A welcome for twin town visitors

Takeaway shop plan approved

A PLANNING inspector has given the go-ahead for a hot food takeaway shop on a new housing estate at Lymm.

Hundreds of nearby residents had opposed the proposal in Chaise Meadow on the Heatley Mere estate because of fears of noise, smells and general disturbance.

But the inspector has ruled that subject to a condition that the shop close by 11pm there would be no serious harm from noise or disturbance.

He also decided existing parking space was adequate because most use would be of an evening.

A separate application for a single storey shop unit on land adjoining the existing Co-op store, also at Chaise Meadow, has been rejected

The inspector in this case had doubts that parking provision would be adequate at peak times and felt the proposal would harm amenities in the area because of parking, highway other servicing and disturbance

He also decided the proposed

building would result in an unattractive outlook for nearby flat dwellers.

Warrington Borough Council's development control committee had refused both applications last year after objections from around 300 people and local councillors lan Bob Barr and Sheila Marks, Woodyatt.

Plan's for another takeaway shop in an adjoining shop were rejected by the inspector - but this property has subsequently opened as a fashion

Kennels given the go-ahead

PLANNING chiefs have given the go-ahead for new kennels and a cattery on land off Burford Lane, Lymm after the parish council withdrew objections.

The scheme – which would normally be considered inappropriate in the Green Belt – was considered acceptable because the new buildings

replace existing kennels and cattery and are well screened.

The parish council originally objected on the grounds the new buildings were too large and because of the potential for noise. But its chairman, Coun Sheila Woodyatt supported the application because the new buildings would be an improvement on the old which were falling into disrepair and would result in better conditions for a reduced number of dogs. The parish council withdrew its objection before the plan was considered by the borough's development control committee.

Parasitic beasties

AS summer approaches and the days are getting warmer, the chance of your pet picking up a few parasitic beasties will dramatically

Like most insects, the parasites that your pet may pick up tend to flourish in the more temperate months. Amongst the most common type of external parasite that your pet can pick up are fleas.

Fleas are pinhead sized bugs that crawl around your pets' skin and fur enjoying frequent meals of your pets' blood. They can cause discomfort, itching, allergic reactions and in severe cases, anaemia. They also contribute to the spread of tapeworms in cats and dogs and the myxomatosis virus in

skin which causes an inflammatory reaction.

£1.5 million expansion for school

LYMM'S Oughtrington Primary School is to be expanded at a cost of £1.5 million to enable it to accommodate an extra 105 $\,$ pupils.

Borough council chiefs have approved the procedures to enable the work to be carried out following consultation with parents and the local community.

Coun Sheila Woodyatt, the borough's executive member for Children's Services, said: This will make a tremendous difference to the

education of the children of Lymm.
"In Lymm, we have had 1,900
new homes built in the last three or four years. Now we are going to give the school a 21st century learning environment. It will give us an outstanding school.

Coun Woodyatt said the response of local people during the consultation process had been "very positive." Sixty one people had supported the scheme and only seven had disagreed.

There had been a few issues over traffic, but the number of children walking to school at Oughtrington was higher than at any other school in

the borough.
Coun Woodyatt said Oughtrington Primary was already an excellent school. But it did have structural problems - such as pupils having to go through the hall to get anywhere else in the school.



Road work delayed

WORK on road reconstruction and footpath resurfacing in Barsbank Lane and Star Lane, Lymm has been delayed.

It should have started on April 20, lasting for about 12 weeks, but is now due to start on May 26 and is expected to be completed in 10 weeks.

Prohibition

As a result the borough council has made an order to introduce a temporary prohibition of driving and a footway closure on Barsbank Lane, from its junction with Booths Hill Road to its junction with Star Lane and on Star Lane from its junction with Barsbank Lane to its junction with Warrington Road.

The restrictions will be in force when signs are in place on site.



Residents oppose plan for extra dentist

MORE than 20 neighbours signed a petition opposing a plan to allow an extra NHS dentist to practice from a dental surgery in Rushgreen Road, Lymm.

They claimed more than 1,000 NHS patients were already attending the premises - converted from a semi-detached house in 2007 - in addition to private

This had resulted in residents suffering increased noise levels, parking problems

and a lack of privacy, they claimed.

Dentist Jill Cooper applied for a variation of conditions imposed on her original planning consent so that two dentists could work from the premises.

The original consent was for one practitioner only. The objectors claimed an additional dentist working from the site would worsen

problems and lead to more clinical waste and hazardous substances being produced.

But planning officers recommended the scheme for approval and said residents' concerns could be addressed through appropriate planning conditions.

Eight people wrote letters supporting the proposal. Lymm Parish Council raised no objections and Coun Sheila Woodyatt said she fully supported the application.

She said: "An expansion of the service will be of great community benefit."

The variation was approved.

Can road be reclassified?

COULD the A6144 Eagle Brow be reclassified as a "B" road?
Lymm Traders can't see any reason why not - and can see considerable benefits for the village and the second results of the considerable benefits for the village and the second results.

Chairman Phil Sexton told a traders' meeting that efforts to have the road made "one-way" and to allow parking on one side of Eagle Brow had failed in the past because it was an "A" road.

He said: "There is no way it is an 'A' road really. It is too narrow in places and the bridge over the canal in the village is just not suitable for the sort of traffic an

"A' road normally carries.
"If we could get the road reclassified as a first step it might be possible to get a one-way street and parking provision at a later stage."

The meeting agreed to ask Lymm Parish Council to put the suggestion to Warrington Borough Council.



Gas main 'farce' angers traders

SHOPKEEPERS in Lymm are furious after work on renovating gas mains in the village centre was abandoned shortly after it started.

Lymm Traders' chairman Phil Sexton described the situation as a "comical farce that was not funny."

The work - which involved inserting a new main inside the existing 12 inch main - was halted after it was discovered the existing main was, in

fact, only 10 inches in diameter. Traders and Lymm Parish Council had opposed the timing of the work from the start, requesting that it be carried out next January, when trade is traditionally slack.

But National Grid insisted on starting excavations - only to discover

their records regarding the existing

mains were inaccurate.

They have now told shopkeepers the work - which will now involve a much bigger operation likely to cause even more disruption - will start some time after August, raising the fear that it will extend into the busy pre-

Christmas period.
The scheme involves excavating the showpiece "cobbled" street and has been complicated by the fact that supplies of replacement setts appear to be non-existent.

Mr Sexton said the council had

always maintained a supply of setts had been kept to ensure the road could be restored after excavations but, in fact, appeared to have mislaid

Butcher Malcolm Hopkinson said he had been told replacement setts would have to be obtained from

Traders are still pressing for the work

to be put back to January. Sharon Walls, highways assets manager at the borough council said: "The recent works to renew the gas main at The Cross, Lymm have unfortunately been delayed.

"After carrying out an initial excavation last week, the gas company discovered that their existing main is smaller than originally thought and is only 10 inch and not the inch as shown on their records.

"The replacement works will now take place later in the year and are likely to be on a larger scale. We will of course be working in conjunction with the gas company to ensure

with the gas company to ensure disruptions are kept to a minimum."

A spokeswoman for National Grid said: "We do apologise to residents of Lymm for the inconvenience. We are investigating why our records were not

"But this work is essential - it has already been put off for a number of years and is becoming critical. We do want Lymm to have a safe and reliable gas supply.

The work will now take about six weeks and the council want us to try and do it during the school summer



High rents drive new shops away

SHOPKEEPERS in Lymm believe high rents for commercial properties are deterring new businesses from moving into the village.

Too many shops lie empty for too long – with a damaging impact on the

local economy.

A meeting of Lymm Traders agreed unanimously that pressure should be brought to bear on local landlords to try and reduce rents - particularly to help new businesses.

The meeting was told there was no shortage of business people visiting Lymm looking for premises, but that the majority moved on when they discovered the rents demanded.

Landlords and selling agents adopted a "take it or leave it" attitude.

As a result shops stood empty – while at the same time more new ones were being built.

The problem, members agreed, was

Fair rent charter

LYMM Traders' chairman Phil Sexton wants to try and draw up a "fair rents charter" for the village centre. He is asking shopkeepers who rent their properties to let him know how

much rent and rates they pay by square foot.

Then a comparison can be made with a view to trying to persuade some landlords to reduce rent levels.

The borough council could also be asked to review business rate levels.

that because Lymm was perceived as an affluent area with high house prices, the same applied to commercial properties. But this was not necessarily the case.

In some cases, the rents asked were so high they would make most businesses unviable.

Enquiries made by Lymm Life revealed that a shop in Bridgewater Street was being offered at a rent of £1,045 per calendar month while an office space, described as "lower ground floor" was being offered for £165 per week.

Stephen Taylor, of Sale-based Jets estate agents agreed that rentals in

Lymm were high.

He said: "This is a reflection of property values. We act for a number of landlords, some of who are Lymm residents. If they have bought properties in Lymm_they need to get an appropriate return. They can't be expected to let them at a loss.

"I am a Lymm enthusiast - a former "I am a Lymm enthusiast - a former resident myself. I love Lymm and I am eager to do anything I can to help Lymm. It is our job to let properties in Lymm and we do our best to do that. We have just agreed a letting that will get another shop back into use.

"It is not in our interests to ask for upradictically high roots. We want to let

LOW Carbon Lymm, the new group campaigning to reduce the village's carbon footprint, is considering ways of offering free advice to help people save energy - and money

The service, which would be available to householders and businesses, is just

one of a number activities planned by the group over the next 12 months.

An early priority is identifying and securing funding to implement an action

Group spokesman Richard Pearce said there was considerable local expertise available to offer advice.

It was hoped to carry out a community carbon footprint survey and provide information packs on how to reduce carbon emissions to those taking part.

The group will be promoting itself at local events such as the May Queen festival, Lymm Festival and Dickensian Festival.

Members will be hoping to initiate projects with schools and offering them assistance to reduce their own carbon footprints. They will encourage the use of public transport, walking, cycling and car sharing to cut transport emissions and develop plans for the installation of a water turbine to produce energy from

Lymm's existing water resources.

Recycling initiatives to tackle household and commercial wastes currently not being collected will also be investigated and a guide/map showing where to buy local food will also be given a high priority.


