The school was visited recently by a five-strong team of inspectors who reported it was outstanding because its excellent curriculum meets individual needs and because of the support students receive to enable them to succeed.

Inspectors also said the school offers students an exceptionally wide range of options and opportunities and that the breadth of enrichment activities is 'astounding'.

Teaching and learning in the sixth form is described as 'outstanding'.

Challenging tasks are set and the praise and encouragement students receive motivates them. In a small number of lessons, however, teaching is slow. Students become bored and sometimes go 'off task'.

Some marking of students' work is excellent, but the quality and frequency of marking is inconsistent and does not always show students what they have to do to improve.

However, the inspectors rate the school 'outstanding' in almost every respect and "good" in the few areas were improvements could still be made.



Martin, a solicitor and author of the acclaimed Harry Devlin Mysteries, will have a story included in the book.





Vandals put out lights – again!

VANDALS have targeted decorative lighting alongside the Bridgewater Canal for a second time.

Local resident Peter Corbett who lives on the canal questions whether the lights should have ever been installed and fears they are a waste of money.

and fears they are a waste of money. He said: "The lights were only installed about a year ago and the odd thing is that although they do look very attractive, they are not strictly necessary since it is fairly light along that path -1 know because I live directly opposite the path and look at it every day and night - But it was someone's idea to put in these bollard lights which have a bulb at the top that is protected by a plastic "glass" cage strengthened by metal struts. Cosmetically they look great but being the age that I am has made me very cynical and so I was not in the least surprised when one week after they were switched on, they were all "broken". It turns out that this was achieved by someone persistently kicking the pillar so it rocks and the bulbs element is broken. Rather surprisingly, the "Environment and design team" of Warrington council did not see the vandalism coming, (although I did). They eventually did come out and replace all the bulbs but one had been kicked out and the posts are now extremely wobbly.

posts are now extremely wobbly.
"Now I hate to say "I told you so",
but really I could have told them so. The
powers that be say that "no street

furniture is entirely resistant to targeted vandalism.

"If the authorities are aware that existing "furniture" is not vandal proof then why not look further afield? I'm sure that someone somewhere has encountered similar problems and come up with a product which makes more sense than a kickable tower.

"But more importantly if the product is now known to be non vandal proof, why bother to install it in the first place if (as is becoming apparent) no-one will take the ongoing responsibility for the repair/replacement/maintenance of the equipment when a vandal strikes?

"The cost of sorting these lights out has become a real hot potato in Warrington council with departments eager to not be the ones to be held responsible."

Local councillor and leader of the borough council lan Marks said: "These new lights are a very attractive addition to the look of the canalside in the centre of Lymm.

"They are very useful too because they light an otherwise dark area."

"Senseless vandalism is most regrettable because we have no lights and repairs just cost the taxpayer unnecessary money."

unnecessary money."
"I know the council is looking at ways of resolving this problem."










Dismount strategies for dead horses

American Dakota Indians passed down from generation to generation says that "when you discover that you are riding a dead horse, the best strategy is to dismount". This wisdom extends to an understanding of the strategies that do not work. These include:

Buying a stronger whip.
 Doing nothing: "This is the way we have always ridden dead horses".
 Visiting other countries to see how

they ride dead horses.

• Performing a productivity study to see if lighter riders improve the dead

Modifying existing standards to include dead horses.

Harnessing several dead horses together in an attempt to increase their speed.

Re-classifying the dead horse as "living-impaired".
Rewrite the expected performance requirements for all horses.

Of course a dead horse to the Of course a dead horse to the Dakota Indians was one that could no longer perform to the ability required during a battle and was therefore running dead. They would simply dismount at an opportune time and a fresh horse would be delivered to them by a rider who had the sole responsibility of providing fresh horses to the warriors in the front line.

If only business strategy was that easy. However it is amazing how much time, effort and energy business owners will put into trying to breathe life into 'dead horses' instead of committing their valuable resources to more productive pursuits. Most would be able to reflect on specific things that they have poured considerable time and money into, only to achieve poor results.

While there is no doubt that running a business is about taking risks, there needs to be an appreciation that sometimes the only means of achieving the desired results is to adopt new strategies. In a way, persevering with poor strategy is like putting up with a car engine that is steadily going out of tune. It's not until you have it serviced that you been. Perhaps if cars engines or business strategy were like horses the path to non performance would be a lot faster and we would be more ready to make the required changes.



ONCE in a while, as we wander the Warrington area in search of places to dine, we chance upon a gem.

Greenfields, in Barley Road, Thelwall is such a place. If you've not come across it yourself, it's probably because it only opened in late August. But plenty of people have found it and it has been receiving rave reviews on internet restaurant guides.

We went on a cold winter's evening and were immediately impressed by the warm, cosy atmosphere.

Impressive

The menu was equally impressive with a bewildering choice of starters, main courses, salads, platters to share and desserts – complemented by an excellent wine list.

Starters included freshly made soup, breaded goats cheese roulade with blueberry mayonnaise, port and stilton mushrooms with caramelised pears and salami and manchego platier.

The soup was a delicious and welcome starter on a cold night. We followed it with lamp rump on creamy mashed potatoes with tomato and olive compote and pan-fried freerange chicken breast, stuffed with chorizo and manchego on a bed of

crushed new potatoes and slow roasted peppers.

There was a wide range of other main courses ranging from winter vegetable stew with herbed dumplings to blocked seabass with asparagus and prawn to Porterhouse steak with home made chips, roast mush room and tomato.

A feature of the menu was a quite remarkable range of vegetarian choices.

Desserts included chocolate brownie stack with hot fudge sauce, winterberry soufflé, homemade sticky toffee pudding or homemade ice cream.

Mind-boggling

Greenfields is also a delicatessen so the dessert menu also offers "anything in the deli counter" which extends the choice to mind-boggling proportions.

Our evening was made the more enjoyable by friendly and helpful staff – so we think we will calling again particularly as Greenfields opens from 7.30am (9.30am at weekends) and serves highly acclaimed breakfasts!


