"I HAVE seen the effect of traffic on Stockton Heath and it is not acceptable. We should be doing something about it."

A statement of the obvious if ever there was one - and particularly when it comes from John Redmond, operations manager at the borough's urban_traffic management and control centre. Fortunately, Mr Redmond said a

good deal more when he attended a meeting of Stockton Heath Parish Council.

He revealed a £175,000 improvement plan for Victoria Square traffic lights is expected to be approved in January with work implemented soon after. This is intended to improve the crossings and provide a right filter for drivers turning from Grappenhall Road into London Road

Changes are also likely at the

crossing by the post office to allow more people to cross at each phase of the lights and other plans include improvements at the London improvements at the London Road/Fairfield Road junction and restrictions on parking in Fairfield Road near the junction.

We suspect that whatever changes are made, they will not be welcomed by all. Solving one person's traffic

problem in Stockton Heath will probably create another for someone else. Advance warning that the swing bridge is "off", for instance, could simply send more drivers down "rat runs" to the dismay of local residents. So, while we welcome news that the borough council is "doing something about it", we fear in the absence of a modern day miracle, it

is unlikely to be enough Happy Christmas to all motorists and pedestrians!

Coun John Price said hedges on this lane were overgrown and making the footpath difficult to use. He asked the council to bring this to the attention of the borough council, who should write to residents asking them to take immediate action.

write to residents asking them to take immediate action. He said: "We fought long and hard to get a pavement on Windmill Lane and now it is almost impossible to use it. This is a particular worry now that winter is approaching and children who use the path may be forced to step on to the road. This is very dangerous and the residents need to be asked to sort this out."

Parish won't pay for PCSOs

STRETTON Parish Council has pulled out a scheme to provide funding for Police Community Support Officers as they have 'minimal problems.' As a result, other parish councils

As a result, other parish councils which do contribute to the cost will have to pay more.

to pay more. Clerk Peter Briggs told Stockton Heath Parish Council that he had attended a meeting to look at future funding for PCSOs. Nine PCSOs were provided in South

Nine PCSOs were provided in South Warrington partly funded by parish councils, excluding Hatton and Walton. Cheshire Police Authority proposes increasing the cost to the parishes of each PCSO from £11,000 to £11,800.

Mr Briggs said Stretton planned to withdraw from the scheme from November next year and this would mean a slight increase in costs to the other parishes.

Stretton reported "minimal problems" in their area. But police had reported there had been an incident where the PCSO attended and had asked the parish to reconsider.

Chairman Coun Peter Walker said: "Stretton Parish Council does have a very small budget."

DINERS at Stockton Heath's Loch Fyne restaurant can be sure they are eating fresh food, produced by sustainable methods in line with strict environmental and quality guidelines.

Loch Fyne is famous, of course, for fish, and has come a long way since it was founded by two cyster enthusiasts on the banks of the beautiful loch in West Scotland in 1978. It was 10 years later that the Loch Fyne Oyster Bar opened and 1990 when the first restaurant opened.

Now the Stockton Heath restaurant

Fish and chips Now all day, every day is one of 46 - all committed to serving fish cultivated, farmed or caught by methods which are not harmful to the marine ecosystem

A glance at the menu reveals just how wide the range of seafood and fish dishes there are. Starters include oysters on ice, smoked salmon, chargrilled squid, classic prawn cocktail and homemade potted shrimps.

Main courses range from beerbattered fish and chips to kiln roasted salmon fillet with mushroom, whisky and horseradish sauce to cold lobster with mayonnaise.

We started our meal with a delicious, piping hot fish soup with garlic bread. We then went our separate ways to sample homemade salmon fishcakes with spinach and

lemon butter sauce and whole grilled sea bass with caper and parsley salsa. We had a choice of new potatoes, chunky chips, vegetables or salad to accompany them and afterwards, for those with hearty appetites, there was an interesting selection of desserts.

Those who dislike fish should be aware that Loch Fyne also have starters and main courses to suit them, including duck and rib-eye steak and a range of vegetarian dishes.

The restaurant is bright and airy and we found the staff friendly and helpful. Everything was in accord with the old Gaelic saying "Nach Urramach an Cuan" -

Do you receive rental income from property? -Are you aware that this income is taxable?

Tax on rental income - an overview If you let out all or part of a property (including your home), how you're taxed on the rental income depends on the type of

letting. If you let property abroad, you may have to pay UK tax on the rental income if you're resident in the UK for tax.

Tax on residential lettings

Letting residential investment property in this country is treated as running a business country is treated as running a business – whether you only let out one property or if you let out more than one property they'll all be treated as a single business. The tax is measured on the overall 'net profit'. This should be reported on a self assessment tax return and the amounts should be taken for the period from 6th April of one year to 5th April of the following year, profit is worked out as follows:

- add together all your rental income add together all your allowable expenses, (you may need to seek advice on what are llowable expenses), then
- take the allowable expenses away from the income

By working out your net profit like this it does mean that if you should make a loss on a property you can offset this loss against profits made on any other properties,

however, if you do only have one property it does mean that you can bring the losses forward and offset against future profits the property may realise. Your net profit counts as part of your overall taxable income.

The 'Rent a Room' scheme

The 'Rent a Room' scheme If you are letting furnished accommodation in your own home to a lodger and your total receipts (rent plus income from meals, laundry service, etc) are £4,250 or less (£2,125 if letting jointly), you can get this income taxfree under the 'Rent a Room' scheme. You will have to pay tax on anything over £4,250. Or you can choose not to use the scheme if you'd prefer to pay tax under the rules for residential lettings.

Letting all or part of your home

Letting all or part of your home If you let your home while you live somewhere else, your profits from the rent are worked out and taxed in the same way as for residential investment lettings. The same rules apply if you let part of your home outside the 'Rent a Room' scheme. If you let part of your home this way, you can include a percentage of household costs like gas and electricity when you work out your allowable expenses.

- reduce your profit by claiming 'capital allowances' for the cost of furniture and fixtures that you provide inside the property

- you let offset any losses against your overall income not just against your rental income also, when you sell the property you may be able to take advantage of extra reliefs that'll bring down your Capital Gains Tax bill


