration the views of pupils and

consideration the views of pupils and parents and this has created a lot of strong feelings," she said.

In a letter to the head teacher Mother of three and former Lymm Grammar School pupil Laurie Harter said:"I hope you are now aware that, together with the Board of Governors, you have sparked off far more garagesion and discorregements than I aggression and disagreements than I have known in the school's history!

"I was a pupil at the school in the late sixties and I believe that the teachers in those days encountered the same problems with uniform as you do today; teachers and Heads had to keep reminding girls why their skirts should remain at a 'decent' level, they had to insist on a practical style for school shoes and check that maintained a boys

appearance.
"We behaved in a similar way to pupils of today, which resulted in regular policing of our general appearance and we frequently faced already has a uniform policy, which permits the purchase of blazers etc from other outlets often at better quality and price!

"The current uniform is not strictly enforced by the school, you only need to stand outside the school to view the state of dress of some of the pupils.

"If they can not enforce the policy now, what change will a new uniform make? If we take the basics, skirt/trousers, shirt and tie that will amount to perhaps around \$50-\$60 per pupil, with 2,000 pupils this is over \$100,000 of money local people have to find to replace the current uniform. In the present



economic climate and credit crunch how can this be justified?

Despite several phone calls to the school requesting a comment from the Head Teacher none was forthcoming.

Budget 2009 – tax relief for pension contributions

WITH the economy in the state it is we would usually expect significant and immediate increases in the main rates of tax. It was perhaps no surprise to hear that the planned tax rises for those with higher incomes will be brought in next year rather than being phased in over two years and, worse still, the planned 45% rate for those with income in excess of £150,000 will now be replaced by a 50% rate. by a 50% rate.

With effect from 2011, those with income in excess of £150,000 will income in excess of £150,000 will also see their pension tax relief restricted. Unless, of course, next year's election installs a new government which might have a different view.

Tax relief for pension contributions to be restricted

Higher rate income tax relief is being restricted, with higher rate relief tapered away for those with taxable incomes of between £150,000 and £180,000 from 6 April 2011 and those with incomes above £180,000 contributions will only benefit from basic rate tax relief.

Provisions applying from 22 April

basic rate tax reliet.

Provisions applying from 22 April 2009 will prevent the forestalling of the new rules. For the tax years 2009/10 and 2010/11 individuals with incomes of at least £150,000 in the year, or any of the preceding two tax years could be affected. Steps

taken to reduce income below $\mathfrak{L}150,000$, for example by entering into salary sacrifice arrangements set up after 22 April 2009, will be up after 22 April 2009, will be negated by adding back the amount

Overview

These measures add another level of complexity to the administration of pensions for both employers and individuals and it is a certainty that the administrative costs of running a pension scheme are going to remain high for a further period of time before these new rules become established.

Although the new rules are only billed as coming into effect on 6 April 2011, the forestalling rules already mentioned have immediate effect, and we would urge caution to those considering waiving bonuses into pensions as this could now trigger

penal tax charges.

At an end of season training session, Warrington Wolves RL Academy commended the squad as outstanding and in particular its defence.


