JUSTICE secretary Jack Straw has finally admitted that the Omega site would be a 'good location' for a Titan prison.

I have previously stated that if the Government decide the Omega site is their choice for a new prison in the North West - it will, in my opinion, happen, no matter how much opposition there is from the borough council, local residents and politicians.

Mr Straw says it will bring a £15 million boost to the local economy with new jobs in the employment and construction markets, which during the current climate would be more than welcome.

But one has to wonder what local democracy stands for if local residents, locally elected politicians and a borough council can't prevent a major planning development taking

"I soon discovered that I had a passion for this, and knew I had tound my new career path. To broaden my skills base, I also completed courses in Beauty therapy, and it was when I had followed on from this to a course teaching spray tanning that I had a very upsetting and life changing experience.

and life changing experience. "As part of the course students had to spray tan each other. I had mine without any problem and expected to carry it out on the student who had just successfully given me mine. But she refused to let me tan her and would not undress to allow me to complete the tan. After a lengthy talk and a lot of coaxing I discovered that it was due to a disfigurement following a serious illness. I reassured her that this was not a problem, explaining that for me, due to my life experiences, there was nothing that I would not be able to deal with or see as being different from the norm. Masons gift for hospice

ST Rocco's Hospice in Warrington and other hospices throughout the country have received a major boost thanks to Freemasons.

Assistant Provincial Grand Master Dennis Rudd handed over a cheque to the hospice for £1,952 on behalf of the Freemasons' Grand Charity

The latest donation means that in the last eight years the Warrington Group of Masonic Lodges has donated nearly £45,000 to the hospice. This year the Grand Charity has donated an enormous £600,000 to more than 220 hospices in England and Wales. Dennis said: "The money is an important contribution towards the millions of

Dennis said: "The money is an important contribution towards the millions of pounds needed each and every year to ensure these respected services can continue providing free physical, emotional, social and spiritual care to patients and their families."

Warrington Freemasons were the first group to give £10,000 to endow a room at St Rocco's when the new hospice was built.

The latest donation will be put into the fund to pay for the new £3.3 million expansion at the hospice. The existing day unit is too small and so an appeal has been launched to raise the money to expand the day care unit and to provide additional resource and education facilities.

Already St Rocco's has raised \$3 million towards the cost of the expansion, which includes a government grant of \$619,000. It is hoped the new extension will be complete by Spring 2009.

Top hotel sold


A WARRINGTON hotel has been sold for a figure believed to be close to £1.8 million.

Making a will needn't kill you!

Too many people assume that the law will provide for their loved ones in the event of their death and that Wills are complicated.



House prices drop 15 per cent

HOUSE prices in Warrington have plummeted more than 15 per cent during the past 12 months – and apartments have dropped even more!

But it is not such a gloomy picture for home owners at nearby Lymm, where homes have fallen by just 7-10 per cent, with unique and individual properties still selling well.

Warrington based estate agent Dave Linaker predicts a tough year ahead for home owners in the town, with builders being very aggressive on price

Dave who runs New Way Homes with offices in Penketh and Warrington said: "Overall 2009 will continue to be difficult with the need for most vendors to be much more realistic on

eventual selling prices. "With builders being very aggresive with prices, specials offers and incentives, the second hand property market will need to be more reasonable with their expectations. For vendors who are going to buy on, the need to remember that any potential loss on selling price on their property, should be reflected in the purchase price of their new home

Tough, but respectful negotiations both up and down the chain will be the key to most property sales. Overall prices in and around the

Warrington area have dropped by approx 15 % over the last year, the decrease in apartments price is generally much higher.

He says the recent decision by the Bank of England, to again cuts interest rates to the lowest in its 300 year history had seen some lenders pass on this reduction for existing customers,

but few had made any decision to

change to new deals. "With more pe "With more people refinancing difficult, if finding either remortgaging or any type of unsecured/secured lending, it is worth remembering to seek advice quickly if you are having any difficulty or indeed expect too. If advice is needed our time is free and we can help on remortgages, reducing debt, debt management and IVA's.

Meanwhile New Way Homes

have now ventured into the lettings market which remains relatively robust.

But she said activity had been busier this January than the same time last year and people with individual and unique properties were still able to sell at a good price.

"Some people are realising that now is actually a good time to move to a property they may not have been able to afford 12 months ago," said linda

"I think the main ones to suffer are the modern houses on new estates where most of the houses are almost all the same

"If you have something unique, like an individual cottage which has been well renovated, you will still get a good price for it.

"People still want to live in Lymm because of its great location, the local schools and the nearby motorway networks and airport."

Russell - better known as Russ had a variety of careers before setting up in the market, including being a pub landlord at the Old Ball, Winwick Road.


He loved horse racing and was a keen fan of Stoke City Football Club, having met Gordon Banks on many occasions.



Operating a business through a limited company can be very tax effective as well as providing a safeguard to the business owner. There is, for instance, tax relief on the purchase of goodwill that is available only to an incorporated

business. However, it can be expensive getting the money out of the company. In the majority of cases the cheapest way of getting money out of the company into the hands of the business owner is by way of dividends. This avoids the charge to National Insurance that is suffered by any employee on their salary, and also the additional charge to National Insurance that the company has to pay on it's payroll costs. However, dividends are not deductible against the profits of the company before scheduler to the company before calculating tax. Under certain circumstances it may be advisable to find other ways of getting the money out of the company and one way of efficiently remunerating employees is by way of benefits-in-kind.

There are a number of tax efficient

a liter a number of hax enclenn benefits that can be provided. 1. It is not usually possible to claim a tax deduction for clothing. However, there are exceptions to this. Firstly, protective clothing is an allowable expense. A more

useful exception, however, is if the clothing carries the name or logo of the employer. For instance, a discreetly placed logo on the breast pocket of a suit would normally render it unsuitable for wear other than at work and not, therefore, taxable.

2. Another benefit that we are all used to is staff parties. Provided the amount spent is no more than $\pounds150$ per head per annum then the benefit of annual staff functions is tax free.

3. The provision of free or subsidised parking is also non-taxable and this even applies where the employee pays for

arking in a public car park. 4. Free or subsidized meals in a staff canteen are also taxfree. The canteen must be available to all employees, but must not be open to the public. Perhaps somewhere out there is a husband/wife company operating from their home who have succeeded in getting their kitchen allowed as a canteen. If so, we would love to hear from you!

5. Finally, the most valuable tax-free benefit is the payment of pension contributions which can be into a company scheme or into personal pension plans of the employees. By paying the

contribution direct the company saves not only the National Insurance payable by the individual but also the additional contributions on company those

payments. It is important to remember that for any expenditure to be classed as a benefit-inkind then it must be in respect of a company liability and not relate to a liability of the individual employee. If the latter applies then the payment is subject to PAYE and both tax and national Insurance is payable on the grossed-up amount of the payment. WatkinsonBlack are pleased to advise




