Alan has been "the moving spirit" behind the creation of the Heritage Centre and is now chair the management committee. It has taken many years for his vision to become a reality but together with Su he has seen the dream come true. The Centre

aims to explain the many facets of Lymm's rich heritage through regularly changing exhibitions of artefacts and photographs relating to specific crafts or local industries. Among Su's many contributions to the setting up of the Heritage Centre, she has made a wardrobe of garments of yesteryear for use with schools' interpretation visits to the Centre. the Centre.

Aside from the Centre, Alan and Su have both made significant contributions to the benefit of the community in Lymm and this award

is an appropriate recognition of their achievements.

STUDENTS and staff at Lymm High School are celebrating another excellent set of A level results.

Headteacher, Gwyn Williams said: "The overall picture is one of another set of really strong results. When Ofsted visited us earlier in the year, they said that our A' level students make some of the best rates of progress in the whole country and the early indications are that

these progress rates have risen even further, which is something we are especially proud of.

Once again, we have seen very high numbers of students achieving the top grades and the numbers who are now able to go off to the universities of their choice look to be fantastic. There are a lot of very

57% of all A' level grades were at A*-B and 84% A*-C. The overall pass rate was over 99%.



Impressive year of GCSE Results



LYMM High School reported another impressive set of GCSE results.

At least 81 per cent of students have met the government's 'basics' measure of 9-4 grades in both Maths and English.

At the top end, a very impressive 27 per cent of students gained at least five 9-7 grades (equivalent to the old A*-A grades) with at least 45 students gaining 9-7 grades in eight or more subjects.

Twelve students gained the very top grades of 8 or 9 in at least eight subjects. They were: Imogen Walsh, Jade Carlin, Amy Wright, Cameron Green, Lewis Hindle, Ella Hoskinson, Amber Heckstall-Smith, Tom Davenport, Jada Moses, Jordan Jones, Marcus Mackay and Finlay Williams.

The school also performed very well again in terms of the numbers of students gaining a "strong pass" (i.e. grades 9-5) in English and Maths, with over 61% of students meeting this benchmark.

Headteacher Gwyn Williams, said: ""We're really pleased. Last year saw record-breaking results for the school and it looks as if we are on track to broadly match those.

"I cannot speak highly enough of the staff and students for the way in which they have tackled all the challenges thrown up by the new GCSE specifications; they fully deserve this success and I congratulate them all."

Consultants have been commissioned to prepare an assessment of the character and heritage of the Parish. This will provide the Neighbourhood Plan with vital evidence to support



policies which protect the features of Lymm that are important to residents."

Martin McKevitt, lead on Community, leisure and Wellbeing added: "Proposals are being put forward to increase the number of houses in Lymm over the next 20 years. We are keen to ensure that there are sufficient facilities within the village to meet those proposals. Our group are looking at the future demand for children's play areas improving local sports and community facilities GP and public health services, school provision and other amenities crucial to help our community thrive.

"The Consultation Day in October will be another opportunity to ensure the voice of Lymm residents is heard. We hope Lymm residents will come and share their views with us."

Return of Lymm Rushbearing Festival

THE ancient Lymm Rushbearing Festival returned to the village after

an absence of two years, following a new route through the Dingle.

Organiser Chris Limb decided to stop the tradition two years ago due to the rising cost of road closures.

But he decided to revive it this year, using a route which didn't involve road closures, with the parade of bull rushes taking place through the Dingle, to a special service at St Mary's Church.

Members of the Parish Council,

were joined by Lymm Morris, Bollin Morris and Lymm Jubilee WI and members of the public. Lymm Rushbearing was re-born in the early 1970's (having

probably died out in the early years of the century, possibly during the First World War) and has been held on the second Sunday in August, although it has over the years been held on other days. For many years in the twentieth century Rushbearing Monday was a local

Ormerod's late Victorian history of Cheshire refers to the festival taking place in many communities on or near to the feast of the parish's patron saint – hence Lymm's tradition of having the festival during the summer holiday period and close to the feast of the Assumption of Saint Mary. Although the carrying of fresh rushes to church (normally on a



horse-drawn cart) was a central feature, and the replacement of the old rushes upon the earthen church floor a very practical necessity in former days, this gathering of locals also involved festivities including not only the procession and Morris dancing but also sports, fairground stalls, and very full public houses!

"Rev Bev", as she's affectionately known, is Rector at St Mary's and will be using Harvest and the run to raise funds and awareness of Phenylketonuria, which causes severe brain damage if left untreated but is completely treatable with a very restricted low protein diet.

Florence Barham, a member of St Mary's Church Lymm's Sunday School, suffers with the condition. All money raised will go to The National Society for Phenylketonuria (NSPKU). Rev Bev, who will run round the dam five times representing each year of Florence's life, said: "Florence is a delightful, happy, bright little girl, but without a special diet, it could have been so very different for her. We give thanks to God at Harvest for our food and this year we thank God for the work of NSPKU who provide such support to those with PKU and their families.


