

It's been a busy few months for the 16-year-old from Birchwood, who won £100,000 internet competition last April.

After sitting her GCSEs in June, Lucie jetted off to Los Angeles for a taste of the rock star lifestyle, recording three songs with guitarists who worked with Robbie Williams and Ayril Lavine. She was even interviewed by celebrity gossip columnist Perez Hilton.

She landed back in the UK in time to pick up nine grade A and two grade A* GCSEs then recorded another five tracks in London with Dsign Music, from

Norway.

In September, she signed a contract with her management team Erika Lee and 1 Click 2 Fame. Since then she's been concentrating on getting a backing band together ready to perform at record industry showcases over the coming months. Her proud dad, Rob Evans, said: "She's back and forth from London all the time. It's been a busy time for Lucie, recording and

doing photo shoots and interviews."

Cemetery is 'shameful'

WARRINGTON Cemetery is in a 'shameful' state and disrespects the people buried in it, according to a senior councillor leading a working group to

Coun Mike Biggin says £85,000 each year is needed to improve it - with the aim of providing a peaceful and well maintained public space which could be reopened for burials.

There are currently 15,000 unsafe memorials in the cemetery with overgrown shrubbery, uneven or sinking kerbstones, untidy plots and headstones which have either been propped up or laid flat to prevent the risk of toppling.

The cemetery, on Manchester Road, was opened in 1857 and is the final resting place of more than 130,000 Warrington residents, including war heroes, calculating and ground 2000 in unmarked errors.

celebrities and around 9000 in unmarked graves.

A working group was set up by the Environment and Housing Overview and Scrutiny Committee late last year to review its condition after public concern about its decline.

The group has spent the last year consulting with the public and piloting some initial renovation work.

The working group also hopes to establish a "Friends of Warrington Cemetery Group" which the public would be invited to join and to create a memorial to commemorate all unmarked deaths.



Holly in line for national award

A WARRINGTON kidney transplant patient, who spearheaded a high-profile campaign to boost organ donation, is in line to win a prestigious national award recognising the impact of her volunteering.

Holly Shaw, who will graduate in Early Childhood Studies from the University of Chester this November, will travel to London this month for the "vlnspired" National Awards, after winning a regional "Vinspired" Shout Award for her prolific campaigning.

Holly, (pictured) from Westbrook, underwent a kidney transplant in October last year, having spent more than three years undergoing regular dialysis while she waited for the phone call that changed her life.

During her time on the transplant

waiting list, she set up the Gift of Life campaign to encourage people to sign the Organ Donor register, and from humble beginnings the initiative has

sprung to national prominence.

During a national Donor Day earlier this year, Holly appeared on television and even received a personal message of support from Prime Minister Gordon Brown, as her endeavours prompted 3,200 people to sign up to

be organ donors.

Since then, Holly's campaign has continued. She spent six months with a documentary and remains an advocate for the Live Life Then Give Life charity, which supports those waiting for transplants and provides post-transplant support.

The university is part of the Cheshire 'vInvolved" team and is supported by funding from "v", the youth volunteering charity, which aims to inspire 500,000 young people aged 16 to 25 to get positively involved.

Holly said: "I'm very excited about going to the awards ceremony in London. I wasn't expecting to win the regional prize, so this is fantastic news. I started campaigning before my transplant and I'm not going to stop now, it has made a massive difference

"People take so many things for ranted, like being able to eat and drink what they want and going for a day out. Thanks to the generosity of the donor and their family, my life has changed and I can now enjoy these

things.
"Organ donation is something I feel passionately about and I'm thrilled to be able to spread the word. Fortunately my story has a happy ending, but that isn't always the case due to the shortage of organ donors in

"I was given the gift of life and I'll always be eternally grateful for that. I'm living life to the full and I'll never stop

campaigning."
Claire Britton, the university's volunteer co-ordinator, added: "Holly



has demonstrated courage passion for this campaign, despite her own health issues and academic commitments. I'm so pleased Holly has won the Regional Shout Award, and will keep my fingers crossed she wins the National Award too!"

Next month, Holly will celebrate the year since her transplant by taking part in an abseil at Wirral's Leasowe Lighthouse to raise money for Live Life Then Give Life. To sponsor her, visit www.justgiving.com/LLTGL-abseil

Diploma pupils go to college

SECONDARY school pupils from Warrington studying for one of the new diplomas in Society, Health and Development attended a workshop session at Priestley College.

The year 10 pupils are now

studying at the college for two afternoons a week, as they complete the diploma along-side their traditional GCSE subjects at school. At the workshop the youngsters looked at job opportunities available in the health sector.

They also practiced the kind of day-to-day tasks that are completed by an operational departmental practitioner within an NHS setting including the plastering broken bones and how to carry out Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR)

Staff from Warrington Hospital oversaw all activities and answered questions.
Tutor Lynn Dutton said: "The Diploma in Society, Health and Development, really is a new way of studying for students at this age. It is equivalent to five to seven GCSEs and takes up half of their core timetable, marking a shift away from traditional methods of studying.

"It was great to welcome in the practitioners from the NHS, the students had a good time and took away positive ideas about future career paths within the NHS

Behind the Golden Gates

WARRINGTON'S links with the slave trade, including trades in the town which benefited from the profits made on Trans-Atlantic slavery, have been

"Behind the Golden Gates" was researched, written, presented and filmed by pupils from six Warrington high schools.

It was premiered at the International Slavery Museum in Liverpool.

Last year the Warrington Humanities Network obtained a £17,000 grant from the Heritage Lottery Fund to research the town's links with slavery and fund the film project.

The high schools involved in the project were Birchwood, Bridgewater, Culcheth, Lymm, Lysander and St Gregory's.

Warrington Museum and the International Slavery Museum were also

involved

Pupils taking part in the project learned how to conduct historical research, how to deal with sensitive historical topics, how to plot, storyboard, script and present a film, as well as how to operate camera and sound equipment and to conduct studio editing.

conduct studio editing.

The film touches upon the range of trades within the town which benefited from the profits of the slave trade, Warringtonians who directly invested in slave trading voyages, the wide range of buildings and infrastructure projects in Warrington paid for by those profiting from the trade, Warrington Academy's role in the abolitionist movement and how some people in Warrington continued to resist slavery up to the time of the American Civil War.

A DVD of 'Behind the Golden Gates' will be available free of charge to schools and community groups. Warrington Museum is in talks to hold an exhibition about the project and its findings, while the International Slavery Museum intend to distribute it as part of their teacher training resources and show it alobally via their website.


Sports village clears two more hurdles




