Now in the Unibond Division One North, Town romped to victory beating Claire House Hospice All Stars 6-0 in the pre-season friendly, which also saw the reserves clinch a 2-1 win over New Longton FC from Preston.

The All stars suffered an early blow when ex-Man United star Lee Martin, who won the FA Cup with United against Crystal Palace in 1990, limped off with a ham string injury.

Town also suffered a major blow with last seasons leading scorer Thomas Lamb suffering a groin injyry.

The two games were part of a family fun day in aid of Claire House Childrens Hospice and special guests included former Man City star Gary Owen, now the club's ambassador, FA Cup Final referee Joe Worrall, who was made an honorary member of the club, TV presenter Mark Olly and Lord Hoyle, Chairman of Warrington Wolves.

The event was also featured live on Radio Warrington, the town's community radio station and provided an opportunity for other charities, including Warrington Disability Partnership and the Shannon Bradshaw Trust, to showcase their work in the community.

The club's new sponsors Johnstone's Paints, sponsors of the Johnstone's Paints Trophy, paraded the Football League Trophy at the ground giving the Town players a tatse of their possible future, with the ambitious club aiming to be knocking on the door of the Football League in the next five years.





#### Police accused of 'spin' over crime figures

CHESHIRE police have been accused of 'putting their own spin' on crime figures for Warrington to make it appear they are winning the war with the criminal.

Local campaigner John Mulhall raised the issue at a meeting of Warrington Police Forum when he claimed the town accounted for 29 per cent of all crime across the county while having less than 20 per cent of the population.

He said: That is a massive difference and what it means

is that Warrington needs more police officers

The level of crime is disproportionate when compared

with the population of the town."

But Chief Supt Gary Finchett said Mr Mulhall's figures were incorrect. In fact, he said, crime in Warrington accounted for only 21 per cent of the whole of the county. He claimed the figures given at the Police Forum meeting

were for the police northern area, which included Widnes and Runcorn as well as Warrington.

British Crime Survey comparator Crimes figures for April 2007 to March 2008 show total crimes for Warrington were 10,197, compared with the Cheshire figure of

47,384.

Chief Supt Finchett said the Northern area figures were compared by police to "most similar basic command units" such as those in Merseyside, rather than rural areas of Cheshire such as Knutsford. On this basis, he said, the area performed well.

Crime figures in Warrington were affected by "pockets of deprivation" in the town. But he stressed that overall levels of crime in the past year were down by 10.6 per cent. He said Police Community Support Officers were making an impact.



now they will be firmly in the saddle when out on patrols.

Inspector Andy Ross said: "The bikes are a great tool for neighbourhood officers as they enable them to cover a lot of ground. It means they can keep a close eye on larger parts of the community in short spaces of time.

#### Discreet

"The bikes help us access areas which are out of bounds to a car and enable us to approach areas in a much quieter, more discreet way – we can be alongside people before they have any idea we are around.

"These are great benefits when it comes to catching offenders or monitoring a problem in a particular

The mountain bikes are used by police officers, PCSOs and special constables and bear police livery and police markings.

Officers using the bikes will be equipped with helmets and highvisibility jackets, which were funded by the Safer Warrington Partnership.


PCSO Kath Harkin said: "The bikes help improve our visibility and accessibility in the local area, which is vital when you are trying to build up close links with the local community.

"Residents want to see us out and about and they want to be able to stop and talk to us about issues in their area. If an officer is out and about on a bike then it makes it much easier to do that.

"We can cover a large area on the bikes but are still very accessible to anyone who wants to stop and talk to us - it is much easier to wave down an officer on a bike than one driving a patrol car.

The bikes are a really effective tool in neighbourhood policing and are invaluable in our work with local communities.



This is a particularly worrying time for all businesses, and it is perhaps time to look at a few ways to help ride out this

It is always important to control costs and never more so than in difficult trading conditions, and one 'cost' that must be controlled is that of stock. It is very tempting to continue to produce goods when sales drop off in the hope of a recovery. This is often justified by saying that the stock will be required to meet orders when the sales do revive, meet orders when the sales ao tevive, but if that recovery is delayed then that stock must still be paid for, resulting in cashflow difficulties. These difficulties will be further amplified if that stock then needs to be cleared at a reduced profit or even at a loss. It is critical, therefore, for a business to closely monitor it's levels of stock and work-in-progress.

Controlling costs requires planning

and forecasting, and is part only of a much bigger process which includes forecasting your future cash receipts and payments. A sale is only completed once the cash has been received from that sale, and one major reason why some businesses become bankrupt is that a customer does not pay them for goods delivered or work done.

Sometimes it is very tempting to continue to deliver to a customer when continue to deliver to a customer when payment of earlier invoices is late, especially if it is a major or long-standing customer. Often this happens due to the fear of losing that customer to your competitors. However, cash is king, and a business should ensure that:

- it has proper conditions of sale,
- it's customers are aware of those conditions of sale, and those conditions are vigorously enforced.

are vigorously enforced.

A good customer will always meet their liabilities on a timely basis and will not object to you reminding them of those liabilities. After all, any contract should be a two-way street. If they do not comply with agreed conditions of sale then you should consider whether you wish to continue with the relationship as getting rid of poor

customers benefits you in two ways:

1. It saves you aggravation

2. It passes that aggravation onto your competitors – it is better for them to incur a bad debt then for you to do so!

Hopefully, the above will help your business to survive the present difficulties and be in a position to benefit from the upturn when this does arrive.
