turn around fortunes but after a brief spell of success under new Head Coach Jimmy Lowes, normal service was resumed.


Silverware

- Limited liability partnerships
- Doorstep selling



Urgent action required to tackle flash floods

AN angry councillor is calling for urgent action following flash floods which caused tens of thousands of pounds worth of damage to Warrington homes as torrential rain overloaded sewers and drainage pipes.

Thousands of gallons of water and raw sewage inundated houses in Densham Avenue, Longford during the early hours, stranding residents on upper floors.

Not realising the health implications local children made the most of the conditions paddling and



riding their bikes through raw sewage.

Fire crews raced to the scene but were powerless to help because there was nowhere to pump the flood water to.

Homes were flooded with water and raw sewage.

> Two families had to be evacuated while others decided to stay in their for homes security reasons.

Coun Hannon said: "Densham Avenue is renowned for flooding. This has happened many times before.

"The forecast was for heavy rain - it could not have been more precise. The forecasters got it right.

"But no precautions were taken. No sandbags were taken to the area.

Artist Martin Trainer saw five years of his work destroyed by the flood waters and is angry that the council wouldn't supply him with sandbags because he is an owner occupier.

Neighbours eventually gave him some of their



sand bags but not before the downstairs of his home and his workshop were under water.

Coun Hannon added: "Nobody seems to know why the flooding is happening. But I am demanding answers as a lot of peoples lives have

been ruined. "We need solutions and we need them fast."

Elsewhere in Warrington there were reports of flooding – at Lymm and in Sankey Valley Park. But nothing on the scale of Densham Avenue

Ex-Mayor who beat the Party machine

THE death has occurred of a former Mayor of Warrington who proved that it is, sometimes, possible for an individual to stand up against a party machine and win.

Ron Crocker, was elected Mayor in May, 1969 and was a member of the council for 23 years, representing the Fairfield ward where he ran a sub post office in Padgate Lane. For most of his time on the council

he was a Conservative. But for a few years, prior to becoming Mayor and following a dispute with his party, he served as an Independent, polling more votes than the Tory and Labour candidates in his ward combined!

He also helped found an Independent Group, which tried and almost succeeded to win other seats on the borough council.

He eventually made his peace with the Conservatives, rejoined and became Mayor. It was rumoured at the time that this was his price for

ne time that this was his price for making peace with the party. Later in his political career, however, he went to extraordinary lengths – quite literally – to keep the Tories in power.

On his retirement from the post office he moved to Cleveleys but for three years made regular 100-mile round trips back to Warrington to attend council meetings. Labour and Conservative both had 29 seats but the Tories held all the committee chairmanships and the Mayor was also a Tory, all with casting votes. Providing Coun Crocker attended every meeting they could still control the council.

Born in India, the son of an Army



officer, Ron Crocker proved courage and independence of mind long before he became a councillor. He served in the RAF during World War 2 and was awarded the Distinguished Flying Cross after flying 55 missions over Germany with Bomber Command. He held the rank of Flight Lieutenant. In 1978 he w

In 1978 he was commended by the Post Office and presented with a £100 cheque after tackling an intruder at his post office.

Mr Crocker died, aged 87, at a hospice in the Isle of Man after a lengthy illness. He is survived by his wife of 67 years, Audrey, a son, two daughters and eight grandchildren.

From its early days the club has now grown to more than 200 members and

has a thriving junior section. One of the founder members Alf Smith, aged 87, a local resident of Old Hall for 26 years said: "I moved to the area in 1982 having retired from Manchester Corporation. Close to where I live there was a pool nestled in a new housing estate, the road to which was named Livingstone Close. "At the time most of Warrington was

run under the auspices of 'Warrington New Town' and the pool in question

was and is known as Whitegate Pool. "At the same time my local pub then was the Sportsman's Arms in Penketh.

There were five of us drinking there who were keen fishermen but had nowhere to fish. To cut a long story short we got in touch with Warrington new town who offered us 'Whitegate Pool' for fishing. They then installed fishing platforms to make it a safe area to fish. From that day to this we still rent the pool, although it is now in the hands of Warrington Borough Council." The club officially started in

September 1983 and at the time was known initially as 'Old Hall Angling Society' but soon became Penketh & Old Hall Angling Society after some members were from the Penketh area and wanted it incorporating in the club name.

Back in 1983 the club had one pool, about 15 members, no junior members and no matches organised just ad-hoc fishing on our pools.

Club meetings were then held monthly in a room at the Sportsman's Arms, Penketh. Between 1983 and 1985, the

ociety gained two more pools from Warrington new town, Brownlee's Pool in Shackleton Close near to Gulliver's World, which they still retain today, although the land was passed to the Woodland Trust to whom they pay rent and the third pool was Mary Ann Meadows in Westbrook not far from the local ASDA supermarket. Unfortunately

due to persistent vandalism and pollution they gave up rights in 2005. Frank Davies is the current club Chairman, who instigated fishing competitions for juniors.

The club expanded sufficiently and began organising matches for Ádults initiated by former member Dave Smith In 1991 monthly meetings meetings

monthly transferred from the Sportsman's Arms at Penketh to the Bewsey Farm Pub in Old Hall, now known as The Maltings.'

Junior development fund was formed in the 1990's which was set up to support specific Junior activities. Now all Junior matches are free to Junior members, food and refreshment is also supplied free at each match and a 'Summer Series' falls in line with the school holidays.

The club has a recognised Child Protection Policy and they are currently in the process of organising members to attend a 'Level 1' Coaching Course

which is a '1st4sport' qualification and has been 1st4sport' developed in partnership with the Angling with the Angling Development Board (ADB) and the Environment Agency. The Junior fund also allows

free fishing equipment to Junior club members.

Club Secretary Paul Bryan added: "The club is moving with the times as it has to, especially when you deal with children and the requirements for risk assessments and health and safety etc. "We are aware that

Without their efforts POHAS wouldn't exist.'

Alf is still active and still bailiffs and fishes the pool at Whitegate. Here's to the next 25 years!

New bin service to boost recycling

The new larger blue bins which are

being launched can be used for steel, aluminium cans and tins, cardboard boxes and packaging, glass bottles and jars, newspapers, magazines, envelopes, junk mail, plastic bottles including juice, water, milk, shampoo and household cleaners

This scheme is in addition to the current black and green kerbside collection services.

Coun Alan Litton, Executive Board member for environment services said: "This improved service is all about making it easier for households to recycle more – all we need now is

for people to do their bit. "We are all faced with the challenge of what to do with our waste and the council is constantly looking into ways we can reduce the amount we all send to landfill - this new service is just one way we can do this.

£inancially yours By David Watkinson **Dragonfly** with teeth

UNTIL very recently IR35 seemed as nasty as a toothless tiger. Now, however, it has regained its teeth thanks to a Dragonfly! For many years it has been the practise

of one-man limited companies to reward the worker/proprietor by means of dividends rather than salary, and thereby reducing the National Insurance payable by both the company and the proprietor. First introduced in the budget of 1999, 1925 IR35 was designed to ensure that PAYE, as well as employer and employee NIC, was effectively deducted from income that would be émployment income except for the insertion of an intermediary into the chain.

It did this by introducing the concept of the 'notional contract'. So if John was the worker/proprietor of A Ltd which in turn had a contract to supply labour to B Ltd then IR35 said that the tax treatment of the various payments was to be determined not from the contracts between John and A Ltd and between A Ltd and B Ltd. Instead it was necessary to look at the 'notional contract' between John and B Ltd, and if that was a contract of employment then IR35 would apply. Since 1999 Revenue & Customs have

fought many cases over this legislation.

Many of these have gone against Revenue & Customs who have generally lost because the contracts included the right for a substitute worker to be supplied, and also stated that there was no control over how the work was done other than quality control. But all that changed with Dragonfly

Consulting Ltd! Dragonfly's contract included the right

substitute alternative workers. However, the customer gave evidence that they would be unhappy if an alternative worker turned up without them having been vetted beforehand. The Special Commissioners ruled that this qualified right of substitution was not inconsistent with a contract of employment.

With regard to control the Court decided that, despite there being some gaps, with the contracts lasting in total for over 3 years this indicated control at a level beyond that of just directing the worker when and where he should work.

Having failed on the above points the Court further decided that the two further planks upon which 'IR35 Proof' contracts rely, intention and worker rights, were

case It now seems that for a substitution clause to be effective then the right of substitution must be unfettered. This is a huge victory for Revenue & Customs, not only because of the extra £99,000 that only because of the extra £99,000 that they will now receive from Dragonfly, but also because of the many more companies that Revenue & Customs will now be eyeing up. We all await further developments and clarification of where this leaves a large number of contractors.
