£725,000 heart unit opens at hospital

A NEW £725,000 acute cardiac care unit has been officially opened at Warrington Hospital.

The new unit merges the former cardiac ward C21 in Croft wing with the coronary care unit in Appleton wing in the former ward A3 and enables the concentration of cardiac specialist staff, facilities and equipment for the seamless treatment, recovery and rehabilitation of patients living with heart problems.

The first patients have been transferred to the unit which comprises the eight bed coronary care unit and the 18-bed ward

It has been adapted to create

and three 5-bed en-suite bays and three side rooms for the ward area. The new CCU zone benefits from

The new CCU zone benefits from a large nurse base which offers greater observation of bed bays while at the same time retaining patient privacy and dignity between male and female patients. The unit is fully air conditioned and has adjustable lighting and designated quiet spaces to create a calming environment.

As well as the significantly enhanced care and experience benefits for heart patients, the former ward C21 has been released as a potential winter ward to allow for an increase in bed pressures

during the winter period. However, the plan after winter is to develop a state of the art midwifery-led maternity unit alongside the existing delivery suite to offer greater choice to women in pregnancy.

derivery some to this greater choice to women in pregnancy.

Professor Simon Constable, deputy chief executive and executive medical director said: "We have long wished to locate all of our acute speciality wards in the hospital's main ward block, close to acute medicine, radiology and the

emergency department. The estates team have done a fantastic job within the confines of our ageing estate and our specialist cardiac and support teams are delighted with the new environment and purpose built space within which to treat our patients."

Mayor of Warrington Cllr Karen Mundry and hospital Trust chairman Steve McGuirk met patients and staff at the formal opening of the

new facility.

Whilst Warrington business surges ahead as ever, we start the year with an undoubted level of uncertainty

Nevertheless Warrington retains international status as a safe commercial investment location. Statistics just out from Cushman & Wakefield predict a 2.7 % rise in Industrial Capital Values in 2019 for the North West. I'm certain that if Warrington were singled out that figure would be higher.

In the coming months we'll be announcing the findings of our Annual Property Review, and early versions of the findings are already indicating another strong year for Warrington property performance.

As I've mentioned before, Warrington Town Centre is enjoying a residential renaissance with hundreds of planning applications approved or picaning applications approved or construction underway. In fact just up the road on Horsemarket Street, Emerald Bay has just obtained planning approval for phase II of their Kings Court Scheme, Phase I having been fully let within three months of opening. Endorsement indeed that the private sector is responding to the Time Square regeneration realisation.

I am confident that Warrington

I am confident that Warrington Businesses will rise to and overcome any challenges that the year presents and I remain confident that Warrington is and will remain a safe commercial property investment haven during the unsettled waters that inevitably lie ahead.



Thirty years on from when Jonathan Davies shocked the rugby world

THIRTY years ago Welsh wizard Jonathan Davies shocked the rugby world by switching codes including a spell at Warrington Wolves.

Although his stay at Warrington was relatively short, he made an major impact during his time in the town on and off the pitch—and proved a big hit all over the town, where he moved with his family, living at Westbrook near the cinema. cinema.

He was often in demand for photo shoots, including this never seen before PR picture taken at the former US Army Burtonwood Airbase by local photographer Eddie Whitham.

It was on January 7 1989 when Widnes Coach Doug Laughton pulled off one of the biggest coups in the game by convincing Davies to switch from a successful international career at Wales to join Widnes, where he had four

problems Davies switched to arch rivals Warrington for three seasons, making 67 appearances, scoring 43 tries, 232 conversions and 26

drop goals.

While at Warrington he was also named player of the 1993–94 season, winning the RFL's Man of Steel Award.

The switch also saw fellow Welsh Rugby Union stars Allan Bateman and Rowland Phillips become and Rowland Philli Wilderspool favourites.

Prior to joining Warrington, Davies took on a further challenge when he spent the summer in Sydney playing in the 1991 NSWRL season for the Canterbury-Bankstown Bulldogs.

During his time in rugby league he represented both Great Britain and Wales, scoring a solo try in Great Britain's defeat of the Kangaroos at the old Wembley in 1994 where he sprinted 50 metres to score in the corner. Although he left the field with a dislocated shoulder, his efforts in both attack and defence saw him named as man of the match.

Davies again played in Australia when he joined the newly-formed North Queensland Cowboys in

His last rugby league match was as captain of Wales against England in the 1995 World Cup Semi-final at Old Trafford, which Wales lost 25–10.

Playing as a stand-off, Davies kicked 3 goals for Wales taking his total score for Wales to 21 points (10 goals, 1 field goal), all scored in the 1995 World Cup.

After the birth of daughter Geena in 1995 Davies' wife Karen was


in 1995, Davies' wife Karen was diagnosed with cancer. In need of family support, and as rugby union had turned professional, Davies went back to South Wales and

signed to play for Cardiff RFC. In 1996, Davies was awarded an MBE and went with his family to Buckingham Palace to collect his award. In 1997, his wife Karen

died.
Since retiring from rugby he has worked in the media as a commentator and pundit in both codes, mainly for the BBC.

Dubious expense claims

Once again the tax return maelstrom has passed, we have and accountants can have a breather.
Therefore, I thought we would take a look at the lighter side of life.

The tax office has recently published some of the "dubious" expense claims received and which were rejected. They have even made a film about them, and this can be seen at https://www.challer.com/ youtu.be/wbGhdPKfzQU

The rejected expenses include a claim for

- a TV and sound bar which was to help the trader price up jobs,
- woolly underwear, and
- a music subscription so that the trader could listen to music whilst they worked.

- We have had personal experience of a sub-contractor (male) trying to claim for a sports bra and tennis dress as protective clothing, as well as a bricklayer claiming for a fortnight in August on the Isle of Wight, double room and a twin-bedded room, as conference expenses.

The claim for woolly underwear illustrates the hurdles that are placed in the way of claiming tax relief on any expense that could have a personal element. It is not difficult to understand that for someone working in an exposed location these items make working

in the winter more comfortable.

However, for any expense to be tax deductible by someone in business then it must be "wholly and exclusively" incurred for the business. Any personal element precludes a deduction. This excludes most "normal" clothing which is necessary to protect the

wearer's modesty.

For people in employment, as opposed to self-employment, the hurdles are even higher. For them the expense must be "wholly, exclusively and necessarily" incurred, which essentially means that not only must there be no personal element in the expense but the expense must be so fundamental that it would be impossible to perform the duties of the employment without them being incurred. This does not mean, however, that incurring the expense must be unenjoyable before it can be claimed. As an example, we do recall the case of a photographer who successfully claimed for the

recall the case of a photographer who successfully claimed for the cost of chartering a luxury yacht in the Caribbean for a fortnight which he shared with a bevy of beauties, as well as the travel costs in getting there from the UK. The time was spent in taking photos of the beauties on the yacht in various locations for a calendar that was subsequently published.
