Congratulations to local councillor Anna Fradgley on her endeavours – I know she has put a lot of hard work into the campaign to get the free one hour back.

A lot of hard work is also going into setting up the Keep Lymm Clean group, with the aim of encouraging volunteers to take responsibility for some of the litter which blight our village.

Traders face 'huge' increases in rates

A MEETING has been called to discuss 'huge' increases in business rates which are threatening to force some shops in South Warrington to close.

The meeting has been arranged by Lymm parish councillor Graham Gowland and will take place at Lymm Village Hall, Pepper Street, Lymm on Tuesday, May 16 at 7.30

Among the speakers will be Andy Carson, revaluation and market analysis team leader of the Valuation Office Agency and Mark Watkins, exchequer manager of Warrington Borough Council on Non Domestic Rates.

Cllr Gowland said: "A lot of businesses in Lymm and Stockton Heath have seen huge increases in their business rates.

"The meeting will cover valuations, exemptions and rates relief and how to appeal rateable values.

"By the date of the meeting the borough council should have in place its policy on rates relief - or how they are helping local businesses survive the increases.

"For some businesses, this could be the final straw - I know of one small shop that is seeing a sudden increase of £8,000 pa that could be the end for them."

The open meeting will not be discussing individual valuations.

Lymm takes 'best place to live' tag in its stride

THE people of Lymm took a rather blasé attitude to the news that the village had – once again – figured in the annual Sunday Times "best places to live" list.

There was a "oh, that again" response from many residents – and a touch of indignation from one long-standing villager who commented: "The Sunday Times seems to think we are a town."

Lymm did not come top of the North West list – that honour fell to Knutsford.

But the newspaper regarded Lymm highly for its proximity to the M6 and the M56, ease of commuting to Manchester and Liverpool, its variety of shops, the Bridgewater Canal and its general "prettiness."

One person who did not take the success lightly was local councillor Ian Marks.

He said: "I am delighted that Lymm has once again been selected to appear in the 'Best Places to Live' list. This comes as no surprise to those of us who are fortunate to live here. There is a tremendous community spirit and a wide variety of organisations and groups catering for all interests."

And on the very day that the almost completed building was revealed, news came through of an award of £88,200 from the Heritage Lottery Fund (HLF), which will enable the volunteer-led group to create a series of exhibitions and activities over the two year duration of the initial project.

The funding will also provide the means to create a series of learning resources and activities for schools and other local groups as well as develop an on-line digital archive accessible to all.

The project was initially made possible by local businessman Howard Platt who has personally purchased and funded the renovation of the building before handing it over to the Heritage Group for an initial three year period at zero rent.

The building is ideally located in the village centre close to the historic Bridgewater Canal on the site of former fustian workers' and boatmen's cottages. It will give the opportunity to tell Lymm's story through the three main themes of trades, transport and tradition as well providing a great focal point where visitors can pick up information before exploring the rest of the village.

The project has already generated huge interest locally and more than 50 people have come forward to volunteer in a variety of capacities.

Group chairman Alan Williams said: "We will be aiming to illustrate

Lymm's rich heritage, by celebrating the stories of the people who have made their lives here, particularly over the past 250 years as Lymm experienced the changes brought by the Transport and Industrial Revolutions."

Local schools are looking forward to taking advantage of the new resource.

Jane Rooney, head at Statham Primary School said: "The location of the centre is ideal as it is at the heart of the village and within walking

distance. Having the flexibility for our pupils to attend the centre and for centre resources to come to us will be a great way to explore local history topics which are so important to us."

The centre is already planning its first exhibition to coincide with Lymm Historic Transport Day in June. The Quiet Revolution will explore 150 years of cycling history and what it has meant to Lymm from the early visiting pioneers on penny farthings to present day tourism via the Trans-Pennine Trail.

Free one-hour parking to be re-instated

FREE one-hour parking is to be re-instated on all Lymm's car parks from the middle of May – and the change is being seen as at least a partial victory for local people.

The borough council has decided to revert to a full-hour of free parking instead of the 15-minute free period introduced in December which was regarded by most people as "useless."

After the free hour, parking will cost £1 for one hour and £2 for more than two hours.

All-day parking on the Davies Way and Henry Street car parks will cost £3.

Free afternoon parking will end – and a flat £1 charge will be introduced for evening parking, after 5pm which will last until 9am the following morning.

Sunday and Bank Holiday parking will remain free.

The borough council has also agreed to provide parking permits for residents who live near Pepper Street car park but have no off-street parking. There will also be a long awaited traffic management review in Lymm.

Parish councillor Anna Fradley, who had campaigned vigorously against the original changes said: "It was a long and arduous challenge, but with the support from residents and businesses in Lymm and with advice and guidance from solicitors, we have managed to re-instate the one hour free."

"I would like to thank Warrington Borough Council for handling the case so sensitively and allowing common sense to prevail."

Some Lymm residents have welcomed the decision, with one commenting: "It's good news for the daytime shoppers, and although they are charging all day now, there's a flat charge after 5pm to avoid hitting the evening restaurants too badly, even though we would have preferred no charge at all."

Cllr Fradley added: "Now Lymm will begin the process of recovery. The village centre has suffered as a result of the loss of free parking and businesses have really struggled. Parish Councillors are urging residents to come back to Lymm village and support local traders. Parking is still free after 3pm every day until the revised charges come in."

The next challenge is a steep rise in business rates.

Parish Councillor Graham Gowland said: "We are working hard to help traders who are facing a huge increase in business rates. A meeting is being set up between Warrington Council and business owners to see what can be done to lessen the burden."

Borough councillor Ian Marks said: "We are not out of the woods yet. We still need to ensure Lymm library remains open and that a Post Office returns to the village centre.

"But the re-introduction of the one hour free is a tremendous start to Lymm's recovery."

Lymm road safety campaign now spreading worldwide

A road safety campaign which was founded in Lymm by local resident Rod King is now going global - in partnership with the World Health Organisation (WHO).

Whilst campaigning for 20mph speed limits in Lymm and Warrington, 20's Plenty for Us was set up in 2007 and now 10 years later is being used by the World Health Organization in UN Global Road Safety Week 2017.

WHO have chosen Lymm-based 20's Plenty for Us to work on a campaign whose tagline is Save Lives #Slow Down.

It is international recognition of the success 20's Plenty for Us has enjoyed in supporting volunteers taking practical steps to slow down drivers on their community roads. 20's Plenty for Us already has nearly 400 community campaigns in the UK, Canada, US and Ireland. Events will run from May 8-14

across the world for the Fourth UN Global Road Safety Week, with the theme of speed management.

20's Plenty for Us have written a toolkit to encourage local people to get involved with effective, grassroots direct actions on their streets and run Slow Down Days.

A Slow Down Day is a street-based occasion calling for slower speeds. The format is up to the local organiser/s. They choose the place, time and activities. Options include decorating a street with slow down messages, a walkabout with decision makers, asking for a speed survey, enforcement or the loan of a speed gun and collecting petition signatures or pledges from drivers to slow down.

Rod King MBE, Director of 20's Plenty for Us, has already presented the toolkit on behalf of WHO at the United Nations Road Safety Collaboration conference in Bangkok.

He said: "It's a great honour to be chosen as a partner by the WHO. Our Slow Down Day toolkit will be translated into multiple languages and offered as a worldwide guide on successful community activism. We have welcomed the chance to write campaigning templates for others to follow. Since 2007 we've learned a lot from working

with nearly 400 20's Plenty groups in the UK, Ireland, USA and Canada. Now that knowledge will be disseminated globally! What started in Lymm, Warrington is now saving and enhancing lives around the world."



IF you have noticed a difference in how tidy the village centre and surrounding areas of Lymm are now it is because of the fantastic efforts of the newly formed group of litter pickers who have joined the Keep Lymm Kleen campaign.

Keep Lymm Kleen needs you!

The new group is being co-ordinated by Brian Harman, who is creating splinter groups of volunteers to work specific areas and on different days of the week.

A group is being formed specifically for the Duke of Edinburgh

award scheme which is perfect for the volunteering requirement. This group is already working closely together with adults and each other, co-ordinated by Brian.

Another team is tackling the village centre which is always in need of litter picking to keep it tidy and another along the Trans-Pennine Trail.

Brian said: "We are in need of more volunteers as we are looking to grow the team. So I would welcome anyone to contact me. Pickers, bags and gloves are provided by the Parish Council which I can give to you

"We had a first major litter pick over the Keep Britain Tidy weekend of 4th March and then another over the Mothering Sunday weekend. But it is the individual picks that people do day in and day out that help a great deal."

Parish Councillor Anna Fradley, who first set up the campaign

explains, "We all need to do our bit. It is great that we have this official team, but I encourage everyone to pick up a piece of litter if they see it and put it into the bin. You would do it at home, so why not in the village where you live? "

"Now that the good weather is coming, we get a lot of tourists coming into the village and this is what helps support the local economy. If we keep Lymm clean and tidy then it reflects well on us. Also, aren't we all proud to live in a wonderful village?

"Please encourage your children and young adults not to drop litter and maybe join in with the young team of Duke of Edinburgh pickers as volunteers to Keep Lymm Kleen"

THE funeral has taken place of John Grace, aged 78, of Dingle Bank Close, Lymm, who died in Warrington Hospital on February 2.




