



This month, I want to focus on the importance of thinking differently. During uncertain times our confidence and self esteem can be eroded. Our belief systems are often challenged and we sometimes or often feel uncomfortable with external events, with other people and ourselves. Regular readers will be familiar with the phrase, 'each thought creates a physical response' and this is important to remember.

What we also have to remember is unfamiliar is not necessarily wrong, it's simply unfamiliar. But we adapt and we can learn to think differently, and as we think differently we eventually feel more comfortable and unfamiliar then become familiar.

become familiar. How many of us who walked past Woolworths the day after it closed and felt those feelings of unfamiliarity? It has always been there. And yet a few walks past it and how quickly we become familiar to seeing it closed. We adapt, and we do it well if we allow ourselves too.

Over recent months, we have become familiar with bailouts, company

closures; we have also become familiar with massive numbers, a billion, 20 billions sometimes hundreds of billions. When we first thought about billions it was a mind numbing number, now we're all familiar with the huge numbers and we now don't give them a second thought (though we will when we have to pay them back!) so again we adapt.

'And that is one of the many great things about being human, we are adaptable, we can make the best of a bad job, we can learn to think differently, we can learn to think better, we can learn new skills, new attitudes and new outlooks.

Every single person who reads this article is capable of changing their thoughts and outcomes. My self help audio recordings and my services at Guardian Medical Centre are about helping people to make changes in their lives. More recently I have been busy focussing on helping those who have been made redundant to speed up their emotional recovery, restore confidence levels develop self motivation and determination amongst other things and therefore to move on again.

Sometimes we have no choice, so the more comfortable we feel in and about outlook, and subsequently what we eventually achieve.

In 1970, Solvay joined forces with Laporte to form the Interox group of companies who, in 1986, built a new AO Plant at Warrington, employing the then latest technology and costing over £20 million.

That plant continues to operate today, albeit with a recently upgraded instrumentation and control system which once again ensures the plant operates with the latest technology, The Warrington site is now wholly owned by Solvay.

Family problems call for family solicitors

by Paul Ireland, Widdows Mason The days of Spiderman stopping traffic by climbing Tower Bridge or Batman scaling the Houses of Parliament are possibly behind us following recent changes to the law relating to children.

I have to be honest and say that both on a professional basis as a family solicitor for many years and also personally as a father of two little girls I have always considered these exploits actually did more harm than good and did little to assist the overall cause.

However, at the same time I also recognise that there are occasions when wrong decisions are made but in my experience it is more because people try and fight the system on their

people try and tight the system on their own and in their own way and without the benefit of proper legal advice. If I had to rewire my house I would employ an expert electrician rather than try and tackle the difficult job myself. It is auract the across principle is exactly the same principle in a court of law and if you have a family problem that ultimately may require the intervention of the court it is better to obtain some initial legal advice from an expert family solicitor.

I have noticed a growing trend over the last few years that when relationships breaks down more and more children are spending an equal amount of time with both parents or alternatively parents are managing to come to very sensible decisions that are in the best interests of the children and make arrangements for both children to see both parents following that relationship breakdown.

However, unfortunately there are a small percentage of cases where arrangements for children cannot be agreed and require a court order and an even smaller percentage where a court order is obtained and not respected by one or both parents. It is the very small percentage of cases that the recent changes of the law seek to address.

The new changes in the law are intended to help all parents promote contact and in those few cases where contact orders are not complied with the court will also have the ability to impose sanctions on the parent who is failing to respect an order of the court. Examples of the new changes and

- Court's powers include:-
- The court being able to attach conditions to contact orders e.g. it can be a condition that a parent attends a parenting program.
- The court can impose on a parent who does not comply with an order a financial penalty or financial compensation for losses incurred as a result of failure to comply with a contact order (e.g. the cost of a holiday which is wasted.

These are just some of the main changes to the new law and I suppose time will tell whether we see the return of Peter Parker or Bruce Wayne but for the time being may the rest in peace.

We're going to live longer!

HEALTH bosses in Warrington have made a key commitment to increase life expectancy for local people over the next five years.

NHS Warrington's strategic commissioning plan for the period up to 2013-14 says life expectancy at birth for men will increase by almost two years compared with the present and a further two years over the

following five years. Women's life expectancy in the same period will increase by 1.5 years compared with the present and a further two years in the following five years.

This would mean men's expectancy would be in line with the national average, compared to being one month less as at present while women's would increase from the national average as a present to one year above the average.

Average life expectancy in Warrington is currently 75.4 years for men and 79.7 for women. NHS Warrington has listed seven priorities to achieve the vision of "A Healthier Warrington for all."

These involve: Increased resources into prevention, staying healthy and reducing inequalities,

Improved access to planned care and reduction of inappropriate and acute hospital admissions and attendance.

Support for long term conditions, prevention and management.

Improvements for the health

outcomes of older people. Improved health outcomes for children.

Development of local integrated services.

Higher levels of efficiency and effectiveness when dealing with cardio vascular disease, alcohol respiratory disease and misuse, mental health.



THE workload of councillors in Warrington has been under-estimated for a number of years – according to the councillors themselves. A working group of councillors set up to review the way council members' pay is calculated is recommending changes. Councillors' allowances are recommended by an Independent Remuneration Panel (IRP) appointed by the council – although the final decision is made by the council itself. In May last year, the IRP, decided that the average time spent per week on council business by a backbench councillor should be estimated at 15 hours. They have during a council out in 2006.

based their findings on a survey carried out in 2006. But last November, another survey was carried out. All 30 backbench members of the council were invited to take part, but only 13 did so. They were from all three

political parties and represented nine wards. This indicated that on average, members worked 28.64 hours per week. 

Tax year reminder

As we approach the end of the tax year it is worth reminding employers of the PAYE reporting requirements and the penalties which follow if you fail to meet them.

them. 18th April – All PAYE and NIC deductions must be paid over to the tax office unless you make your payments electronically. People making their payments electronically have another four days, but they should note that the payment must have cleared by 22nd April, not just have been made. If the payments are received late then interest will be charged, currently at 3.5% per annum, but there are no penalties unless you have more than 250 employees.

250 employees. **19th May** – Employer Annual Returns must be received by the tax office. These consist of:

P14s for each employee, showing the total gross pay and deductions for each person who has been employed during the tax year.

P35 which is a summary of P14s for all employees as well as various statutory declarations.

Paper returns are still acceptable if you have fewer than 50 employees, although there is a tax-free reward if you file

electronically. Employers with more than 50 employees must file their returns electronically. Penalties, currently £100 for employers with fewer than 50 employees, are payable for each month or part of a month that the returns are made late.

are payable for each month or part of a month that the returns are made late. **31st May** – A form P6O, which is the employees copy of form P14, must be given to each employee in your employment on 5th April. Employees who have left before this date should already have been given a form P45.

6th July – Forms P11D and P9D must be received by the tax office, as well as form P11D(a) which is the return of Class 1A NIC payable. All these forms relate to expenses and benefits received by employees during the tax year. It is important to note that:

 all expenses paid to employees, including allowable travelling expenses, must be reported unless the employer has applied for and been granted a dispensation by the tax office. Penalties payable for late submission are similar to those for the other Annual Returns. A copy of the form, or of the details contained on the form, must be given to the employee by this date.


