#### AN Open Day for a local charity – which was re-scheduled last year after 'freak weather' – was held in brilliant sunshine this year.

The day had a Traditional Summer Fayre theme, and included horse and carriage rides, bouncy castle, climbing wall, face painting and tombola. There were also traditional fairground rides, children's entertainer, The Great Damondo's Family Show and live music from Metropolitan Brass.

Guests enjoyed a hog roast, barbecue, tea and cakes and other refreshments.

Thame Valley Vintage and Classic Car Club displayed their vehicles, alongside classic motorbikes from local clubs. There were tours of the site and a range of side stalls and games including a coconut shy, hooka-duck and a kiddie corner.

Events fundraiser Pippa Watton said: "We really couldn't have asked for a better day. The weather was glorious, and our supporters attended in their droves.

"Everyone had a wonderful time. It was lovely to see so many happy, smiling and often slightly sun-burned faces!"

### Housing Association invests £1 million

### A SHELTERED housing scheme for the elderly is being completely refurbished and modernised as a result of an injection of $\mathfrak{L}1$ million.

Eight apartments at Raven Court, Pepper Street, Lymm, have already been completed, providing homes for existing and new residents and work is underway on another eight. The newly refurbished scheme will

The newly refurbished scheme will eventually provide 16 contemporarystyle one and two bedroomed apartments - the only "affordable" rented retirement homes in Lymm.

Raven Court was transferred to Warrington Housing Association (WHA) from the borough council, following a ballot of existing residents. Previously it consisted of 19 dated bedsits and sub-standard warden accommodation.

The new apartments have stylish modern kitchens, larger bedrooms and bright lounges. A lift has been installed and there are new features such as walk in showers and energy saving heating and ventilation systems.

The scheme will also boast a brand new secure front entrance, conservatory, separate study room, laundry facilities and outdoor landscaped gardens.

The remaining apartments are due for completion by November. One resident, Vince Ball, who




LYMM-based big band Dr Jazz and the Cheshire Cats are going to church - in concert.

# High school's best ever A-level results

### LYMM High School achieved its best-ever GCSE A-level results.

Ninety seven per cent of pupils achieved five plus A\* to C passes and 73 per cent A\* to C passes, including English and Mathematics.

This was a record for the school since it went comprehensive in the 1980s.

Headteacher Angela Walsh (pictured) said: "The students and staff worked extremely hard to achieve these outstanding results and clearly our new programme of catering and supporting individual students in an extremely focused way has paid off."

school governor Coun Sheila School governor Coun Sheila Woodyatt – the borough council's executive member with responsibility for education – said: "What excellent results! We are very proud to have a new school record for examination achievement. Well done to everyone!"

everyone: Top individual performances came from Georges Rouillon, Catherine Edwards, Jessica Bowell, Charlie Coughlan, Toby Foster, Richard Goodall, Harry Musson and Louise Pomfret.

Overall pass rates were 99 per cent for A level and 100per cent for BTEC.

A total of 56 per cent of all A level grades were A and B – 27 per cent at grade A. Eighteen students achieved straight

Eighteen students achieved straight A grades in three or more subjects. A total of 122 students of the 153 taking A level exams achieved at least one A grade.

Top individual performances were: Sean Hewitt: Five A grades at A level (Cambridge); Jonathan Edwards: four A grades at A level plus Distinction in History advanced extension award (Oxford, Law); Oliver Layfield: four A grades at A level and Merit in Physics advanced extension award (Cambridge, Natural Sciences); Stephen Legg: four A grades at A level (Manchester); Elisabeth Gellert: four A grades at A level (Oxford).

### Clean teeth for our pets

We all love to take care of our own teeth and are proud of our pearly white smiles but many of our pets' teeth are crying out for a clean up.

The soft pet food that we feed our animals can cause a build up of bacteria rich plaque on the surface of our pets' teeth which leads to inflammation of the gums which can directly affect the attachment between the tooth and the gum. When this attachment becomes weakened by inflammation the affected tooth can become loose and even fall out. Inflammation of the gums can also lead to abscess formation and concurrent blood borne infection of the kidneys, heart, lungs and liver. Classic signs of oral problems

in our pets are: bad breath, excessive salivation, bleeding gums, in appetence or chewing on one side of the mouth, pawing at the face and sometimes facial swelling.

There are many forms of preventative dental care available for our pets such as tooth brushes and dental chews but most of the time, animals need to be given a short general anaesthetic and have the tartar removed from their teeth. The tartar removal is done with an ultrasonic scaler. The teeth are then polished with



an electric polisher – like a dental hygienist would use. Lymm Veterinary Surgery has

### Cheshire ploughing match comes to village

### THE annual Cheshire Ploughing and Hedgelaying Match is to be held at Lymm this year -and could attract up to 5,000 people.

It will be held at Tony Cookson's Agden Brook Farm, in Lymm Road, Little Bollington, on September 30 and is expected have about 100 tractors and 10 sets of horse ploughmen and women taking part in the ploughing match, as well as a

The stock is cut about half way through and bent over to make the hedge thicker so livestock cannot go through it. This is very hard work - but the finished result is a hedge that is a work of art.

Along with the competition there will be about 100 exhibitors on the showground which are mainly based in agriculture.

A spokesman said: "It is an almost agriculture has developed over the last 150 years from the horse plough to the large modern day machines which are used today. If anyone wishes to see farming as it really is today then it is well worthwhile having a visit.



history. In 2006 the cult archaeological series 'Time Team' joined James for a three day dig in the village to try and wonderful ancient treasures had been recovered

After failing to make any major finds, the programme concluded that there had possibly been a small Roman farm on the fields that could account for the artefacts, which had been unearthed in the area

Undaunted by their conclusion James was not happy with the results and decided to carry on with his research to try and pinpoint exactly why so many ráre treasures had been uneárthed and more importantly, find the centre of ancient activity within the village.

Now three years on he has succeeded where Time Team failed, with the discovery of a multitude of rare ancient treasures from the Iron Age and Roman period and all coming from a

new area of the village. James said: "When Time Team left the village I was greatly disappointed that they had not found the reason behind why I had recovered so many treasures from ancient times. After taking a few months off from my research I still believed that an answer to this great mystery still remained out there to be

found. "After another three years work around the village I have unearthed many more unbelievable treasures including Silver ancient treasures including Silver Roman Republican coinage dating back to 130BC and almost certainly deposited by the Roman military when they arrived here circa 60AD

But as well as the coinage he has started to find material that could indicate on Iron Age settlement in the area including a rare Bronze statue dating to the Iron Age or Early Roman period and a stone carving that was lay deep in sandbeds of the river Bollin. The carving is something exceptional and currently it is believed that it is a intual carving placed in the river as an offering to the gods, which was common practise during Iron Age and Roman times.

"These James added: latest discoveries are truly amazing and go to prove that Time Team did indeed miss something very special. "I couldn't be happier that my

determination and belief in the research I carry out remains strong and now the results go to show that my theories were correct. I will continue my work and I hope to be able to hold several open days next year to display my discoveries to the people in the area. I would like to thank everyone who has supported me over the years and in particular the landowner's who have allowed me to research their fields."

We started our meal with homemade soup, accompanied by Sexton's crusty bread and Creamy Garlic and Stilton Mushrooms. But

there was a wide range of starters to choose from, including aromatic duck spring rolls, prawn and crab cocktail, homemade chicken liver pate and barbecue chicken wings.

For our main course I tackled a gargantuan helping of fish and chips teaturing a superb cod fillet and mushy peas, while my lady partner opted for slowly braised lamb shank, served with a mint jus set on creamy mashed potatoes and served with fresh vegetables. Both meals were superb and left us unable to even consider the dessert menu, tempting though it looked. Other main courses included wholetail breaded scampi, chicken and garlic mushrooms, fillet of beef stroganoff and crab and prawn linguini, as well as a variety of grilled steaks served with chips, mushroom and tomato and a range of sauces.

At lunch time the Thresher serves a good range of sandwiches and tortilla wraps and also makes a speciality of excellent value Sunday lunches.

The meals are made all the more enjoyable by friendly, helpful staff but if you want to make sure of getting one, be advised to book in advance!


