# Editor's Comment



WE have made no secret in the past that we do not believe the green fields of Daresbury to be a suitable site for a major pop festival.

Whatever the merits of the music, the behaviour of the people attending, the adequacy or otherwise of the road network to cope with the additional traffic, the people who live in the area deserve to be protected from the noise and disturbance that inevitably accompany such an event.

In an urban environment, where local people are accustomed to a high level of background noise all the time, a pop testival may be acceptable, but in the normally peaceful countryside of Daresbury, or the other neighbouring suburban areas, it is not.

Residents are entitled to object and to fight their cause to the bitter end without risking the loss of substantial sums of money.

#### Outrageous

Two Walton residents did just that and, for their pains, were ordered to pay costs of some £13,000 in total.

We believe this to be an outrageous injustice.

The unlucky pair did not hire lawyers or expert witnesses to fight their cause but their opponents did. It was a David and Goliath struggle but David did not have the legal equivalent of even a slingshot.

They were not the only locals to object - simply the two prepared to put their names to an appeal.

We would like to think that other objectors - in particular parish councils who, we understand, have received monies from the festival organisers - might consider chipping in to help meet these legal costs.

And we would hope the threat of such costs will not deter local people from objecting again next year.

### New nursery to go ahead

THE way has been cleared for an £800,000 new nursery unit and play area at Appleton's Cobbs Infant School.

Planning chiefs have approved the scheme – and borough council education chiefs say funding is available.

The need for the development was highlighted as part of a review of primary education across the borough which showed

that the existing nursery was in a poor condition and needed replacing.

Although there are plans to reduce Cobbs to a three form entry school, this applies only to children in the statutory 5-11 years age range. The nursery will continue unchanged in the replacement building which should be ready next year.


It was the company's third bid for planning consent. One was refused by borough planners and the second was withdrawn.

The eventual plan involved a mast of reduced height, 50m further away from the junction with Dipping Brook Avenue and Pewterspear Green Road than the original location.

In addition, the company provided a detailed explanation as to why it could not use other locations or share masts with other companies in the vicinity.

Residents claimed the mast was inappropriate in a residential area and out of keeping with a landscape which includes trees, green spaces, sculptures, Roman pillars, etc.

They also claimed network coverage in the area is adequate with O2 already having reached the 80 per cent coverage required by the Government.

# Residents' £13,500 bill for fighting music festival

TWO residents who tried to stop the Creamfields music festival going ahead lost a legal battle – and were landed with £13,500 costs.

A judge ordered Paul Barlow and Peter Priestner - members of the neighbourhood action group which opposed the festival at Daresbury over the August Bank Holiday weekend - to pay the costs following a two-day appeal hearing.

Originally Halton Borough Council and festival organisers Cream had sought costs totalling £23,500, but District Judge Miriam Shelvey reduced the amount.

It was the fourth time the event had been held at Daresbury and, as in previous years, many residents barricaded their homes and gardens for the weekend to keep revellers out.

Others went away for the weekend to avoid the noise and disturbance. Mr Barlow said he had been

stunned by the costs award. "It was a victory for the legal system over common sense," he said.

#### Anti-social

Earlier this year, Halton Council granted a licence for the controversial festival on land owned by Lord Peter Daresbury, despite opposition from 160 local residents who claimed it caused a noise nuisance, traffic congestion, drug and alcohol problems, litter and anti-social problems, behaviour.

Mr Barlow and Mr Priestner decided to appeal against the council's decision and found themselves in a David and Goliath struggle against lawyers and expert witnesses engaged by Halton Council and the Cream organisation.

Mr Barlow admitted he had expected the appeal hearing to be similar to the original application by

He said: "It turned out to be more a technical and legal argument.
"I am actually annoyed with

Warrington Borough

because they originally opposed Cream's application for a permanent licence. But at the appeal they stated that in their opinion the festival did not cause a nuisance. After that, we didn't really stand a chance."

#### Object

Mr Barlow said it was likely he would object to the Creamfields festival again next year - but that he would not appeal against the decision if the application was

Mr Priestner was not actually at the appeal hearing because he was away on holiday. But he was still ordered to pay costs.

# 30,000 attended – but no 'serious incidents'

POLICE said more than 30,000 music fans attended Creamfields but that there were no reports of serious incidents.

Inspector Giles Pierce, who led the police planning team said: "We are extremely pleased with the policing operation for this year's Creamfields music festival.

"We worked closely alongside the

organisers of the event to build on the success of last year. Our main aim was to ensure the safety of festival goers and to minimise disruption for the local community."

Ten people were arrested over the weekend for a variety of offences including possession of drugs with intent to supply, public order offences, fraud, aggravated vehicle taking and drink driving offences.

#### Warning

A total of 21 people received a caution on site - all for drugs offences. One person also received a street warning for possession of cannabis. A variety of drugs and weapons were left in the amnesty

There were 19 thefts from tents reported to police during the event, including one theft of a tent and its contents. Also reported were 43 other incidents of theft, including two thefts from motor vehicles and two thefts of motor vehicles.

Five assaults were reported over the weekend along with one robbery.

There were a few problems with traffic heading to the site on Saturday morning – with some congestion on the M56 and on local roads, which caused some delays for festivalgoers trying to get to the site.

The general view of local residents was that the noise problem was worse this year than last.

The music could be heard as far away as Appleton, Stockton Heath and even Lymm.





# Limited company director responsibilities

For all reporting purposes, it is important to be clear that you and your company are two separate entities.

If you were previously self-employed then you will have to make some significant mental adjustments, for example:

adjustments, for example:
You can no longer just withdraw money
from the business without thinking about how
you are going to treat it and you need to be
aware of all the implications. You need to
seek advise from an accountant to establish
how this should be done.

The legal issues are different too, for
instance, starting and closing a company is
fairly complex and there are tax and
accounting issues which you will also need to
consider from the start of the business.

#### Financial Responsibilities

You have to produce accounts that will be more complex than you may be used to producing as self employed either as a sole r in a partnership (depending on the the business). You have a legal responsibility to:

Keep good accounting records from which accounts can be prepared which give a true

and fair representation of the financial position

of the company.

Produce accurate accounts annually. These have to be prepared in a specific format and then filed by the due date with Companies

House.
You have to pay any tax due on the profits of the company and furthermore the corporation tax returns have to be submitted to HMRC and both by the due date.
You must deal properly with your responsibility a an employer if you have employees, deducting tax and national insurance as appropriate and paying it to HMRC by the due date.

HMARC by the due date.

You must only trade solvently, i.e you must ensure that you are able to pay the liabilities of the business. Failure to do this is to commit

#### Legal Responsibilities

Apart from the financial responsibilities

mentioned above, there are other legal responsibilities for the director, such as:

Completing and returning the annual return (form 363) to Companies House. Your accountant will explain to you what this is and

will no doubt deal with it for you on your specific instruction.

Acting in the interests of the company shareholders. This means that the directors cannot enrich themselves in a way that damages the company i.e pay inflated and not market value salaries knowingly when the funds are not there to withstand this.


