Leaflet sparks Green Belt fears

FEARS that Green Belt land at Lymm is set to be developed led to local councillors being inundated with phone calls and emails from concerned residents who were sent a misleading document claiming major developments, including a super market were set to take place.

circular stated developers were planning to build on all Green Belt land between Lymm and Oughtrington with proposals for a major supermarket on Rushgreen Road – currently Rushgreen Petrol Station.

But local councillors Sheila Woodyatt and Ian Marks moved

quickly to allay fears. Cllr Woodyatt said a large number of residents had received a leaflet stating that Green Belt land was under imminent threat.

"Unfortunately it contained a certain amount of misinformation.

I am sure the person who sent it out had the best of intentions but unfortunately it was complete nonsense and has caused a lot of unneccesary concern.

unneccesary concern."

She explained that the Coalition
Government had made certain
changes to the planning system,
meaning Councils had to review
and amend their Local Plans. She
said Warrington had produced
a very robust Development Plan
which stressed their intention to which stressed their intention to protect and preserve the green belt.

An Inspector from the Department of the Environment was currently holding an Examination in public, similar to a Public Enquiry, into the proposals and objections to the Development Plan. This was standard practice.

"Warrington has prepared and submitted a very robust defence of our proposals to protect the green belt as have Lymm Parish Council Oughtrington Community Association.

Warrington has enough brown field sites and sites with planning permission to cater for the housing need for the next twenty years so there is no need to build on green belt and our Development Plan makes that very clear. I am very closely involved with planning in Warrington and will continue to fight to protect the green belt as I have for many years."

Preserving

Cllr Marks added: "Lymm's three Warrington Councillors are totally committed to preserving the Green Belt and have spoken out forcibly on many occasions.

"The proposals everyone is rightly concerned about are not planning applications but objections to Warrington's proposed Plan. The two developers who are objecting are Peel Holdings and Mr Mohammed Waheed. It is normal for developers to object to proposals to constrain building so we should not be surprised at this.

"We believe there is quite enough land in Warrington for building on in the foreseeable future without the need to build more houses in Lymm.
"We have more than enough
new houses in recent years!"
Cllr Marks added: "We think we

have an excellent case and ought to be able to persuade the Inspector that we are right. However Peel is a very powerful company and nothing can be left to chance."

Lymm Parish Council supports the current draft of Warrington's LDF and does not believe that calls to relax restrictions on development in the village are justified. It believes that they would be harmful to the character of the village and could not be supported by the existing infrastructure.

The developers' argument that demand exists does not justify damaging the very character of the area that generates that demand. There are adequate opportunities for development elsewhere in the Borough.

only running club and is currently organising a 5k and 10k race and 2km fun run on June 30 as part of the Lymm Festival.



Massive support for car parking petition

A campaign to re-introduce two hours free car parking in Lymm and Stockton Heath has been enthusiastically welcomed by local residents.

Local Lib Dem councillors have collected more than 2,000 names on a petition while campaigning at the village centre car parks.

Earlier this year the Labour Council at Warrington cut the free parking time from two hours to one hour on Pepper Street and

introduced charges on Davies Way and Henry Street.

Spoiling

Cllr Bob Barr said, "The charges are having a serious effect on our shops and businesses and spoiling the relaxed shopping experience which makes visiting Lymm so enjoyable. The new charges have created a major problem with more on-street parking. Nearby roads like Brookfield Road are virtually impassable at times with vehicles parked solidly on both sides. This cannot be allowed to continue." Cllr Ian Marks added, "Only

Cllr Ian Marks added, "Only Lymm and Stockton Heath

are drivers being charged at the Council's district car parks. These car parks already make a profit but the Council strategy is to raise this to £200,000 to help cover the huge losses made in free residentonly parking zones in other parts of the town. The south of the Ship Canal is seen as a 'cash cow' and this is unfair."

The Lib Dem petition to restore two hours free parking has already gathered around 2000 names. will be presented before the Council's Executive Board makes a decision on parking strategy at its meeting later this month.

Commendation from Princess Anne

A LYMM resident has received a Commendation from Princess Anne at Buckingham Palace.

Alan Lilly, who lives in Oughtrington with his two sons, was awarded the Commendation by the Butler Trust which "celebrates

by the Butler Trust which "celebrates outstanding dedication, skill and creativity on the part of those working in correctional settings across the UK".

He received the award from Princess Anne, who is Patron for the Butler Trust, for setting up and running the Cheshire Probation Trust (ex-Armed Forces) "Veteran Support Officer" (VSO) initiative.

Alan said: "I served for 16-anda-half years in the Army joining straight from school and found the transition back to being a civilian

transition back to being a civilian

quite challenging.

"I eventually found employment within the Prison Service. I then joined the Probation Service in 2002 with a role as an Offender Manager working in Wilmslow,

Macclesfield latterly, and combined Warrington. my experiences of being a military veteran and working in the Criminal Justice System to set up and manage the VSO team".

The majority of those leaving the Armed Forces rejoin society fairly seamlessly, however, a number of veterans find the transition overwhelming and get into difficulty, a further tew end up in the Criminal Justice System. It can be pretty tough on the veteran, but equally so for the family as well, and that includes mums and dads at home"

Alan, whose two boys currently study at Lymm High School, has just left Cheshire Probation Trust to take up a post as Senior Veterans

Manager with Live At Ease.

He said: "The Live At Ease team have been commissioned

by the NHS to provide a non-clinical, 'wrap-around' service for their NHS partners, the Military Veterans Service Improving Access to Psychological Therapies (IAPT) which in turn provides a bespoke mental health provision for any military veterans and their families in the North West region.

"Our Live At Ease team helps provide specialist support and advice to the local veteran "Our community regarding housing, employment, debt management, relationship difficulties, training, wellbeing and welfare, however, if the problems include anxiety, depression, PTSD, hyper-vigilance, anger management , stress, sleep or substance misuse (alcohol / drug misuse) then the MVS IAPT team

step in.
"We work alongside and often use the services of established ex-Armed Forces welfare agencies including, the Royal British Legion, SSAFA, Combat Stress, the SPVA, RFEA, and other veteran friendly organisations.

Festival tickets flying off shelves!

The succession of sell out events over the Winter seems to have given a new momentum to ticket sales for this Summer's Lymm Festival.

At the beginning of June ticket sales were already approaching £10,000 and several events were either sold out or close to. One new innovation this year has been opening of the box office on Saturdays from the beginning of

Festival director Jacquie Davies explained: "On-line sales are certainly becoming more and more important but many people still like to come in to the box-office, look through all the publicity and even chat to the box-office staff who are well informed about the events.

"Saturday June 1st saw ticket sales of nearly £1,000 which was fantastic.

"We also have some other exciting new initiatives this year" said Publicity Manager Alan Williams.

"I wanted to be sure that nobody would enter or leave Lymm without knowing there is a festival on. The hanging banners in the middle of the village in particular have drawn many positive comments and add

many positive comments and add to the buzz throughout June when of course there are also many visitors for May Queen."

The festival is also pushing hard to pull in more outside visitors this year with a number of large outdoor events and wider advertising including lymm Life's sister publications Warrington Worldwide and Village Life. sister publications Warrington Worldwide and Village Life. Alan added: "Our greatest asset

is the village itself and using the canal and the May Queen field to celebrate that with the innovative Historic Transport Day (June 23rd) is a bold step for the festival. We are aiming to attract thousands and to bring in many people who may never have visited Lymm before".

A huge amount of work has been going on too at Lane End Nursery the new home for this year's Art in the Garden.

"We think yisitors will be thrilled by the transformation in such a short time" said Jacquie.

Another innovation this year is

an indoor Lymmfest spread over four venues on the evening of Saturday June 22nd.

Among the "name" attractions at this year's festival Radcliffe and Foes, are Mark hilarious Hegley and Tayo Aluko whose searing dramatisation of the Life of singer and human rights activist Paul Robeson (pictured) has been winning awards at Festivals all over

the country.
Lymm Festival kicks off on Thursday June 20th as usual with the Foodfest followed by Mark Radcliffe and Foes in the evening.

Work is planned on The Cross where tree roots are making it unsafe to walk and the Parish Council have, with the help of English Heritage and an architect, looked at levelling off at the bus stop, so it will assist people to get on the bus. We are now waiting for Warrington Council to approve this work.

Lymm marked the occasion following public meetings and the help of the festivities committee. A team led by Mrs Lock, decorated The Cross. The village looked very festive and on the due day the Queen's proclamation was read out at 11am on The Cross by the town crier and this took place in 150 cities and towns throughout the realm.

From the open meetings for the Jubilee, one of the proposals was a path way in the Dingle up to the waterfall, with a viewing platform. This was approved by United Utilities after I attended six meetings. A mock-up picture of the path and platform was done by Colin Grimes - thank you very much Colin. It has been approved by the Parish Council and been sent off to Warrington

Council.

Bus Stops

It has also been the year of the bus stop with a new one sited at the top of Oughtrington Lane on the Altrincham bound side, along with a rebuilt stop at the top of Barsbank Lane plus the repairs to the vandalised bus stop outside St Mary's Church.

Meanwhile the walk way round the Dam was rebuilt and the new steps installed, paid for by The Parish and Borough

Councils.

Car parking

I think most of the parish councillors have contacted Warrington over this most unsatisfactory state of affairs. I have been seven times and it would seem Warrington like taking our money but really are not interested in what elected representatives of Lymm

Finally I would like to pay tribute to the many voluntary groups in Lymm, who help the old, young, sick and the village events and festival teams - life is a great deal better for their existence!



Council urged to take action on Trans Pennine Trail

PARTS of the Trans Pennine Trail which passes through Lymm is falling into disrepair and becoming a "quagmire" in places due to pot holes and tree roots according to concerned local resident Konrad Balcerak.

Now Konrad, who along with the benefits of the trial, is urging local councillors to take urgent action before the facility becomes unusuable.

Konrad, who contacted Lymm Life to help highlight the issue, said:"As residents of Lymm for over 25 years, my family and I have benefited from the transformation of the redundant old railway track to a great facility for walkers and

cyclists.
"I taught both my sons to ride their bikes in safety along the Trans Pennine Trail; I used it to regain my strength by quietly walking its flat surface when recovering from a heart attack seven years ago; it's a great cycling 'artery' from which to explore the Cheshire countryside and now in my 60s I still like to use it to cycle to work in Altrincham occasionally.

"Unfortunately after 20 years the track surface is worn out. Trafford council re-surfaced their section from Altrincham to the River Bollin about three years ago, but our local section from Heatley into Statham is

in a very sorry staté.

"Even when it stops raining, the track remains a quagmire and needs a couple of days of sun to dry, out. And when dry the track surface is very rough in parts, with pot-holes, tree roots and raised man-hole covers to navigate around, making the ride uncomfortable.

"I understand from the Area Ranger that repair work has been costed but cannot be funded by the Council. I don't have any magic answers but I would like this issue to be given higher priority by our Councillors to explore funding options.

"The Trans Pennine Trail is an important facility for our leisure, fitness and safety from traffic. So let's find a way of maintaining it before it becomes unusable."

Chairman of the Parish Council, Cllr Ian Marks said, "The Trans

Pennine Trail is a great asset and we mustn't let in fall into disrepair.

"It doesn't reflect well on Warrington Council when other boroughs like Trafford manage to maintain their sections.

"We have talked about funding the Lymm Environment and Heritage Group. It's not easy because substantial sums are involved. But we must be more creative in finding sources of money so we can make the much needed investment to bring the Trail back to an acceptable standard.
