

Many people ask me what it is like

The charity supports others affected by political violence, conflict and acts of terror. It works with people of all ages, race, faiths and nations with the aim of turning painful experiences into positive action. This includes former combatants and those bereaved, injured and witness to terrorist acts and conflict anywhere in the world. Under Clare's leadership the Foundation has worked with over 25,000 people, expanded its geographical reach nationally and internationally and is networked through 36 organisations in 8 countries in Europe. The Foundation acts as advisor to both U.K and European Government on the aftercare of victims of terrorism and the prevention of violent radicalisation of young people. Clare will be leaving the Foundation at the end of September to take up her new position.

A day in the life... Elaine Potter - Fundraising Administrator

# Elaine Potter came to St. Rocco's as a volunteer three and a half years ago and never looked back.

"In 2009, I had been working in banking since I left school and had reached a stage in my career where I felt I wanted to do something more - give something back. I had some free time and thought it would be great to volunteer for a worthy cause like St Rocco's Hospice. I applied to be a volunteer on line via the St Rocco's website and following my interview, was offered a role helping with the banking administration in the Fundraising Department. When a permanent position came up a few weeks later, I applied and was delighted when I was successful in my application as Fundraising Administrator.

"One of the best things about working in the Hospice is how we all work together as a team. No day is the same; which makes everything just that little bit more exciting knowing that anything could happen!"

On a day to day basis, Elaine's role brings her into contact with many hospice supporters, patients and families. "It's so rewarding to meet the people who support us by raising funds in the community, knowing that the money raised goes to such a good cause. When supporters come to the hospice with funds they've raised, they are always delighted when I'm able to tell them how the money will be used to help the patients and families we care for at the Hospice".

"So many people give their time as well as funds to help support us- they are truly inspirational. I recently met two young girls from a local primary school who came into the Hospice with their parents to hand in a huge tin of loose change; all of which had been collected in memory of their grandad. Little things like this just make your day."

Elaine's responsibilities include reconciling fundraising income and general administration, looking after volunteers and administering many of the fundraising events run by the Department. "A typical start to the day is to check whether anyone has registered for events like the Starlight Walk and administering those registrations. I am always very involved in the event, attending meetings with the planning team, assessing the venue and the route and planning activities on the night, in conjunction with Helen, the Events Fundraiser and the rest of the team. I also look



after the registration team on the night of the Starlight Walk, making sure that all the participants submit their sponsorship forms and register before midnight.

Elaine would love to do the Starlight Walk herself one day. "It's such a fun atmosphere – the feeling of collectivism and camaraderie you get from being part of a group of ladies all doing something worthwhile for the Hospice - it must be a wonderful feeling".

# MBE for St. Rocco's Unsung Hero



Volunteer Roger Moray has been involved with St. Rocco's for over 26 years and his tireless devotion to the Hospice has now been recognised by one of the highest awards possible - Member of The Most Excellent Order of the British Empire (MBE)

Roger's involvement with St Rocco's dates back to the original home of the Hospice;

the former St Ann's Vicarage in Orford. His work with the Hospice includes tackling numerous maintenance jobs as a volunteer and extended to him becoming Project Manager for various hospice projects, including the building of the new Hospice in Bewsey in 1998-99, the Day Unit/Education Centre extensions in 2006-8 and the renovation of Lymm and Longford Street Shops.

"It was a bright, warm, sunny day in November when I arrived at Buckingham Palace with my wife, Sue; daughter, Nicola; son, Stuart and daughter-in-law, Cheryl", said Roger. "We were pleased to see the Queen's flag flying over the Palace. This was the first clue as to who would be carrying out the investiture".

On entering the Palace, Roger recalls how the guests were directed straight to the ballroom ready for the ceremony, while the 95 recipients of awards were taken to two holding areas where the proceedings were explained.

"The most important instruction was not to climb onto the dais on which the Queen would be standing" said Roger. "The Palace is very impressive. It sparkles with fresh paint, acres of gold leaf and lots of royal portraits. The Household Cavalry, the Yeomen of the Guard and the Ghurkhas were in attendance and a military band played during the ceremony".

"My actual investiture was over very quickly. Having pinned on the medal, the Queen commented that St Rocco's was a very worthy cause. She then asked how long I had been involved, to which I replied, "since 1985". With that, we shook hands and it was all over".

"The whole event was organised with military precision but it was not intimidating in any way. It was a thoroughly relaxed and enjoyable experience".

#### Support Group Network/Community Events


Since the last issue, a number of events have been run by volunteers throughout Warrington:-



#### Tax return deadline looming

Like all accountants we are beginning to build up to the January deadline for submitting tax returns. The deadline is January if the tax return is submitted electronically. However, there is a nearer deadline looming.

October 31st is an important deadline

- in two circumstances: 1. It is the deadline for submitting your tax 2. It is the deadline for informing the tax
- office that you are required to submit a tax return if you have not already been issued with one.

Self Assessment means exactly what it says. It is your responsibility to assess your tax position and to inform the tax office if tax position and to inform the tax office it you are within the self assessment system. It is then your further responsibility to assess the tax that you are due to pay, and to then accurately inform the tax office how much this is, and to pay that amount, by the due date in the correct format

format. This is important as there are severe penalties payable if you fail to meet the deadlines. For instance, the following penalties are payable if you fail to send in your paper tax return by 31st October or your electronic return by 31st January:

- If you are 1 day late then you will pay a penalty of £100
  If you are 3 months late then further penalties of £10 per day up to a maximum of £900
  If you are 6 months late then you will
- If you are 6 months late then you will pay the higher of £300 or 5% of the
- If you are 12 months late then you will pay the higher of £300 or 5% of the tax payable.

By that time, you will have incurred penalties of at least £1,600 even if you do not owe any tax. It is therefore essential that you check whether you need to complete a return if you have the slightest suspicion. We cannot cover all reasons why you will need to submit a return in this article, but the main ones are: • You are either self employed or a

- company director
- You receive £10,000 in rental income, or £2,500 after deducting expenses
- You receive  $\pounds10,000$  in savings or investment income, or  $\pounds2,500$  if they
- are untaxed You receive any foreign income liable to UK tax
- You are over 65 and are only entitled to a reduced rate age-allowance




