

Both George and Will have been hailed by Leader of the Council Ian Marks and Head Teacher at Birchwood High School Anne Bright as a perfect role models for others in



the town.

George has found fame and fortune since winning the competition, but is still humbled by the experience.

He said: "Winning means a lot to me. It has taken a huge weight off my shoulders in terms of family problems. "It won't change me as a person,

but it will definitely change my life style.

He eventually won the hearts of the nation at the second attempt after being sent packing by judges Amanda Holden and Piers Morgan in the competition last year.

Now the Birchwood star will perform at the Royal Variety Show in December in front of Prince Charles, not to mention receiving a £100,000 cheque for winning

Meanwhile Boteler boy Will was hailed by former Mayor Celia Jordan as 'Multi-talented' "There isn't anything Will doesn't do, whether it is sports, music, school council, establishing links between students and staff, she said.

"He is a fine example of what our

Award for January. Will said: "It is fantastic to have won. I was really surprised when the mayor read my name out. It has been brilliant to meet all the other winners as well and hear about the fantastic thing they have done.

Forget Everything And Run FEAR - we have all felt it at some time in our life, whether the fear was real or perceived, it still has an affect on us, it can send us into fight, flight or freeze reaction or it

may make us act in a positive way. For some people FEAR can stand for 'Forget Everything And Run', or it could be, 'Fiction Envisioned As Real'. Fear is just an emotion which creates a physical response, and we react in whatever way we feel is appropriate at the time, even if it is inappropriate to do so! Phobias are a good example, when we are not faced with the situation which causes the phobic response we are rational, cool, often calling the phobic response silly or stupid, and even laughing about it. But when in the situation which causes the phobic response, logic and humour are forgotten, the learned response kicks in and we forget everything and run! Imaginings can also create fear. Even though an imagined event has not happened, nor is very likely to do so, the imagined event can create just as powerful a response as one actually happening in the moment.

Since fear is an emotion which creates a physical response, change the thought and the physical response changes too. When we are fearful in the moment we rarely stop to think through the problem, we just react. Often the answer is simply to stop and think. Introduce some logic to the thought process, and when you introduce something new, the response is changed too.

If we live a life of fear and dread, we are robbing ourselves of living the life we want to live. We are sabotaging our lives and often the lives of those around us because we are not allowing ourselves to be the person we are capable of being. If this state of mind continues for any length of time, our emotional energy is often drained, wasted on fear of imaginings. And yet we have the capability to be and do more, we are capable of learning and relearning ways to think, feel and behave. 



Students help industrial giants

ASPIRING engineers from one of Warrington's top colleges have successfully resolved problems for two major industrial giants.

Students from Priestley College have been working with Fiddlers Ferry Power Station and Solvay Perstorp on two specifically arranged projects as part of an engineering enrichment course.

An engineer from both organisations has worked with the two groups since September on two problems, culminating in the trial of test models.

The students were divided into two

groups, the first had to find a solution to extracting debris from fuel at Fiddlers Ferry, while the others were challenged to design and build a machine that would break down 25 kg bags of neo-pentyl glycol (NPG)at Solvay Perstorp. All of the students from the Loushers





a more natural appearance. Wrinkles that are present when facial muscles are relaxed, although they can be reduced over time, are unable to be fully resolved using botox treatment alone. A dermal filler is a substance which is injected into the skin A dermai filler is a substance which is injected into the skin to plump if up, make it firmer and smooth out lines and wrinkles by replenishing both volume and tone. Old Hall plan put on hold

PLANS to convert one of Warrington's most historic buildings into state-of-the-art apartments are set for further scrutiny from Town Hall planners.

Warrington Borough Development Control Council's Committee decided a site visit was needed to determine whether to allow the plans on the site of Bewsey Old Hall. Urban Splash Ltd submitted two

proposals to the committee to convert the Grade Two listed building into seven apartments, with a further 48 also being erected on the site.

There have been strong objections raised from neighbours, councillors and local organisations, who say there would be a loss of green space, increased traffic congestion and a disregard for the heritage site, should

the plans be given the green light. Planners have however committed to retaining some of the historical features of the building, creating a new ranger section and improving

pedestrian access. Bewsey Old Hall was originally built by William Fitz Almeric le Boteler and it was home to the Lords of Warrington from the 13th Century.


The manor house - described as Warrington's "hidden gem" was lost in a gambling debt 700 years ago by the Boteler family. It is reputed to be haunted and in

1997 a campaign was launched to turn it into a tourist attraction.

The future of the site remains uncertain until the site visit and another development control consultation has taken place.



MANY people already work from home, and with the increase in fuel and other whenever home working is possible in the future. The question then arises of what expenses can the employee offset against his income.

Usually, employers will reimburse the employee for expenses incurred. Reimbursement of expenses incurred on accommodation, goods and services can be made without the deduction of tax and National Insurance provided firstly that the private use of those items by the employee or their family is insignificant and, secondly, the sole purpose of their use is in the performance of the employment duties. Claims can cover furniture and

equipment, including computers, secretarial assistance, postage & stationery, telephone, rent, and other expenses necessary for the employee to perform their duties. Not surprisingly, the provision of motor vehicles, boats and/or aircraft is not covered, and a benefit charge will always be incurred if any of these are provided. Business rates can be claimed if they are being charged on the property, but council tax is always considered private.

An employee will need to be able to

provide evidence of the expenses incurred. The one exception to this rule is an agreed scale rate published by revenue & Customs of £3 per week, and a reimbursement up to this level can be made without receipts. It is open to the employer to agree a scale charge in excess of this level, although if Revenue & Customs consider the amount excessive then they may challenge it on the basis of disguised remuneration.

If the expenses are not exempted from tax under the above then the strict rules for claiming an expense against employment income must be followed, and these require the expenses to be incurred wholly, exclusively and necessarily in the performance of the duties of the employment. In these circumstances reimbursement can only be made if the

• the employee must perform "substantive duties" at home, that is the duties must be all or part of the central duties of his employment

• these duties cannot be performed without the use of the facilities


