IT is easy to pick holes in the arguments put forward by the borough council for changing the pay-and-display parking arrangements at Lymm. Easy, but probably pointless, because it is fairly clear the real reason for the changes is to reduce the heavy losses being stacked up by parking services across the borough as a whole.

They say the changes are designed to encourage a better "turn around" of shoppers, "discourage all-day parkers and introduce consistency across all car parks.

Well, the system that has operated on Pepper Street in recent years already results in a good turn around so, at most, all that needed to be

done was to extend it to Davies Way and Henry Street.

Instead, the borough ignores the legitimate protests of Lymm people and reduces the free parking period on all car parks from two hours to one. If this makes it easier to park in Lymm it will only be because it has driven some shoppers elsewhere.

They impose a £10 all day fee in Pepper Street and a £2 all day fee on the other car parks. Hardly an example of consistency - and do they really believe a £2 fee will deter the all-day parker?

Whether we like it or not, many people do not visit Lymm solely to shop. They visit to combine a shopping trip with a relaxing breakfast, morning coffee, lunch or afternoon tea. They will be unable to comfortably do this in an hour, so

some will go somewhere else and the village will lose trade.

If the council wants to save money on its parking services it should cut back on the unnecessarily high level of surveillance of car parks and focus the attentions of a reduced number of parking wardens on motorists who park on yellow lines.

Dog owner defends family pets



THE owner of the Atika dog involved in the unfortunate incident when an eight month old Shih Tzu lost an eye has come forward to defend her family pet following last month's article in Lymm Life.

Mum to be Joanne Johnston, who was walking her two pets with her partner around Lymm Dam, says they were NOT Japanese Akita's but American Akita's, a totally different breed and certainly not fighting dogs.

"I am extremely sorry that the pup was hurt, and as a dog lover myself I hate seeing another dog hurt. But I think it is only fair to say there are two sides to the story.

"The owners of the puppy approached us, to admire the dogs as it happened! They were so busy chatting that they had neglected to notice that their puppy had gotten away from them (it was on a long lead) and sneaked behind my partners legs (where my dog was). I

don't know whether it snapped at my dog, I honestly couldn't see, and it all happened so fast, but yes, there was an altercation.

"When we saw them coming towards us in the opposite direction, we stood well in to one side and sat the dogs down. This is usual practice for us, so as to offer other dog walkers the courtesy of plenty of space to pass, and we don't move on with our dogs until they have passed safely and we have never had a problem.

"My dogs were both on extremely short leads and sat down nowhere near their pup.

"I personally, would, in the interests of safety, never let a small dog near two large dogs that I did not know, as it is always going to be a risk if anything were to happen.....

Indeed, had they taken the hint, and passed on their way there is no way their dog would have been hurt.

"My dogs were not out of control, and never have been.

"Many is the time of my frustration,

at trying to walk my dogs on leads and mind my own business, only to have several out of control unleashed dogs come up to us and bark or snap, jump up, or just generally agitate my dogs. I try and ask people to get their dogs under control so I can go about my walk in peace, but all too often the owner is miles away, and disinterested. I personally think all dogs should be on leads in public places for numerous reasons, as we all have the right to walk our dogs without fear of having to restrain them, or a dog being threatened."

Joanne has two small step children, and a baby due.

"Do you honestly think I would let children near my dogs if I thought they posed a threat? Both my dogs are very loving, and welcome members of the family, and most people that we come across are absolutely charmed by them and their nature.

We are always approached by children, wherever we go with our dogs (again, we don't ask for it, but it happens) and the dogs are very tolerant. Though again, it angers me that people allow their small children

to run up to my dogs and cuddle them without asking permission first!

"Again though, I have no cause to worry, because they are very good natured with people in general and children. We are very responsible with our dogs, but I do feel that other people also have a duty to behave responsibly with regards to their dogs or children. I was always told, when growing up, to ask when approaching a strange dog, but you would be amazed to hear that more often than not this does not happen, and we are descended on by throngs of well meaning children or even adults, as they are very appealing dogs to look at."

Joanne added that her second dog, which is nine-years-old, had not been involved in the incident.

Major coup for festival's winter warmers

LYMM Festival has achieved a major coup by signing author, comedian and TV & Radio personality Tony Hawks to host the first of this year's Winter Warmer Series of events.

Tony, well known for his exploits hitching "Round Ireland with a Fridge" will be introducing the Manchester and Cheshire premiere of his new film "Playing the Moldovans at Tennis". The film which premiered in London's Leicester Square in June recounts Tony's hilarious and at times, dangerous adventures in that country as he attempts to track down every member of the national football team and beat them at tennis in order to win a bet and avoid an embarrassing forfeit. After the film Tony will host a lighthearted Q&A with the audience on the challenges of translating his surreal adventures to film.

While in the capital, Chisinau, Tony was moved by the plight of the people in this impoverished country and in particular of young children with chronic health conditions such as cerebral palsy. On his return to the UK he decided to do something about it. He now donates 50% of all of the profits from book sales about his adventure to a socio-medical centre for these children in Chisinau as well as all of the profits from sales of the film. In recognition of his work it has been renamed "The Tony Hawks Centre". The Lymm event will also support this charity.

It all happens on Thursday November 22 at 7.30pm at the Statham Lodge Hotel who have



generously offered free use of their 250 capacity Gainsborough suite as a gesture of support for Tony's cause and the for the festival itself.

Volunteers help transform community facility

A TEAM of volunteers has helped transform the Lymm Youth and Community Centre.

Anyone passing the building in Lymm village centre will have seen a "hive of activity" as a team of volunteers and local tradesmen set about the latest phase of the upgrade of the building.

First job was the installation of new windows, followed by a new upstairs kitchen.

Spokeswoman Su Williams said: "The combination of expertise from volunteers and local trades people who have offered us rock-bottom prices means we have been able to use our limited funding very effectively. The recent Parish Council grant of £5,000 has also been a huge help."

During the summer the centre hosted 15 young people who undertook a social action project Lymm as part of the National Citizen Service programme. This involved team building, challenges and training workshops over a period of three weeks.

When the centre ran short of volunteer drivers for a recent Senior Social the newly opened Cheshire Grange stepped in with the offer of free use of their purpose built mini-bus. Su added "It would be great if we could call on more volunteer drivers - just once a month for an hour or so."

Borough 'riding roughshod' over local people

A ROW has erupted over proposed car parking charges in Lymm with claims that the borough council is "riding roughshod" over the views of local people.

Lymm Parish Council and Lymm Traders strongly oppose plans to make all three village car parks pay and display.

Following a consultation, plans are to make the car parks pay and display with only one hour free rather than two as at present.

Cllr Ian Marks said: "I don't know why the council bothered to consult. They have ignored all the comments made by local people. Only two people were in favour of the proposals."

"In several other cases the council is claiming support but this is not true because these same people are objecting to a reduction in the two hours free parking. Low Carbon Lymm carried out an excellent survey with the help of the high school and this seems to have been ignored too."

He disagrees with borough council claims that changes would improve the operation of the car parks.

"There is no evidence for this. What is driving the changes is obvious - money. The council's parking services operation makes a loss, although the car-parks in Lymm and Stockton Heath make a surplus. "We are seen as potential cash

cows to subsidise other parts of the service that make a loss. Each part of the service should be broadly cost-neutral and this includes inner Warrington residents' parking zones, which account for a substantial part of the deficit."

Cllr Pam Marks said that two years ago the parish was promised that before any changes were made to car parks there would be a survey of on-street parking.

She said: "This is still being promised but after the introduction of pay-and-display on Davies Way. I am worried that this measure will further increase parking on roads causing even more chaos than we have already. The long promised survey should be carried out first."

Lymm Parish Council is sending a

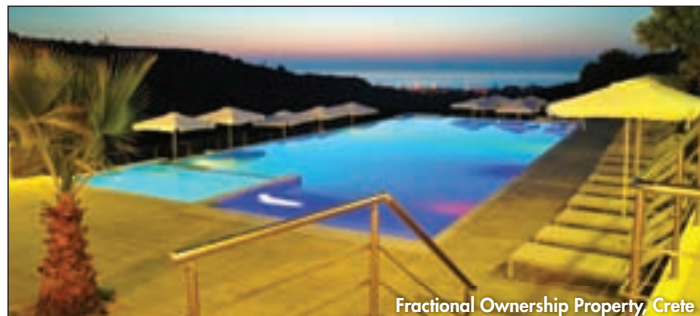

Top school in tune with pupils' needs

REGARDED as one of the very best independent schools in the country Withington Girls' School has given a Lymm youngster full rein to pursue her love of music.

Talented pianist Sophie Foreman (pictured right) has a second string to her musical talent when it comes to playing in the Hallé Youth Orchestra... as an accomplished violinist.

Sophie scored six A* GCSE passes including music and four at A grade. High school becomes an Academy

LYMM High School has become an Academy - and is now known as "Lymm High School - an Independent State School."

As such, the school is now self-governing and funded directly by the Government. Principal Angela Walsh said: "This new status will give us more autonomy and resources to support our vision of providing an outstanding education for all our pupils."

"I want to take this opportunity to thank everyone who has given of their time and supported this process, particularly the school governors, our parents and our very many community partners and, most importantly, our young people whose energy, enthusiasm and creative ideas have been exceptional throughout the complex stages of this process."

Conversion to an Academy is the latest chapter in the school's long history. The exact date of its foundation is unknown, but documents dating from 1592 refer to "Lymm School."

It was reconstituted as "Lymm Grammar School" in 1601 in buildings near The Dam and in 1885 moved to a site off Grammar School Road.

The present site in Oughtrington Lane became an annexe in 1945 and 12 years later the whole school moved there, with the Grammar School Road buildings becoming a new secondary modern school.

In the early 1980s the two schools amalgamated as a comprehensive and the Grammar School Road buildings were demolished to make way for housing.

Objections to stable plan

PLANNING chiefs are to visit the site of a proposed stables development off Higher Lane, Lymm, after hearing of objections from Lymm Parish Council and nearby residents.

The scheme involves a timber building consisting of three stables and a tack room for private recreational use.

Members of the borough council's planning committee will inspect the site before deciding if the project can go ahead.

The scheme was originally submitted earlier in the year but was withdrawn because of concerns that the building would be too close to houses in Oughtrington Lane. But it has now been revised to locate the stables 160m from the nearest dwelling.

The parish council believed it would be an intrusive development in the Green Belt and its proposed access onto Higher Lane would be dangerous.

Objections from three neighbours cite noise, disturbance, pollution, vermin, loss of privacy, floodlights, and parking issues.

Officers are recommending the scheme be approved. They point out the facility is not for commercial use but for small-scale, private recreational use.
