Editor's Comment

THE fact that the fate of one of Warrington's most historic buildings still hangs in the balance is almost criminal.

The public inquiry into the future of Bewsey Old Hall has been dramatically halted – apparently because of a blunder by the wouldbe developers who submitted proposals for apartments in the grounds of the Grade 2 listed hall, apparently taking up more space than

originally envisaged.

A three day inquiry was adjourned and will now be resumed on September 30.

Developers are appealing against Warrington Borough Council's refusal to grant planning consent for the conversion of building into apartments and the construction of 48 more

apartments in the grounds.

Bewsey Old Hall is arguably
Warrington's most historic building. But despite various attempts to bring it back into use, it has stood virtually unused and in a deteriorating condition for many years. Objectors to the current proposal would prefer to see the building preserved for

community use.

In 1997 a campaign was launched to turn it into a tourist attraction - but came to nothing. Prior to that it was considered as a possible venue for the Warrington peace centre - which now with hindsight may not have been too bad

a thing.

I find it hard to believe that a building of such historic importance can be left in the hands of a Government quango like the Homes and Communities Agency, formerly English Partherships and private property developers.

Warrington has already lost much of its heritage and steps should be taken to preserve what is left.

Lets hope that whatever happens to the hall in the future we do not lose another piece of our heritage.

I WAS delighted to get more than the usual amount of feedback regarding last month's column. 

New rules for selling your home

As anyone who has been hoping to either buy or sell a property recently will be all too painfully aware, it has been a legal requirement for all properties being marketed for sale since December 2007 to have a Home Information Pack available.

Home Information Packs include important information such extracts of the Title Deeds, legal searches and an Energy Performance Certificate. On the 6th April 2009, changes were made to Home Information

Packs, including:

- 1. a requirement to make the Home Information Pack available to buyers as soon as a property comes onto the market for sale.
- 2. the introduction of a new Property Information Questionnaire, to be completed by the Seller. (the questionnaire includes questions about whether the property has ever been affected by storm, flood or fire and detailed questions about leasehold arrangements).
- 3. an end to the use of legal indemnity insurance in personal searches to cover missing data.


These changes may well bring delays to properties being advertised for sale on the open market or by

estate agents. On average it can take up to a week to prepare a Home Information Pack. The changes however are intended to make the selling process "easier and more transparent" for both Buyers and Sellers.

It is anticipated that by providing core information to Buyers at the outset, that Buyers will be less likely to incur wasted costs and Sellers will be less likely to experience delays by having to deal with multiple queries throughout the transaction.

The new Property Information Questionnaire has resurrected concerns that Sellers should be aware that prospective Buyers should be entitled to rely upon the accuracy of any information provided. This has always been the case in Conveyancing transactions however. The recent changes have simply meant that the Buyers are able to make informed decisions about their transaction, before committing to transaction before committing to unnecessary expense.

Marathon boost to local economy

A NEW annual English Half Marathon road race set to take place in October will provide a major boost to the Warrington economy.

Already more than 400 people have registered to take part in the new event which has been dubbed the 'People's Challenge', which is coming to Warrington this autumn, in the form of the New Balance English



Expenses and expense claims

It seems that every time you open a newspaper or switch on the TV at present you are confronted with stories about expenses and expense claims. So we thought that we could look at some of the rules which we mere mortals, as ordinary employees as opposed to MPs, must adhere to in order to successfully claim tax relief for an expense. And the first thing to say is that any claim will probably be vigorously scrutinized and resisted by the tax office, who will demand evidence of the expense incurred as well as the reason for the claim.

For a claim for tax deduction to succeed then all of the following conditions must be

- The expense must be one that each and every holder of that employment would have to incur.
- The expense must be necessarily incurred.
- The expense must be incurred in the performance of the duties of the employment.
- The expense must be incurred and paid The expense must be wholly and exclusively so incurred.

 These conditions are extremely difficult to

meet. As one learned judge once said:

unnecessary for me to refer to any of the occasions because it is notorious, that it is difficult for a taxpayer (employee) to bring his expenses within the (rules for deduction)

A couple of examples taken from the tax office's own publications might illustrate the difficulties faced in getting expenses allowed.

1. A worker is employed by a chemical company which provides protective overalls. However, he finds them uncomfortable and so buys and uses his own overalls. The cost is not deductible as it fails the first test.

2. The duties of someone's employment are such that he is often required to work late into the night. On these occasions he has no access to his employer's premises so he takes his work home. No relief is due on the travel costs or any costs associated with the home as it is not an objective requirement that the work is done at home (it could be done anywhere) and so it fails the second test.

A workplace can exceptionally be defined as a geographical area, in which case all travelling expenses within that area would be deductible. However, this will only apply where all of the following three

conditions apply:

1. The employee has no single site that is his permanent workplace.

The employee attends the area

regularly.
3. The employee has a job where the duties are defined by reference to a geographical area.

This is a vast subject, and the tax office's guidance to employers extends to over 150 pages on travel expenses alone. So one tinal point to make is that round sum expense allowances are, in all cases, subject to both tax and national insurance.

So, in conclusion, don't try to claim a barbeque as an expense against your earnings. Only MPs can do that!


