Stockton Heath Parish Council heard that Cartwright's Field, off Chester Road, had been surrounded

by the fence. The field was previously used for many years by the community for recreation on an informal basis.

Despite massive objections from e parish council and nearby the residents, a planning application for 51 affordable homes to be built by Warrington Housing Association was approved some months ago.



Legal question mark over new HMRC Penalties

We have recently received a publication from one of our advisors which reads "As you may be aware, since the new Construction Industry Scheme came into force there have been arguments that the new penalty regime is too harsh and open to legal challenge as it is completely out of proportion. Penalties have been seen running into many tens of thousands of pounds, and many operators have been successfully defended by including this argument in their defence. Until recently HMRC has avoided taking any cases to a Tribunal. Tribunal. to a

to a Tribunal. However, doubts over the validity of the scheme have now been confirmed by a recent case heard before the new FirstHier Tax Tribunal earlier this month. Judgment in the case of SKG (London) Ltd v H/MRC was handed down on 3 December 2009, in which the Tribunal for the first time analysed the new scheme in light of safeguards in European Law which protect against arbitrary or disproportionate penalties. The Judges in European Law which protect against arbitrary or disproportionate penalties. The Judges in the case ruled that... "the Tribunal is left in doubt as to whether or not the statutory provisions for the penalty for late filing of a return...satisfy the requirements of the Human Rights law principle of proportionality". As neither side appointed Counsel for the hearing, the Tribunal has not yet had the benefit of detailed legal submissions and has adjourned its final decision until further legal arguments how been considered – this should be sometime between March and July 2010.

HMRC has been quite devious by taking a case where the penalties at stake were a mere \$2,800 – whereas under the new scheme in theory the penalties can run to over \$70,000. It seems that HMRC could be in for a rough ride and the entire new late filing penalty regime could suddenly be swept away" Example of some of the penalties charged:

The penalty keeps increasing with the number of subcontractors on the return. So if there were 500 subcontractors, for example, the late return penalty would be £1,000 - and so on.

Returns with no subcontractors on them - nil returns - also get a £100 penalty if they're late. If you have any CIS penalty cases this judgment will affect you so watch this space As this is breaking news we are unable to deal with specific cases at this time. Currently this article is for information only and any further developments will be reported in due current course

Fears dismissed over hall

FEARS that the public would be denied access to parts of the historic Walton Hall and Gardens if it is sold to a private investor have been dismissed by a local councillor. In fact, the public may have more with the private company in as long-

In fact, the public may have more access to the hall and grounds than they do now, if current plans get the go-ahead, according to Paul Kennedy, councillor for Walton. Stories have been circulating for

Stories have been circulating for weeks among local residents that any deal with a private hotel company would include a plan to prohibit the public from part of the grounds –in particular the much-loved rose garden.

Patrick Mullee, a former Stockton Health Parish Councillor visits the park every day. He said: "I do agree that we need some investment in Walton Hall and Gardens. I'm all for that.

Hall and Gardens. I'm all for that. "The place is being run on a wing and prayer at the moment so something needs to be done. But it's what sort of investment and what price are we going to pay for it, that concerns me.

"The rumour is that we might lose public access to the rose gardens. I hope not, as people have donated benches and memorials over the years and it would be very sad if they were to lose access to them."

But both Councillor Kennedy and a spokesperson for the Council have denied this would be the case, if the current deal goes ahead.

current deal goes ahead. Warrington Council has confirmed it is in early talks with a private, family run company about running the site as a joint venture.

Under the proposed deal, said to be worth 23m, the Council would continue to own the hall and grounds

more access than they do now because some of the facilities are in such bad repair that they are closed at the moment.

"If they were restored, they'd be open to the public again. I am keeping a very close eye on how this progresses but if a deal can be reached on this basis then it could be an ideal solution."

A spokesperson for Warrington Council said a joint venture on this basis was being discussed and that a full public consultation of any development of Walton Hall would take place once an agreement has been reached.
