Editor's Comment



NOT for the first time, a question mark hangs over the future of the historic Cavaille-Coll organ in the Parr Hall.

This time, however, we fear that despite consultation with those who wish to retain the 138-year-old instrument, there is a determination among councillors to dispose of what, to them, seems an insurmountable obstacle to modernising the venue.

There are those who believe that because the organ – one of only two of its type in the world – is of interest to only a minority of people, it should not be allowed to stand in the way of

progress.

But if that argument was applied across the board, the town – and indeed the world – would have lost so much of its irreplaceable heritage that it hardly bears contemplating. True, when a recital is arranged for

the organ, even one by a distinguished visiting musician, the audience is likely to be counted in dozens rather than hundreds.

But on the other hand, it features regularly in concerts by the Warrington Male Voice Choir, when tickets are like gold dust.

And on civic occasions, such as the Mayor's Ball, the organ, suitably illuminated, makes a magnificent backdrop, the loss of which would rob the Parr Hall of much of its atmosphere.





Town centre is 'much calmer' says council

TOWN centre Warrington is 'much calmer' of a night - thanks to a 10point plant drawn up by the borough council to tackle the problems caused by binge drinking and anti-social behaviour.

This is the claim of Coun Liz Smith, the council's executive member for Neighbourhoods and Communities.

The plan was launched in February to start a public debate on what needed to be done to address issues

of alcohol, disorder and crime.

One of the first actions was to close Lower Bridge Street to all vehicles on Friday, Saturday and Sunday evenings. As a result fewer incidents have been reported and the overall atmosphere on the street is 'much calmer', says Coun Smith. Since April, police have issued 165 notices requiring drunken

offenders to leave the town centre for a period of 24 hours.

a period of 24 hours.
The council is now developing a 'Warrington at Night' strategy and will be looking at ways of recognising and rewarding those premises who do comply with the regulations.

Coun Smith added: "We are

making real headway with other aspects of the plan. We know that there is still more to do to overcome some of the problems we have experienced, and to some extent continue to experience in Warrington at night, but we want to build on this initial success and learn from what is starting to work for us.

A FORMER architect who turned to art to help recover mental ill health can now see the results of his efforts on display in Warrington Town Hall.

Thanks to the support of mental health charity Making Space Colin Pearson, 62, took up painting to relax and illustrated has now Warrington's famous town hall.

A print of his work was one of many exhibits at a special arts exhibition organised by the national mental healthy charity which has its HQ in Allen Street,

Warrington. Former Mayor Linda Dirir saw Colin's excellent work during a previous arts exhibition and asked him if he could do an illustration of

the town hall. Colin duly obliged and his masterpiece caught the eye of current Mayor Graham Welborn and his Mayoress wife Elaine when they officially opened the latest exhibition.

Colin says the support he has received from Making Space, including taking part in art classes at his local college, helped him on the road to recovery. He was working as a local government architect at the time of his breakdown and had to give up work.



He has also spent 25 years in the police, rising to the rank of deputy commandant

He never had time to paint while working but now finds it an excellent way to relax.

After viewing various items of work on show at the exhibition the Mayor congratulated Colin and other exhibitors on their extremely high standards.

He said: "Work like this deserves to be on show in public places and we are delighted to have Colin's work on show in the Town Hall.

New Automotive Training Centre opened



'Marriages should be renewed like dog licenses'

A FAMOUS ex-Fawlty Towers actor has been making the Headlines in recent weeks. If you are thinking I mean Andrew Sachs following the now infamous 'Manuel Gate' saga you would be wrong. I am in fact talking about John Cleese.

As a Family Solicitor I was most interested by the ex Fawlty-Towers and Monty Python actor's comments about marriage and children when he suggested 'marriages should be renewed like dog licenses'. He went further to say, 'I think you should have to renew marriage licenses every five years unless you have children and I ťhink before you have children you should have to go and pass various tests and get a license to have a

child'.

Given that the actor is on his third divorce he is hardly speaking from a position of strength with his views on marriage. However, his comments also came in the week where new figures were published suggesting that something in the region of 40% of marriages end in divorce. I have to be honest this figure astonished me and in my experience that is not an accurate reflection of the true position. However, sadly it is a fact that the number of relationships breaking down or marriages ending in divorce down or marriages ending in divorce

is increasing. Regrettably, whilst there exceptions to every rule it would be fair to say that the phrase 'amicable divorce/separation¹ is a paradox but that does not in my view mean that unlike Mr Cleese and his soon to be wife or Paul and Heather

McCartney before them that divorce has to be acrimonious or expensive. I am always at pains to emphasise to those that I represent that they should always retain a degree of focus and where possible try and be sensible and civil about matters. It is always important to remember that the financial issues of a divorce do need

to be resolved and however the money is shared and in whatever proportions it is much better off in the parties pocket than in the court's.

The reality is that divorce is often a stressful and emotional experience for those individuals who are going through it.

I would strongly recommend that if you are ever experiencing difficulties in connection with any personal family issues that it is important that adviće is obtained from a solicitor who is an expert and more importantly can detach themselves from the emotion of the situation and provide an independent emotionless overview and guide you along the right path.



THE International Day of Older People was celebrated in style at Warrington Town Hall.


Invited older people from all areas of Warrington attended a tea party with the Mayor and Mayoress, Graham and Elaine Welborn.

Limited or not?

ONE decision that must be made by all new businesses, and one which should be reviewed regularly, is whether the business activity should be carried out within a limited company or not. A company provides at least some security against the loss of personal assets, and this will appear even more attractive when viewed against the rapidly rising number of bankruptcies and liquidations currently occurring. However, being a director of a limited company carries it's own risks and obligations.

carries it's own risks and obligations.

The Companies Act 2006 laid down seven statutory duties on directors, and all seven are now in force. These are:

- A director must act within the powers of the office, and these powers are contained within the Articles of Association of the company.
- He must act in such a manner as to promote the success of the company
- He must exercise independent judgement in performing his duty
- He must also exercise reasonable care, skill and diligence in performing those duties.

The above four duties have been in force for some time, and since October 2008 the following three duties have been added:

• A director must avoid conflicts of

interes

- He must not accept benefits from third parties, and finally
- He must declare any personal interests in all proposed transactions and arrangements.

The government have published guidelines on how directors should protect themselves against any claims by the shareholders that they have acted negligently or in breach of these rules. These include:

- The director should always remember that company's property belongs to the company and not to the directors or shareholders
- The director should use any specialist skills or experience that he possesses
- He must always act in the company's best interest, considering all matters including the welfare of the company's shareholders, employees and creditors.
- He must act within the company's constitution, and comply with any decisions that are taken under it
- He should ensure that a record is kept of all decisions
- He must remember that the responsibility for work delegated to others remains with him

• Finally, he should avoid situations where there may be a conflict between his own interests and those of the company or, at the very least, make very early disclosure of those conflicts




