## Editor's Comment

THE status quo was maintained on Warrington Borough Council following the local elections, with the joint administration between the Lib Dems and the Tories set to continue for at least another two years.

Although there were a couple of surprises, most notably at Hatton, Stretton and Walton where the Tories made a surprise gain from the Lib Dems

### Death toll at lowest rate for eight years

THE number of people being killed on Warrington's roads has hit its lowest levels for eight years according to Cheshire Police.

In fact the number of deaths for the whole of Cheshire is at its lowest levels whole of Cheshire is at its lowest levels since 2000, with the total number of casualties falling last year by six per cent. In 2007, a total of 47 people lost their lives on Cheshire's roads, but in 2006 the total number was 64.

Chief Constable of Cheshire Police,

Peter Fahy, believes although recent figures are encouraging, more work needs to be done.

He commented: "While it is encouraging to see a downward trend in the number of casualties and indeed the number of overall collisions, it is still unacceptable that 47 people lost their lives needlessly in collisions last year and the challenge still remains. Death and injury on our roads is preventable and we are committed to continuing this downward trend – one casualty on Cheshire's roads is one too many

at the expense of Peter Walker and at Penketh where Labour stalwart George Warburton lost out, again to the Tories, there was no overall change in the council, although the Lib Dems made gains from Labour in Bewsey and Whitteress and in Whitter Labour the Lib Labour in Sewsey and Whitteress and in Whitter Labour the Lib Labour the Labour Whitecross and in Whittle Hall.

Surprisingly to some, the joint administration appears to be working reasonably well and it is refreshing when local politicians an put their political differences behind them - as the needs of the local community should

always come before party politics.

Despite close working relationships with the borough council I have never been afraid to make my view point known if I believe those in power have got something wrong – so it is only right that when they do something well it should be pointed out.

I recently had the honour presenting one of the prizes at the Borough Council's annual staff awards when I presented the 'investing in our communities' award to the Family Reading Service, who were rewarded for being actively involved in initiatives to support the community – something very close to our hearts here at **warrington-worldwide**.

They were one of 28 finalists at the awards ceremony, instigated by the counci last year to recognise the achievements of their employees.

The event proved to be a great success and it was good to see those running the services in our town being recognised for their hard work and dedication



### What Price Our Health?

FOR many it is recognised as the precious gift it is. For many others it is taken for granted; only valued when it is threatened, or destroyed. ### Labour are main election losers

LABOUR were the main losers as the controlling Lib Dem Tory alliance made

But it was mixed fortunes for the Lib Dems who missed out on taking overall control of the council by just one seat – ironically losing out to the Conservatives at Hatton, Stretton and Walton, where veteran councillor Peter Walker lost out to Tory Paul Kennedy - a popular member of the warrington-worldwide discussion forum!

The Lib Dems made two gains from Labour in Bewsey and Whitecross and Whitle Hall, while the Tories made gains at Hatton, Stretton and Walton and Penketh.

Former Mayor George Warburton lost his seat at Penketh and Cuerdley to Conservative Paul Campbell.

It was a painful election success for another former Mayor, Pauline Nelson, who had to receive hospital treatment earlier in the day after having her finger savaged by a dog as she put an election leaflet through a letterbox.

She declined to comment on the incident due to a police investigation but turned up at the count with her finger heavily bandaged. She is believed to have lost part of her finger!

### **Enhanced Capital Allowances**

IF a business purchases plant or equipment for use within the business then the cost of these purchases are not deductible against profits. Instead, the business is allowed to claim Capital Allowances which were generally set at 25% of the cost or remaining value each year. However, Enhanced Capital Allowances in the year of purchase are available on certain types. of purchase are available on certain types of assets, and are also available to small and medium sized businesses on general expenditure. Subject to certain restrictions these businesses can offset 40% of the cost of the assets against profits in the first year,

of the assets against profits in the first year, and small companies could claim 50% on expenditure up to 5th April 2008.

The budget in 2007 proposed a further measure. Although still subject to change, this will take effect from 6th April 2008 and introduces the concept of an "Annual Investment Allowance" (AIA). This gives full tax relief on the first \$50,000 of annual expenditure incurred on plant and expenditure incurred on plant and machinery. There are, of course, some exclusions, the most common ones being:

- Pre-existing assets introduced into a
- Expenditure in the final period of a

Subject to these exceptions, however, the AIA is available to businesses of all sizes. For the vast majority of businesses this will be a major simplification to the law on capital expenditure, the level of £50,000 being sufficient to ensure that the previous rules will no longer apply. If, however, a business does spend more that £50,000 in any one year on capital expenditure then the business can choose which expenditure is included in the AIA and which is subject to the old rules. This will be relevant if costs have been incurred

on assets that potentially attract Capital Allowances at different rates.

So much for the good news! Now for a couple of items that may not be so welcome to some people.

Firstly, for plant purchased under the old rules and which are already in the "pool", rules and which are already in the "pool", as well as for new plant which is either in excess of the £50,000 or is within one of the exceptions, the rate at which the cost can be written off is reduced from 25% to 20%. At the same time, the rate at which Industrial & Agricultural Buildings can be written down is reduced by 25%.

Secondly, the budget introduced measures to restrict loss relief available to paractive, participators in a business.

non-active participators in a business,

which is broadly defined as someone spending less than 10 hours a week in it. Loss relief is now restricted to a total of £25,000 unless it is part of a tax avoidance scheme in which case no relief will be available. This is, surprisingly, more generous than the existing "hobby

farming" provisions.
