# Playgroup's home under threat

THE future of the Lymm Village Hall Playgroup could hang in the balance after a request for an outdoor play area was turned down by the parish council. Playgroup organisers told members of the council that it was a requirement of Ofsted for playgroups to have a suitable outdoor play area. Without suitable facilities they could be forced to find alternative premises. Parish council Chairman Coun Sheila Woodyatt said: "While we have every sympathy with the playgroup we have to take into account other users of the village hall. We simply could not accommodate having an area fenced off

village hall. We simply could not accommodate having an area fenced off outside a public building." Coun Woodyatt said she was hopeful that proposals for a young persons play area on the nearby May Queen Field could still happen later in the year, although she realised it was not entirely suitable having youngsters crossing a road to access it.

"It would be helpful if organisations like Ofsted could be a little more flexible in their requirements," she added. Lymm Village Playgroup has operated successfully from the village hall for


more than twenty years.

which will launch a report into standards of screening and diagnosis in hospitals and Primary Care Trusts (PCTs) regarding the baby hip examination.

Initial findings indicate that, alarmingly, many PCT's do not even have a hip examination policy which is an important part of the newborn and 6-8 week physical baby health check.

Every year, up to 2,000 babies and children are diagnosed with Developmental Dysplasia of the Hip (DDH) which describes a range of conditions from mild instability and immaturity to total dislocation of the hip. Late diagnoses can lead to early hip replacement and osteoarthritis, for

which there is no cure.

# Good housekeeping

This month we take a look at how the self-employed can claim part of their household expenses against their annual tax bill. The Revenue recently clarified the details of how self-employed workers may be able to offset some of their household expenses against their taxable income. Examples of what is allowable when using your home to run all or part of your business are given below.

below. If part of your home is set aside solely for business use for a specific period then a part of these costs is allowable and it will normally be appropriate to apportion these expenses by area and time. Insurance, Council Tax, Mortgage Interest (not capital) or Rent Repairs & Maintenance - general

- redecoration of the exterior or repairs to the roof, but NOT the decoration of a room not used for the business.
- Cleaning only if the area used for operating your business is being cleaned!
- Heat, light & power a photographer with a studio at home will have a much higher business expense for electricity than a trader writing up records once a week in the spare bedroom Telephone & Broadband – the cost of
- business calls may be allowable as well as a proportion of the line rental Metered water charges in cases of heavy usage the business part of the property may be separately charged, however in the case of

writing up records there is no business use of water.

#### Take Care!

There may be implications for Capital Gains Tax. Historically, there was a fear that if you took mortgage interest as an expense, it could put your house in jeopardy of not being free of CGT. Currently, taxpayers do not pay CGT on profits made on the sale of their primary residence, but if part of the residence was considered to be wholly used for business purposes, there was a risk that it could be deemed liable. This again has been clarified. A room which is used partly for business purposes and partly for residential purposes will qualify in full for relief from

Unfortunately, if you are an employee or company director, and undertake some of your work at home, the allowances are not as generous. If you are self-employed and spend a


