**HAVE you submitted your comments on Warrington Borough Council's Local Plan and Transport Plan - if not why not? - This will shape the future of our town and impact not just on our lives but those of future generations.**

It is certainly worrying when you hear the former head of the town's planning department describing the Local Plan as "flimsy" and urging people to challenge and question it, especially the proposed development of our Green Belt, which is exactly what John Groves did, when I attended a recent event organised by residents' groups and local parish councils.

While Mr Groves has been employed by parish council's in the south to challenge the Local Plan, especially the development of Green Belt, he is certainly an "expert" and knows the planning process better than most.

We mustn't let apathy win the day – as it did when a proposed event for the local business community was cancelled due to lack of interest – apparently I was one of the few who responded an interest to attend! Whatever our council decide your views will count when the whole plan comes before a Government Inspector at a future date. You have until 5pm Monday June 15 to lodge your comments/objections.

Meanwhile congratulations to the Local Parish Councils and residents' groups who have come together to put forward a "professional" team to ensure no stone is left unturned in the bid to protect our precious Green Belt

for future generations to enjoy.

While this group has come together in the South the Local Plan impacts on our whole town so please don't adopt a NIMBY attitude – everybody needs to work together to ensure whatever future developments take place have the right infrastructure with the least impact on our environment. There has been some excellent campaigning going on in the North at Peel Hall,

while over in Culcheth, Croft and Glazebury, campaigning is ongoing to save the Green Belt.

The council does need to develop our town and provide more affordable housing and indeed some excellent work is going on in our town centre, regenerating it and encouraging more residential development. But we must ensure no stone is left unturned in developing brownfield sites before we consider building on any green belt.

# Eleventh woman Mayor of Warrington helping create history

**LIB Dem Cllr Wendy Johnson has been elected as the 136th Mayor of Warrington – and only the 11th woman to hold the office, following in the footsteps of retiring Mayor Cllr Karen Mundry.**

But with Labour's Maureen Creaghan elected as her deputy, the balance is gradually being re-addressed at the town hall - and means when the Deputy Mayor succeeds as Mayor next year, it will be the first time Warrington's history that three women will have served consecutively as Mayor.

Cllr Johnson, who represents Lymm North & Thelwall has chosen Warrington Disability Partnership, Walton Lea Project, MacIntyre and Contact the Elderly as her charities for the year.

Born in Warrington at Great

Sankey, she moved to Thelwall aged one.

In nominating Cllr Johnson, fellow Cllr Bob Barr said it was quite appropriate that she was becoming Mayor at the time the Golden Gates were being renovated. Her grandfather had been a planner at the town hall and was involved in the project the last time the gates had been restored.

She has served on a range of committees and working groups and has particularly enjoyed her time as the Chairperson of the Health and Wellbeing Overview and Scrutiny

Committee. She will be focusing on two themes in particular, tolerance and homelessness, in her year as Mayor.

Cllr Johnson said, "I have been a long-serving council member since I first joined in 1998. To now succeed to the role of Mayor of Warrington is an honour.

"I look forward to the year ahead and being able to support the charities under the Mayor's Appeal. I'm excited to get out and meet all the different residents of Warrington and to take on the new responsibilities of the mayoral role."

Her sister, Beverley Hallam, will be the Mayor's consort and support her throughout her mayoral year.

# Death of Freeman of Warrington Norman Banner MBE

**FREEMAN of Warrington Norman Banner MBE has died aged 71 after a near two year battle with cancer.**

Born and bred in Warrington, Norman, who recently retired as a solicitor with FDR Law, was well known and hugely respected across the town for his various charitable and community roles spanning more than 50 years.

He leaves wife Louise and his sons Mark (21) and Edward (15).

His voluntary work began over 50 years ago when he built and ran up the Youth Club at Grappenhall Independent Methodist Church for a number of years.

After graduating in law from Manchester Polytechnic, Norman joined Robert Davies & Co and served a total of over 48 years with one or other of the component firms that comprise FDR Law. He became a partner in the practice and rose to Senior Partner before retiring from the partnership at 65 continuing as a consultant solicitor with the firm until earlier this year.

Shortly after qualifying Norman was approached by well known local head teacher, magistrate and charity champion Marjorie Griffiths and was invited to join the recently formed Warrington Committee for Disabled People, an umbrella group representing local charities and statutory organisations to encourage collaborative work and an improvement to the provisions for people with a disability.

Norman chaired the committee for many years and out of their work was formed Warrington Crossroads Care Attendant Scheme which Norman also chaired and from which he also obtained the full funding for the first single occupancy vehicle with a tail-lift for Warrington Community Transport.

Involvement with Crossroads Care took Norman onto the national board which he also chaired for 10 years. Crossroads was based in Rugby and apart from monthly meetings, Norman spent many evenings addressing the AGMs of member schemes across the UK, visiting schemes in Scotland, Ireland and the Netherlands and attended and hosted many events in London including three receptions at No. 10 Downing Street. His weekday Crossroads commitments were taken as annual leave from his legal work.

Crossroads Care grew under his chairmanship from around 50 schemes to over 200 at the time of his retirement.

Following Crossroads, Sir Donald Wilson the chair of the Regional Health Authority invited Norman to sit on the board of the authority following which he appointed him as the first chair of Warrington Hospital Trust which office Norman held for 12 years,

the last four following the merger with Halton.

It was in the first weeks of the Trust that Warrington Hospital was at the centre of the town's brave response to the IRA bombing.

For 10 years Norman was on the board of St Rocco's Hospice for most of that time as Chair.

For the last few years he served as a Deputy Lieutenant of Cheshire and was a founder member of Cheshire Community Foundation where he was able to assist in the creation of a £1m + trust fund for the benefit of projects for elderly people ring-fenced for Warrington.

In 2016 he was awarded the inaugural Lifetime Achievement Award at the Warrington Business Awards.

There were many other local voluntary and statutory organisations that Norman has been involved with including the Warrington Festival Trust and Warrington Community Health Council.

He was also a regular at the Warrington Club, where he was a popular character, still visiting for lunches on a regular basis following his retirement.

# Digital app to showcase Warrington's best local businesses

# Exciting start for Summer with The Botanist coming to Warrington

The summer begins with the exciting news of The Botanist coming to Warrington, a real coup for the Town Centre and a significant vote of confidence in the Time Square development. ## Exhibition explores students' 'Fear of the Unknown'

**A GROUP exhibition by final year college students explores the pressures they face at an important turning point in life.**

Now / Fear of the Unknown, created by students at Warrington and Vale Royal College (WVRC) and on display now at Warrington Museum and Art Gallery, takes Charlie Brooker's Black Mirror as a starting point.

Inspired by the cult TV series which examines techno-paranoia and unease about the modern world, the work explores the pressures put on students by society and themselves at this point in their artistic and academic careers.

The group of budding artists have worked as a professional collective for the project, gaining valuable work-based learning alongside their academic studies at college.

Each of them has approached the project with their own ideas, concepts and beliefs about what is the next stage of their lives.

Subjects explored include self-identity and social conformity while the work on display combines traditional and non-traditional media including interactive installations.

Rebecca Rogers, WVRC's senior practitioner for art and design, said: "As a department we are exceptionally proud of our students and what they have achieved."

"They have worked to professional standards and time frames, and demonstrated maturity and management skills when liaising with the curator."

"They have gained valuable work-based learning experience as professional artists and received an insight into the creative world they will be progressing into after higher education and apprenticeships."

The exhibition is on display at Warrington Museum and Art Gallery until Saturday June 15.

# Students aiming for places at the UK's top universities

**STUDENTS from Warrington's Priestley College are taking part in a programme designed to give them the best chance of securing places at the UK's top universities.**

Priestley students make up nearly a quarter of those on the Pembroke North programme, which is organised by Pembroke College, Oxford University.

Former University Academy Warrington pupil Ethan Holton said he was enjoying working alongside young people from other North West colleges.

"As much as it's challenging, it's very open and there's an inherent comfort knowing this is a challenge for not only yourself, but for those around you," he said.

"The style in which the course is taught means the only way to succeed is through communicating with other people. Not only does the course provide the academic

challenge, but also one of teamwork and communication. To me that has been the most enjoyable thing."

Nine students from Priestley attend the Pembroke North sessions every Tuesday after college.

The unique humanities programme prepares them for the intensive learning required by competitive universities.

It includes support with applications, a study day and a residential at Pembroke College as well as a number of seminars in Manchester.

Megan Byrom, a former pupil at Hope Academy, now studies A-Levels in English Literature, Classical Civilisation, Geography and Politics at Priestley College.

She said: "As students in the north west, selective and competitive universities such as Oxford and Cambridge can feel like unrealistic goals.

"However the programme, along with the trip to Oxford, has helped us see these universities as places we can aspire to study in."

For former Cardinal Newman RC High School pupil Ewan Craven the Pembroke North programme has allowed him to develop valuable

skills such as critical reading.

"The academic literature that has been given to us is very challenging, but I have developed the skills needed to follow a difficult text and to critically analyse a hard piece of work," he said.

All the Priestley students also take part in the college's Graduate programme, which is designed to make them as competitive as possible when applying for top university places.

FORMER leisure centre manager Greg Snape has been presented with a special long service for lifeguard training and development.

Greg has received the silver bar to service medal and gold bar to service medal for over 30 years service to the royal lifesaving.

# Peel Hall campaigners team up with top planning consultant

**SAVE Peel Hall campaigners have teamed up with one of the region's top planning consultants who claims residents still have 'everything to play for' in the fight to protect the future of the last natural green space in north Warrington.**

Campaigners met up with Manchester-based Peter Black to dissect the council's controversial Local Plan.

The meeting was arranged by Winwick Parish Council and supported by Poulton-with-Fearnhead Parish Council following a request by campaigner Wendy Johnson-Taylor, who wanted to know what the future may hold for the 65-hectare site.

She said: "We had a very productive evening and the consensus was that we still have everything to play for and that the Local Plan needs to go back to the drawing board as there is a better plan out there that is simply being ignored. Our town deserves better than this."

Mr Black told Wendy "Warrington needs a different plan as urban sprawl has had its day. There is a different way of developing Warrington for the future in a more sustainable way. Warrington could become a much better place."

He urged Peel Hall residents to continue concentrating on key technical issues which have already scuppered previous applications submitted by landowners Satnam

Millennium Ltd.

Winwick Parish Council's vice chairman Mike Matthews urged residents to keep fighting "We must continue to challenge this plan. We have not lost a battle yet and our next committed battle will be to get Peel Hall removed from this plan so we can safeguard it for future generations."

## Catastrophic

Fellow campaigner Jim Sullivan added: "We have been fighting Satnam's plans for 30 years. These plans have failed because they would have a catastrophic impact on health, quality of life and traffic congestion. This is not the time to cave in – if anything those negative impacts are far worse now than they were three decades ago. We've still got everything to fight on for."

Meanwhile, Satnam is to go to the High Court a second time to appeal against the Secretary of State's decision to refuse planning consent for residential development at Peel Hall.

The hearing is due to start on July 16 and is listed for three days.

Tom's lecture at the Arley Garden Festival, tickets to which can be booked now, will focus on walled gardens.

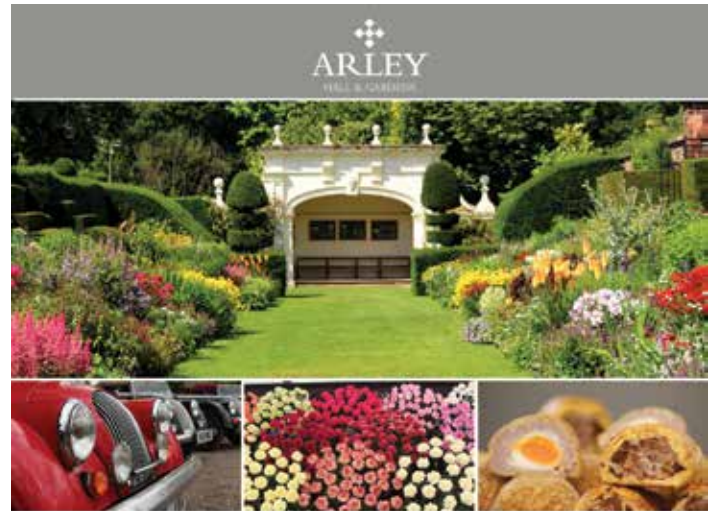
"I will be looking at examples as varied as an Islamic garden in the heart of Marrakech, the

## Financially yours

### Pension Credit

**Eligibility for Pension Credit has changed recently. If you are in a couple, one of whom is above pension age and the second of whom is a younger partner then you may be affected.**

Previously, Pension Credit was available to someone who had reached pension age and who met the income criteria even if their partner was below pension age. From 15th May both partners need to be above pension age before a claim can be made so that same person would be ineligible to claim Pension Credit.

Instead they would need to claim Universal Credit which would almost certainly result in a loss of income.

The income criteria for claiming Pension Credit is quite complex. Essentially, however, you may be eligible if your total weekly income is less than £200. If you think that you may be eligible then you should call the Pension Credit claim line on 0800 99 1234. You should have details of your income and savings, as well as your bank details. It is better to check your eligibility with them than to miss the opportunity to claim.

"But surely if the rules changed on 15th May then I am too late?", I can hear you ask. The answer is "No" provided that you act quickly enough. A claim for Pension Credit can be backdated 3 months. Therefore, provided you met all of the criteria on 15th May then you have until 15th August to make a claim. If you do so then ensure that you make it very clear that you are making a claim for Pension Credit rather than Universal Credit.

Talking of pension eligibility, a quick reminder to **younger couples with a child** that they should avoid losing pensions in the future. For several years now someone earning more than £50,000 would be subject to a **High Income Child Benefit Charge** if they or their partner claims and receives child benefit. To avoid this charge, and the resultant requirement to register for self-assessment, the government allows you to elect not to receive it.

**Some couples, however, are shortcutting this process by not claiming the benefit in the first place, which is not the same.** In order to receive a full state pension then you need to have a certain number of eligible NI contributions. If you claim the benefit and then elect not to receive it then the non-working partner will still receive notional NI contributions that will maintain their future pension eligibility. If you do not claim then that partner will not receive those notional contributions and may therefore only receive a lower pension in the future.

# Historic season to be proud of for Rylands FC

**The champagne corks were popping as the bubbly flowed at Gorse Lane on Easter Monday as Rylands FC crowned their first season playing at step 6 of the non-league football pyramid system by receiving the Hallmark Security League First Division South trophy.**

Rylands completed their historic season by capturing a second piece of silverware beating their North Division counterparts Longridge Town 3-0 to lift the First Division Champions Cup.

Having stepped up from the Cheshire Football League last summer, the club formed in 1911 topped the table seven points clear of their nearest rivals, having scored 111 goals and conceded just 27.

Joint manager Dave McNabb writing in the club's programme on Easter Monday said "The players have been fantastic all season and every one of them deserves the success we've achieved. To win this league in our first year as well as a Liverpool Senior Cup semi-final shows just how special this bunch of players really are."

The Blues title triumph attracted congratulations from some of the biggest names in the sport taking to twitter to offer words of support. England's all-time record goalscorer Wayne Rooney; now playing with DC United in America's Major League Soccer was quick to convey his congratulation as were current England stars Harry Maguire and Jack Butland were also in touch, as was England women's team captain Toni Duggan.

All four are represented by Paul Stretford, who is owner of the Rylands Recreation Club and through his company, Triple S Sports & Entertainment, is the major sponsor of the football club and has big plans for the club to move up the leagues.

A former player with the club in the 1970's, Stretford's ambitious plans for the club are for them to eventually play in the Football League, as well as developing a football academy to develop Warrington based players.

"Why not aim for the Football

League?" Said Stretford, "There's no point in setting a target we could achieve tomorrow. It might take 10 years, or 20. It might not happen in my lifetime. But you have to aim for the stars."

As a reference point as to where Rylands currently stand in the National Football League system, cross town rivals Warrington Town were champions at the same level in 2000/01, a season in which the division was dominated by Warrington teams with Tetley Walker finishing second. To reach the holy grail of the Football League Rylands would need to achieve five more promotions.

Reflecting on the most successful season in their 108 year history secretary Tony Bennett said: "It's an historic moment for Rylands Football Club. This is the proudest day in the club's history and also its most successful season. When we entered the league this year, our goal was to consolidate our position and plan to build on that over the next couple of seasons, what happened this year has accelerated those plans" adding "We will enjoy our success, but are already planning ahead for next year".

The planning includes further improvements to the ground which in the past few years has seen a stand erected at pitch side, hard standing, a covered standing enclosure built, pitch side changing rooms, new dug outs, snack shack opened and floodlights installed.

Top scorer Stuart Wellstead, who also doubles up as joint manager with McNabb, won the Hallmark Security League Premier Division title as a player twelve months ago so is ideally placed to assess his team's chances next season and where they need to strengthen the squad for what he acknowledges will be a much tougher league.





# Carden hoping to keep Warrington Town squad together

**WARRINGTON Town boss Paul Carden says he will be trying his best to keep his squad together for another tilt at promotion next season.**

The Yellows were cruelly denied promotion to National League North at the weekend, beaten 3-2 after extra-time by King's Lynn Town in the super play-off.

In any other year, winning the Northern Premier League play-offs would have been enough to go up, but due to a re-structuring of the football pyramid, an extra game was needed and that proved a hurdle too far.

Carden's men have finished in third in the table in each of the past two seasons, and last summer he had to virtually re-build his whole side due to a number of player departures, largely to teams in leagues above.

He said: "There will be a few vultures circling, as I would expect, because there's lad there who have had unbelievable seasons and are destined to go higher, so it'll be a

case of when they move and when they decide to move.

"The thing is we knew it before the start of the season so there's no point moaning about it.

"Any other year gone by and any other year going forward, you're promoted.

"It's just the way it seems to be, we've had to overcome another hurdle but we're back staying in our division next season unfortunately.

"I said to the lads we don't need to rip it up and start again. Looking at the side there I think Tony Gray was the only one to play in the play-offs last season, which tells you how well and strong the lads have done.

"We will try our best to keep as many of them to take us forward, and we will be trying to keep it together."
