# Independent special school celebrates outstanding Ofsted

PUPILS and staff of a local independent special school are celebrating, following a recent visit from Ofsted.

Cornerstones school was given an 'Outstanding' rating following a rigorous three day inspection by

the regulator. Head Teacher Ruth Clifford said that everybody was delighted and so proud of the students achievements.

Although the school has been established in Warrington for some time, it only moved into its new premises in a tranquil corner of Lymm in November 2013. Ruth was quick to point out that the warm welcome received from local people has made this achievement all the more special.

The school supports young people with Autism and Learning Difficulties, inclusive of complex communication, sensory and behavioural needs. Ruth explained that it is important for all students to access meaningful education and community living experiences, and this Ofsted award recognised their hard work and positive attitude towards learning and life.

The company Director, Paul O'Leary was delighted with the outcome of the inspection feeling that it both recognised the value of partnership working with parents, staff and local authorities and also ensured that all students had the opportunity to enjoy a meaningful

and bright future.

Mr O'Leary stated that "we are very proud of the entire staff teams very proud of the entire start reams commitment which has consistently delivered 'Outstanding' Ofsted ratings in each of our three children's homes since 2008. However, the addition of an 'Outstanding' rating in our school tells the story of just how much can be collectively achieved if people are passionate and dedicated in




## Pupils help lund trip down m

LOCAL amateur photographer Sammi Walsh has been attempting to rekindle the love and intrigue surrounding her home village through a series of images taken over a 12 month period.

Sammi, a 23 year old amateur photographer, studying drama tutor and music journalist from lymm, took up photography at University. Although her course didn't strictly

include photography, it is something she has been interested in for quite some time. Consequently, over the last four years she has taken it upon herself to complete various courses outside of her studies and is currently signed up for an advanced diploma in photography with The Institute Of Photography.

"Lymm Through The Lens" is her new project which will attempt to rekindle the love and intrigue that can sometimes be lost when you live in a certain place for a long period of time; in this case Lymm, her home of 22 years.

It began in February of this year and will take place over a twelve month period in order to collect images of the village in all weathers and seasons.

"You don't think twice about that pub, house or even post box you are walking past. How long it's been there, what it used to be, the memories that have been made there, let alone the outer shell of the building/object itself".

She added: "I spent my school days in Lymm and as I was growing up'I felt like I needed to move on. I had got to the stage where the village was just somewhere I had to walk through to get home from school, nothing more. I barely glanced at what was around me anymore. Three years of living in Bangor, Wales for University was a nice break away from what had become somewhat mundane surroundings, however I came back equipped with my camera and a couple of years of experience using it, and I began to see Lymm in a completely different light."

Sammi works in The Gobstopper sweet shop in the village and explains how she sees hundreds

of tourists flock to Lymm every weekend, especially during the summer months. She believes these people see the beauty of the village instantly as it is all 'new and exciting' to them. 




