## A NEW square in Warrington has been named Hilden Square to mark the 40th anniversary of the town's twinning with the German town.







## Payroll Giving Or Gift Aid?

AS the count-down to Christmas is under way, we make no apologies for revisiting the subject of giving to charity, and the tax benefits that can be gained by structuring your donation correctly.

If you are an employee, and if your employer operates Payroll Giving, then you can make regular donations to charity directly from your pay. The donation is deducted before Income Tax is calculated, which means that you get immediate tax relief on your donation at your highest rate. As an example, we will look at a donation of £10. This will be deducted from your pay and will be paid to your chosen charity by your employer on your chosen charify by your employer on your behalf. However, you will save £2 tax if you are a basic rate taxpayer and £4 tax if you pay tax at the bishes rate.

you are a basic rate taxpayer and £4 tax if you pay tax at the higher rate, meaning that the pay that you actually receive will only fall by £8 or £6 respectively. You can make all of your donations to a single charity or you can split your donations between several. One further alternative that may be available is that you receive a charity "chequebook", enabling you to write cheques to any charity of your choice whenever you so wish. wish.'

If you do not wish to make regular

donations, or your employer does not operate Payroll Giving, then the Gift Aid scheme is available. By completing a simple form, including your name and postcode, then any donation that you make will be increased in the charity's hands by the basic rate tax that you have suffered on that income. Additionally, there is a Government supplement of 3p for

suffered on that income. Additionally, there is a Government supplement of 3p for every £1 that you give up to April 2011. You should not use Giff Aid if you do not pay tax as you will receive a bill for the amount of tax that the charity has reclaimed. If you pay tax at the higher rate then you can claim back the difference between the higher rate and basic rate of

then you can claim back the difference between the higher rate and basic rate of tax, and this is done by declaring the donation on your self assessment tax return if you complete one, or alternatively by contacting the tax office directly.

Gift Aid is useful for making one-off donations. It can also be used to pay annual membership fees to a charity, and even to pay an entrance fee to a stately home or wildlife sanctuary run by a charity such as the National Trust. You can even such as the National Trust. You can even receive a small benefit from your donations subject to fairly stringent conditions regarding their value

for the year, and this may therefore affect the amount of age related Personal Allowance, age-related Married Couples Allowance, or Tax Credits that claim. It is therefore important that you keep a record of all donations that you

make in each tax year under Giff Aid.

You should note that both of the above schemes provide full tax relief on your donations, but neither affects the amount of National Insurance that you pay


