## Council plans new £18,000 toilets for Lymm Dam

LYMM Parish Council is moving forward with plans for new £18,000 public toilets at Lymm Dam.

Councillors have inspected examples of the toilet units under consideration

and say they are strong and secure and not at risk of being broken into. Options being studied include units with roller barriers as a deterrent to people climbing on the roof or, the preferred option, anti-vandal paints.

### **Concrete platform**

Planning permission will be required and a concrete platform needed to secure the base of the unit.

Talks will take place with Warrington Borough Council – who own the site - in order to agree sharing the costs.

The toilets are seen as important with regards to the Dam continuing to have Green Flag status.

So far, capital costs are expected to be in the region of £18,000 with ongoing annual cleaning and maintenance costs of  $\pounds6,000$  – significantly better value than the previous toilets.


A maximum of 50 per cent of the costs would be included in the 2019-20 budget.

## New chip shop proposed for village centre

PLANS have been submitted for a fish and chip shop in the former St Rocco's charity shop at The Cross, Lymm.

The scheme involves a change of use of the lower ground floor from a charity shop to a hot food takeaway and the rear ground floor and first floor to a two bedroom apartment, including erection of a new front dormer and a new platform access at the rear to the apartment.

Demolition of an existing twostorey flat roofed rear extension and its replacement with a new, two-storey pitched roof extension, with living accommodation in the roof space is also proposed.

The scheme has yet to be considered by the borough council's development management committee.

## Homes plan

OUTLINE planning consent is being sought for two detached dwellings in Mill Lane, Lymm.

The proposals include access, layout and scale, with all other matters reserved for subsequent applications.

# When Belgian refugees "invaded" Lymm

LYMM'S historic links with Belgian refugees during the First World War were explained in detail by speaker Alan Williams at the monthly meeting of Heatley WI. Mr Williams (pictured), from Lymm Heritage Centre, told how, when Germany marched through Belgium, in order to reach the French border millions of Belgians fled the

border, millions of Belgians fled the country, some to the Netherlands which remained neutral, but about 250,000 to Britain.

The connection with Lymm was made when Percival Perry, head of Ford Cars UK decided to help find accommodation for as many tind accommodation for as many refugees as possible. He had several properties in the area including Beechwood in Crouchley Lane, now the rugby club and Oughtrington Hall, the old building at Lymm High School. With the co-operation of Henry Ford in America he transformed the ball into temporary accommodation

hall into temporary accommodation which initially was home to 90 refugees between 1914 and 1918 and 30 at Beechwood. However and 30 at Beechwood. However these figures increased over the years. They came from many walks of life and a new generation of children was born and went to school in Lymm. A working community developed, many employed in the hall but also on the land, for which they received a small wage, saved for their return home.

One hundred years later in 2017 Belgian Ludo Holens visited the hall, the birthplace of his father, to learn more about his family history. He much appreciated the help given by everyone including the parish clerk, the school and the Heritage Centre.

Vice president Ann Oakes thanked Mr Williams for his excellent insight into one aspect of local history.

# Lymm woman helps raise awareness of Hate Crime via virtual reality

LYMM based Jude Limb has helped raise awareness of Hate Crime through a virtual reality experience working with Manchester's Muslim community.

Changing Places – a collaboration between Jude's Mother Mountain Productions (MMP) and the Manchester Muslim community (MMC) - has created a 360 3D virtual reality experience that will allow members of the public to directly experience hate crime.

crime. Seeing hate crime from the victim's viewpoint - in effect 'changing places' with them, the film tocuses on Islamophobia, portraying the real life experience of a young Muslim woman who is subjected to this abhorrent crime during her day-to-day life. Funded by the Big Lottery, the

Funded by the Big Lottery, the national campaign was launched at GMP Headquarters during Greater Manchester's Hate Crime Awareness Week (HCAW) Feb 4 – 10.

Jude, who came up with the idea for the project said: "Many Muslims in Greater Manchester still live with the trepidation that they may be a victim of hate crime at some point in their lives and we think that this is totally unacceptable. We have been working closely with the Manchester Muslim Community ,to learn what could help them in such situations, nudging all of us not just to stand by and let these crimes happen."

to stand by and let mese crimes happen." "The Changing Places project literally puts viewers in the shoes of people experiencing hate crime by letting them feel that discomfort first hand. Ultimately we hope to shift entrenched prejudices and misconceptions and encourage empathy and understanding."

misconceptions and encourage empathy and understanding." Fesl Reza Khan, Chair of the Manchester Muslim Community said: "Hate crime is an ongoing issue and there is a need for communities to unite in a constructive approach to tackle the problem."

"We wholeheartedly support this project and feel that we need to engage more people in an open and honest dialogue about hate crime but also demonstrate how that crime impacts the people who directly experience it."

directly experience it." Changing Places is working with Greater Manchester Police and their partners to help raise



awareness of hate crime and prompt people to safely challenge and report hate crime incidents as well as stand alongside those affected.

During HCAW people across the city-region were encouraged to watch the film and sign up to the Greater Manchester Promise to show that hate crime will not be tolerated and that we are united against it: letsendhatecrime.com/ promise

# School raises amazing £8,000 to help boy with rare cancer

A LYMM school has raised £8,000 towards the £500,000 needed to try and save a 10-year-old boy suffering from a rare and aggressive form of cancer.

Oughtrington Primary School held a special day to raise the money for Harry Banks whose family was given the devastating news when he was six that he had Stage 4 Neuroblastoma – an aggressive children's cancer which affects just 100 youngsters a year in the UK.

He underwent two years of intensive chemotherapy, continuous investigations, major surgery, radiotherapy, immunotherapy and more

After the treatment came to an end, Harry enjoyed nearly two and

half years of remission. But in November, the family was devastated to learn that the neuroblastoma had returned – and as yet there is no cure for the relapse.

A two inch tumour has been removed from his brain – but doctors have warned that without further radical treatment, not available in this country, the disease will return a third time.

Harry lives in Woburn, but his cousin, Sophie Cook, aged nine, is a pupil at Oughtrington Primary and asked her head teacher, Gillian Marsland, if the school would raise money for the "Mad About Harry" campaign which family and friends have set up to enable him to receive further treatment in the United States.

The head needed little

The head needed little persuading and the school has held a "Yellow Day" to raise money. But youngsters on the school council wanted to do more so the special fair was organised. Dozens of local businesses

supported the event with raffle and auction prizes and parents, staff and friends of the school turned out in force to help raise as much as possible.

Nationally, scores of sporting nd showbusiness celebrities and supported the "Mad About Harry" campaign. Harry's Mum, Nina, said: "My


