

# 93 per cent happy with education standards

A HUGE 93 per cent of Lymm residents who took part in a questionnaire about community life

are happy with standards of education in the village. This has been revealed by the "Big Conversation" event organised by Lymm and District Churches Together iń March.

More than 500 people responded to the questionnaire which posed questions on six main issues: policing, education, local government, The role of the church, local business and volunteering.

This community audit was the precursor to a well received "Question Time" style event where almost 100 members of the public interacted with a panel of local representatives for each of six issues. Data from the questionnaires has been extracted and analysed and the comprehensive results are available on the Lymm Baptist Church web site - www.lymmbaptist church.co.uk.

Hard copies are also available at Lymm Library or the church itself. The main areas of concern included antisocial behaviour, pot-holes, parking and dog fouling.

# Golf star flies in to thrill young golfers

I couldn't believe how far he was hitting the ball though. It was about twice the length I can hit it!"

After signing autographs and memorabilia, Lee got back in his helicopter, waved goodbye and headed off to Northamptonshire where juniors at another Lee Westwood Golf Academy affiliated

course were waiting.
"Throughout his visit Lee was very down to earth and approachable,"

added Martin. "And that has been the same for all the coaches from the Lee Westwood Academy. Juniors need experiences like this to spur them on and, after talking to a few of them, I can see that it's inspired






them greatly. At High Legh Park we're fully committed to junior development and we all hope that one day one of our own will be fighting it out on the world stage just like Lee."





# Golf driving range thrown out

A CONTROVERSIAL plan for a golf driving range on Green Belt land at Lymm has been thrown out by borough planners.

The scheme, put forward by Arena Developments, involved adjoining the Lymm Nurseries site off Rushgreen Road.

Angry residents set up an action group to oppose the scheme on the grounds of loss of amenity, traffic problems and loss of wildlife habitats.

Lymm Parish Council lodged a strong objection and the plan was strong objection and the plan was

rejected by borough planning officers

under delegated powers.

Arena Developments now have the

Arena Developments now have the right to appeal against the decision. Cllr Sheila Woodyatt said: "I am delighted with this decision. Our Green Belt land is so precious, there is so little left of it in Lymm.

"This would have been a most

unsuitable development.

Anna Fradgley, spokeswoman for the action group had spearheaded a vigorous campaign against the development.

She described the plan as an attempt to build in the Green Belt "by

the back door."

She said: "Lymm is such a beautiful village and we are lucky to be able to enjoy the countryside. But more and more of it is being built upon, just for

the benefit of developers."

Mrs Fradgley said the scheme involved a clubhouse, changing

facilities, car parking and 20 driving ranges. It would be open from 8am Opm every day.

to 10pm every day.

It would increase traffic on
Rushgreen Road and local homes
would be affected by floodlights and
stray golf balls.








OLDER drivers are much more likely than younger drivers to stop to help if they saw someone broken down at the roadside, according to a recebt AA/Populus

Almost one quarter of drivers would not stop to help as they would suspect that

the breakdown was a con trick.

Participants were asked: "If you saw someone by the roadside (not a motorway) by a vehicle that looked like they had broken down, what would your reaction be?"

Sixty one per cent would stop if they felt comfortable it was safe and thought they could help - 65 per cent male and 55 per cent female.

Of those that definitely would not stop, 16 per cent were in the 18-24 age group and only 10 per cent over 65s.

Twenty two per cent think most people have mobile phones so can seek

assistance themselves and 24 per cent would be concerned it was a con trick.

Londoners would be least likely to stop.

More affluent drivers would be more likely to stop than semi-skilled or

unemployed drivers.

AA president Edmund King believes it is perhaps surprising that 61 per cent

of motorists would stop.

He said: "Our poll shows that the 'Good Samaritan' is alive and well and driving along the highways and byways of Britain. On the other hand it is disappointing that almost 40 per cent don't feel able to stop.

"It' is interesting that older drivers seem much more likely to stop to help other




