

Editor's comment

WE have never been convinced that the scrutiny system operated by borough councils to keep a watch on themselves is particularly effective – if only because it involves them keeping a watch on themselves! Poachers can, and sometimes do, turn gamekeepers, but they don't do both jobs at the same time. Scrutiny committees are dominated by the same political party that controls the council so opportunities for voicing differing opinions are somewhat limited.

But the system seems to be working in the case of the controversial decision, which we reported last month, to close the Sandy Lane Recycling Centre at Stockton Heath. Not only did Warrington's scrutiny committee refer the issue back to the executive board but the executive immediately agreed to carry out a four week consultation, not just into the closure of Sandy Lane but into a recycling strategy for the whole of the borough.

It can still all come to nothing, of course. The recycling centre may still close. But the decision should never have been made without consultation with the public, with parish councils and with other interested parties, in the first place.

There remains the issue of the timescale. Four weeks is not long to organise a meaningful consultation on such a wide-ranging subject – particularly in August, when councils are in recess and people are away on holiday.

We see no need for haste. The original decision caused a storm of



protest from people living over a wide area and if the consultation turns out to be little more than a paper exercise, with no change in the eventual outcome, we confidently predict there will be a further uproar.

Members of Warrington Amateur Radio Club are based at Grappenhall Community Centre and each year get together with pupils from nearby St Wilfrid's CE Primary School during National Science Week.

The club invites pupils to their headquarters and also sets up a radio station at the school allowing the youngsters to understand and experience amateur radio.

This year, St Wilfrid's teacher Sharon Sarjeant visited South Africa as part of an exchange scheme and met Johannesburg electronics teacher Shipo Mzangwe, who was to be part of a return visit to Grappenhall.


She discovered his hobby was amateur radio so, on returning home, lost no time in contacting the club – and as a result Shipo was invited to attend one of their weekly meetings.

Heritage Watch – a campaign to save our history

STOCKTON Heath Parish Council is to give its full backing to Cheshire's unique "Heritage Watch" – a campaign to combat thieves who are targeting churches and other historic buildings.

Time was, the council was told, when church burglars headed straight for the altar.

But now they are more likely to be after the lead on the roof, Stronger Communities manager Andy Williams told members.

The theft of lead and other metals from heritage assets is costing the public many thousands of pounds in repair bills when roofs are left open to the weather, he said. Even worse, some thefts can lead to the loss of a priceless piece of history for ever.

Cheshire's Heritage Watch scheme is the first of its kind in the country.

A network of police, community groups and other partners with special knowledge of heritage locations in their areas have come together to look at ways of combating heritage crime.

ISA reforms encourage saving

Four in 10 people who are aware of the ISA changes say they will help them to save more, according to consumer research group Which. The survey of over 2,000 people revealed that 54% say the new rules will encourage them to shop around for the best ISA deals. The research found that many ISA-holders had never switched their accounts before the reforms. More than half (55%) of those with instant-access cash ISAs and 42% of people with notice cash ISAs had never searched for a better deal before.

Separate research found that:

- half of people admit they could save more
- 12% of people plan to save more in the next year
- 36% of people still haven't heard about the new ISA rules.

Which group is calling on providers to stop limiting transfers into new savings accounts. Earlier in the year the consumer group revealed that 72% of instant-access cash ISAs allowed transfers in, dropping from 88% in 2012.

From I July 2014, ISAs were reformed into the New ISA with a \pm 15,000 annual limit for cash and stocks and shares. You can now also transfer a stocks & shares ISA from a previous tax year to cash, something not permissible in the past. Please remember however, a cash ISA is not an investment. It is a bank account, that's all. What the rules do mean however, is that if you have saved for your child's education or wedding in a stocks and shares ISA and you have done well out of it., at a time you think right, you can transfer the proceeds to a cash ISA for safety. And as long as you use it for these kinds of reasons I think that is fine.

Rental Income

Please note: If you are a landlord, and you are not already aware you do need to register with the Inland Revenue for Self Assessment.

Just like employment income rental income is subject to Income Tax, and many landlords believe that as the amount they receive in rent only pays the mortgage, or is not even as much as the mortgage repayments, then this is not taxable. Unfortunately this belief is incorrect. It is only the interest element of the mortgage repayments which can be offset against the 'Rental income' 'Rental income' is taxable in the same way as any other investment income, i.e. savings' interest etc.

£38,000 grant for cricket club

GRAPPENHALL Cricket Club has won a £38,000 grant to enable it to replace the existing outfield at their Broad Lane ground.

The club - which fields three senior teams in the Vivio Cheshire County League ECB premier division, has obtained the money through Sport England's "Protecting Playing Fields" fund.

The Broad Lane outfield has deteriorated over a number of years due to disease and wear and tear and is no longer the flat, lush green surface it used to be many years ago.

But it is hoped the new outfield can be in place for the start of the 2015 season. Work will start as soon as the current season ends in mid-September.

The existing grass will be removed to a depth of 25mm and additional drainage will be installed. The outfield will then be levelled and re-seeded to hopefully dramatically improve the existing diseased outfield and inadequate drainage which has led to numerous matches and training sessions being cancelled in the last few years.

A club spokesman said: "The committee are delighted with the award and would like to thank Sport England for their help throughout the process and for recognising our need.
