

Macular Degeneration – The IOL-VIP system

Age related macular degeneration (AMD) is a common disease of the retina that occurs in some people as part of the aging process. It can cause loss of central vision and in some cases make everyday activities such as reading, writing and driving difficult.

Treatment options for dry AMD are limited, but the IOL-VIP system has shown promising results, providing patients with macular disease with an improvement in their central vision. The procedure takes about 30 minutes and there is no need for an overnight stay in hospital.





Mercy mission to Moldova

FOUR Lymm High School students and two of their teachers are back home after a mercy mission to Moldova – generally regarded as the poorest country in Europe.

The party have been working, together with international volunteer-ing group Service for Peace, at an orphanage in the tiny country, which is sandwiched between the Ukraine and Romania.

They have been entertaining the children and helping with the running of the orphanage

Lymm Parish Council Annual Report 2007 / 2008

1. The precept for the year was £95,000 and £43558 was brought forward from the previous year. The total income for the year was £162387. The expenditure for the year comprised £25318 for administration, £16587 for the Village Hall, £1267 for the allotments and £95197 for miscellaneous items. The miscellaneous expenditure included Grant Aid totalling £46586 of which £12,000 was match funding for the Lymm Life Project, £7950 was to Lymm CAB, £4750 to Oughtrington Community Association, £3000 to Lymm Festival and £3000 to Lymm Dickensian Christmas. The total expenditure for the year was £138269.

- 2. During the year the following matters were either discussed, carried out or supported :
- a. The Duck Race in 2007 had to be cancelled for Health and Safety reasons. To facilitate all future road closures for Lymm events the Parish Council has worked with Sean Kerfoot who has set up Lymm Events Management. Lymm Events Management undertook the road closures for the 2008 Duck Race and this event was extremely successful. The cooperation of Warrington Borough and the Police had been greatly appreciated in setting up the Lymm Events Management Team
- b. To improve the sound quality at Carols at The Cross on Christmas Eve the Parish Council purchased a P.A system that was used at the 2007 event and the sound quality was greatly enhanced. The P.A system is available for hire by any of the local Lymm groups.
- c. The Rotary Club and Round Table organised a very successful Lymm Dickensian Day in 2007 and Tony Horne ran Radio Lymm for a period leading up to Dickensian Day.
- d. The Parish Council has worked with the Police to address the problem with speeding vehicles on Mill Lane. The Parish Council has continued to fund three Police Community Support Officers in

Lymm. The Lymm Police Office will now be open every Tuesday afternoon

- e. As part of the Westenders Project Oughtrington Community Association received a grant from WREN. The Parish Council provided £5270 as third party match funding to secure the grant from WREN
- f. The Parish Council has continued to support the Youth Club during the year. The Youth Club has been incorporated and is now known as Lymm Youth and Community Association. The Churches Together Group is keen to support the Youth Club and see the building more extensively used
- g. The Churches Together Group, as part of Hope 08, has organised two litter picks in Lymm which have been well attended and greatly improved the tidiness in the Village Centre. Several more litter picks are planned during 2008
- h. To prevent notices being attached to the trees at Lymm Cross the Parish Council has provided a notice board erected on the outside wall of the Somerfield Store.
- i. The Parish Council has continued to work with local horse riders to explore the possibility of having more bridleways in Lymm. Warrington Borough Council made a grant application to WREN to upgrade the TPT to a bridleway between Mill Lane and Birchbrook Road which was unsuccessful but a further application is being considered.
- j. The Parish Council has been involved in the organisation of a Sports Forum bringing together various local sporting groups in conjunction with Lymm Leisure Centre.
- k. A second Lymm Fair was held in the Village Hall for local groups to advertise their activities and recruit new members.
- 1. Lymm Festival : This event took place for a ninth year and was very successful. Honor Giles continues as the Festival Director.

The Parish Council's priorities for the year 2008/2009 are :

1. Car Parking in Lymm

Lymm Parish Council will continue to urge Warrington Borough Council to introduce pay and display car parking in Lymm to improve the car parking facilities for people shopping in the village. Warrington Borough Council will be carrying out a consultation exercise to ensure that the final scheme is the most suitable for both shoppers and local residents. The consultation is programmed to commence from September 2008 onwards

2. Working with Voluntary Groups

The Parish Council will continue to work with the local voluntary groups in Lymm and support all the Lymm Festivals. The Parish Council will host another Lymm Fair in March 2009 in the Village Hall to give local voluntary groups the opportunity to promote their activities and recruit new members. A steering group will be set up to organise and publicise the event. Anyone interested in joining the steering group should contact Cllr Griffiths on 754651.

Fundraisers meet researchers

LYMM couple Anne and Paul Scales who have raised £90,000 for research into the rare Kabuki Syndrome in memory of their daughter, Hannah, organised a trip to see how the money was being used being used.

Friends, relatives and the community have supported the fundraising in memory of Hannah who died, aged six, from meningitis after her immune system had been

Immune system had been weakened by Kabuki. The couple organised a visit to a Kabuki research group at St Mary's Hospital, Manchester, to find out more about their work. about their work. A total of 21 people went

on the trip.

They were welcomed by Professor Dian Donnai who diagnosed the rare syndrome in Hannah – and who was full of praise

of the couple's 'spirit and enthusiasm'. As a result of the fundraising a dedicated researcher, Dawn Struttman, was appointed to work in Professor Graeme Black's research laboratory at the hospital.

Progress

The visitors were given a tour round the laboratory, shown the complex equipment which can look for genetic clues about the cause of Kabuki syndrome and told about the progress of the research.

They also met Peter Mount, chairman of the Central Manchester Hospitals Trust, who also oversees the research endowment funds. He congratulated Anne, Paul and their friends on the "magnificent"

fundraising success. Before returning to Lymm the party enjoyed tea and cakes, and were able to ask questions about the work. After the trip Anne said: "It was an absolutely amazing visit and everyone was impressed to see exactly what research is being done.

Everyone really enjoyed the visit and the team made us very welcome."



Vehicle Excise Duty

It's August, new number plates for vehicles are valid from 1st September; are you thinking of buying a new car?

The government is a leader amongst nations in its drive to reduce carbon emissions and in its drive to do so it has decided to change the way the Road Fund Licence Fee is calculated.

Earlier in the year in his budget speech, Alistair Darling set out a radical new way in which vehicles would be taxed. He has announced that the current seven band system will be replaced by a new 13 band system.

'Currently cars are split

between bands 'A' and 'G' according to their CO2 emissions, with cars emitting below 100g/km falling into band 'A' and anything producing more than 225g/km falling into the highest band 'G'.

From next April, the bandings will be tightened up with a new band 'L' applying to cars emitting between 225g/km and 255g/km and a new 'super band' 'M' for cars that put out more than 255g/km.

Because the government wants to crack down on

CO2 high emission vehicles, the tax for higher emitting cars will be dramatically increased from next Ápril with new cars being subject to a higher first year VED charge according to their CO2 emissions. Cars that emit under 130g/km will be exempt from this and cars emitting between 131g/km and 160g/km will not pay more than their standard VED rate. Any cars which fall into the new band 'M' will pay £950.00 in the 1st year

and then £455.00 thereafter.

Sorting office closure plan under fire

A COUNCILLOR has slammed Royal Mail over its proposals to close Lymm sorting office.

Coun Pam Marks says the whole idea of closing the sorting office in Bridgewater Street, Lymm, would lead to a poorer service for village residents

To a poorer service for Vilidge residents and would not, in the long term, prove cost effective for Royal Mail. In fact, Royal Mail had put off the closure pending talks to find alternative premises in Lymm, following a strike threat by the 14 postal workers based in the village

in the village. Coun Marks says she is relieved the closure, which would involve moving the workforce to Altrincham, has been delayed.

The local postmen provide a high quality service and have a great deal of local knowledge which they use with

initiative. Losing such a workforce can only be detrimental to the postal service, she said "Secondly, with the present concerns about global warming and the use of fossil fuels, it seem ridiculous to send a complete workforce in their own cars on a daily round trip of about 16 miles to collect their deliveries when at present a high proportion of them walk to the lymm sorting office because they have Lymm sorting office because they have been recruited locally.

Coun Marks asks where the postmen are to park their cars on their return to Lymm.

Currently, the postmen use pedal cycles and she wonders where these will be kept.





Documents outrage

Many of the documents bore the name Classic Mortgages, with an address in Manchester.

daress in manchesich. A spokesman for Classic Mortgage referencien Ital., said: "Classic Partnership Ltd., said: "Classic Mortgages went into liquidation a couple of years ago. We are a different company.

"I placed a box of old documents relating to the former company in the paper bin at Lymm at 9pm. They were all safely inside the bin when I left them.

"Someone must have got into the bin and scattered them around. "But they were all several years old and no longer of any significance." But a resident who helped collect

the papers, Hilary Knowles, said: "These documents bear the names of people applying for mortgages, with their addresses, bank details, etc. They could still be relevant!"


