Editor's Comment



WARRINGTON Borough Council's response to a campaign to increase free parking on pay and display car parks in Lymm is to scrap free parking altogether with a minimum charge of 30p!

Apparently this latest charging scrapping of two hours free parking and reducing it to one hour tree with a 50p charge for up to two hours.

You couldn't make it up if you tried – and on top of that we are told the charging policy could even be unlawful!!

Full details elsewhere in this edition of Lymm Life – but one can't help feeling that the controlling Labour group on

the borough council have decided to totally ignore the views of the 5,000 plus people who signed a petition co-ordinated by local Lib Dem activists.

I do hope this is not the case and that party politics is being allowed to influence decisions which could affect the livelihoods of local business people.

I realise 30p is not a lot of money in the grand scheme of things – and it certainly is hardly likely to offset the losses currently being made by the council's parking services scheme.

It is more a matter of principle – and also the inconvenience of actually having the right change every time you want to park in the village.

Could someone on the borough

council please try and use some common sense and introduce a parking scheme which allows people to pop into their local village and do their shopping and enjoy the local amenities for free for a couple of hours – or even 90 minutes, while at the same time introducing a worthwhile charge which deters people from hogging a parking space for most of the day.

Annual Charity Walk set for Lymm

THE inaugural Annual Charity Walk in support of Motor Neurone Disease will take place in Lymm on Sunday September 8 (starting at 12 noon).

Hayley Shatliff-Smith, born and bred in the area, is hoping to establish the annual walk around the pubs of Lymm, starting and finishing at either The Venue, The Wheatsheaf, The Spread Eagle or The Green Dragon, calling in at all of these pubs on a five mile circular starts.

The pubs will also organise additional activities for the walkers as they progress around the route, as well as before and after the event. Hayley's grandfather, Terry Shatliff, suffered from MND, and

she hopes that the route will become known as the "Shatliff Shuffle."

In the first year, Hayley is asking walkers to pay to do the walk, rather than raise sponsorship. Prices are adults £5, children £2. Donations are also welcome.

Motor Neurone Disease (MND) is a progressive disease that attacks the motor neurones, or nerves, in the brain and spinal cord. This means

brain and spinal cord. This means messages gradually stop reaching the body's muscles leading to weakness and wasting.

MND can affect how you walk, talk, eat, drink and breathe. However, not all symptoms necessarily happen to everyone and it is unlikely they will all develop at the same time or in any specific order.

order.

Although there is currently no cure for MND, symptoms can be managed to help achieve the best possible quality of life. However this is not funded by the NHS so they need to raise money and awareness for the people who suffer with MND



Bungalow appeal is rejected

AN independent planning inspector has backed local councillors who rejected a controversial plan to develop a small piece of land on the edge of the Green Belt at Lymm.

Mark Dakeyne, an inspector appointed by the Secretary of State for Communities and Local Government has dismissed an appeal by Mr B. Evans against Warrington planners' decision to refuse permission for a detached bungalow on land in Longbutt Lane.

He has ruled that the development would have an unacceptable impact on the character and appearance of the area.

The development would look like an encroachment into the countryside and proposals to widen Longbutt Lane and provide a footpath in front of the bungalow would contribute to the "urbanising" of the site, he said.

The inspector noted that the site had views across open arable land to Oughtrington Church spire, with more distant vistas across to the Manchester conurbation and the West Pennine Moors.

When the plan was originally onsidered by Warrington's considered Warrington's planning committee it was opposed by 19 nearby residents, Lymm Parish Council and local borough

councillors.
Cllr Sheila Woodyatt said: "I believe this is the right decision.



The site is totally unsuitable for development. It is a locally very sensitive site and any development would compromise the openness of the adjacent, very precious Green

"Longbutt Lane is a substandard highway and not suitable for additional traffic."



Woman wins stables appeal

A LYMM woman has won an appeal against Warrington Borough Council's decision to refuse planning permission for stables, fencing and gates on land off the A56 Higher Lane.

A government-appointed inspector has upheld the appeal by Mrs M Wronko against the council's decision, in December last year, to refuse permission for the development.

The inspector, David Kaiserman, says the use of the land for equestrian purposes and erection of stables is not inappropriate in principle, provided

the building is no larger than reasonable necessary.

Although the council believed the building was too large he did not think excessively large in relation to the amount of land associated with it. Although a building of any size would detract from an attractive view of trees, new planting around it – which would be a condition of the approval - would soften the outlines of the building itself.

Free parking to be scrapped – but is it legal?

FREE parking on Lymm's car parks is to be scrapped altogether, the borough council has decided.

In future it will cost 30p to use either the Pepper Street, Davies Way or Henry Street car parks – even if you are just stopping for two minutes to pick up a pint of milk

even if you are just stopping for two minutes to pick up a pint of milk.

The decision was made after the council received a 5,000-strong petition asking for extra free parking time at Lymm and in Stockton Heath, where free parking is also being ended.

It infuriated shoppers and shopkeepers alike. One disgruntled shopper said: "The council has raised two fingers to the people of Lymm."

The opposition Liberal Democrat group on the borough council

condemned the move – and claimed the council could be

claimed the council could be breaking the law.

Cllr Brian Axcell, the Lib Dem highways spokesman, said the ruling Labour group had not listened to the people. If they had, they would have restored a two-hour free period instead of ending free parking altogether.

He said: "Charging 30p for the first hour will either act as a disincentive to visit Lymm and

disincentive to visit Lymm and Stockton Heath or encourage drivers to park on the streets, making matters worse.

"It unfair because no charges are I tritial because no charges are levied on other district car parks in the borough."

The Lib Dems say the borough may be acting illegally following a High Court ruling against Barnet Council

on a similar issue.

Cllr Axcell said: "I have written to senior council officers asking for the two hour free parking to be reinstated until the result of an appeal by Barnet Council against the High Court ruling is known.
"If the ruling is upheld

on appeal then it seems to me crystal clear that Warrington Council has acted unlawfully."

The borough says it has made its decision after "listening to

Cllr Linda Dirir, executive member for highways, said: "One of the biggest issues was the or the biggest issues was the anxiety people have felt if they thought they might exceed their hour's free parking and end up not just paying for that hour, but getting a parking ticket. What we've done will completely remove that anxiety. Our new flat charge of just 30p for up to two hours' parking will give

up to two hours' parking will give people plenty of leeway.


"We feel we've reached a good balance. Inevitably some people will object to paying 30p for an hour's parking. Set against that, other people will be glad that their charge for two hours has been charge for two hours has been

reduced by 40 per cent. Nobody could reasonably object to paying 30p for up to two hours' parking. At a time of heavy pressure on council budgets we simply can't go back to free parking, and we feel this very low charge is a reasonable

compromise."

Cllr Dirir added that borough legal officers had examined the Barnet case and believed it had no relevance to Warrington.

Meanwhile, a Lymm Life reader snapped a parking wardens' van parked not only on double yellow lines but also half on the pavement in Pepper Street. He claims that when he remonstrated with the wardens they argued that they were allowed to do so.

Firm won £40,000 costs

A LONG-running planning battle against a Lymm company led to costs of £40,000 being awarded against Warrington Borough Council.

The award related to enforcement action against ADS Recycling, of Camsley Lane, Lymm following the borough council's decision to refuse an application for a variation of planning conditions which would allow the company to operate from 7am.

About 20 local residents, Lymm Parish Council and Grappenhall and Thelwall Parish Council also opposed the company's application.

But ADS, who claimed noise from its vehicles "below the level of marginal significance" successfully appealed against the council's decision.

They originally claimed for costs of £56,473 but eventually a settlement figure of £40,000 was agreed.



Campaigners fight to stop HS2



RESIDENTS of Lymm are now able to give their views about the proposed HS2 high speed rail line from London to Manchester and its spur line from Agden to Wigan.

The consultation period has started and will run until January 31.

Drawings of the route that crosses from Agden to Wigan show a massive 100m wide Y intersection at Agden, high viaducts over the Bridgewater Canal and the Bollin River and a further much larger 30m high one mile larger viaduct over the Manchester Ship Canal similar in high one mile long viaduct over the Manchester Ship Canal, similar in size to Thelwall viaduct.

The building work is expected to take up to 10 years and will mean re-routing the A56 and surrounding lanes.

The disruption will be enormous, according to campaign group ABLE

to stop HS2

There is already debate about the cost benefit case for the whole of HS2 and its rationale, based on 300,000 passengers a day. There are environmental concerns as well, such as its large power consumption

and the visual and noise impact.

ABLE say costs estimates are already more than £40 billion and says


