

Coming home!!!

Lifestyle catches up with 80s Pop Icon Rick Astley ahead of his return to Haydock Park

lifestyle

L: You previously played Haydock Park in 2013, how does it feel to be returning to the racecourse to play live again?

R: Haydock is a stone's throw from where I grew up so it's always special to play there. I had my Mum on stage playing piano there once so I have great memories from past gigs there.

L: What can fans that have never seen you play live before expect from the show? Any surprises in store?

R: I obviously play my old hits and have fun doing it. The last couple of years have been amazing because of having some success with new material, so we play new songs and people don't all go to the loo!

I always like to do a cover or two because it reminds me of how I got started and it keeps the band on their toes.

L: Are you a big sports fan yourself?

R: I love football, Moto GP and F1, I guess I can watch any sport if it's of a good level.

L: Whilst at the races are you planning on making a day of it? Will you be placing any bets?

R I'm not a gambling man but... when in Rome!

L: You're also supporting Take That on their UK arena tour in April. How did that come about and what are you most looking forward to on the tour?

R: I've been lucky all my life and opening for Take That proves it. The guys are great and they always have an amazing show so it's awesome to be their guest.

L: Looks like you've got a busy summer this year as you've recently announced that you'll also be playing Isle of Wight Festival and Mouth of Tyne Festival. Are you excited to get back on the festival scene?

R: *Festivals are great, always fun to see how eclectic they are today.*

I did one in Japan a few years back that went from K Pop to Foo Fighters! Bonkers! **L:** Do you prefer these big shows in arenas/ sports grounds, or do you prefer the more intimate shows?

L: I like doing both small and big shows.

You can have moments in a small show where the interaction can even be one on one. The big shows have interaction on a different level but it's great to have both kinds of shows in my calendar and mix it up a little.

L: Do you take different approaches to one off event shows compared to tour preparation?

R: I treat performing the same way every time, I enjoy myself and I see it as my job to try and get any audience to enjoy it too.

When you are on tour the hotels and travel can get a bit 'Groundhog Day' but we never take that on stage with us, every show is a challenge to me to get people on side.

L: 'Never Gonna Give You Up' is such a great track that has really stood the test of time. How does it feel to have a song that is so universally recognised and loved, even in 2019? Has the song's success continued to surpass your initial expectations for the track?

R: No one could have seen what that song has become. It's strange to have a 30 odd year old tune still be my biggest song but I am grateful for it and it has become part of my DNA. It's like a suit of armour, I know where-ever we are in the world, people know that tune.

L: I think everyone on the Internet has been "Rick Rolled" at least once in their life. Does it feel bizarre to have become such a viral sensation?

R: What's Rick rolling ?????????

L: Last year's studio album 'Beautiful Life' was your fifth top ten album in the UK. Having reached such a large achievement in your career, what inspires you to keep making music and keeps you motivated for live shows?

R: I am lucky to be still singing to any audience so I never take it for granted. The fact that I have

L: Finally, after Haydock Park, what's your plan for the rest of 2019?

R: After Haydock Park I go to Spain and Hungary for a few shows, it's a Beautiful Life X See Rick Astley Live and take in some racing with the Jockey Club Live on July 20th.

The mere mention of the registration plate 77 RW is enough to set the pulse of any classic motoring enthusiast racing. The number can be found on the bonnet of an immaculate 1961 E type Jaguar open two-seater. But this is not just any É type. It's the original testbed vehicle that was historically driven through the night to the Geneva motor show that year where it caused a sensation. The E-type's looks were simply stunning while its performance was unbeatable. Today the car is on permanent loan to the Jaguar Daimler Heritage Trust thanks to the generosity of long-term owner Michael Kilgannon. Just occasionally 77 RW will



Having a special place is linked to higher happing

The National Trust has launched a new study which reveals that having a place that is special to you is linked to higher happiness and life satisfaction.

One of the case studies focused on Dunham Massey and the remarkable effects that a connection to this place had on one family.

The report highlights that on average, people with a connection to a special place in their lives (whether it's a place they escape for contemplation, a place of natural beauty or somewhere they go to remember a loved one), are happier, less lonely and more satisfied with life and relationships compared to those without a special place.

Additional research from the study includes:

• 63% of those with a place of importance are more likely to give both their time and money

•They feel stronger connections to others, report better levels of physical activity and awareness of emotions when compared to those without a 'special place'

• Almost 60% feel connected to a place outdoors

• 69% believe if their place were to disappear or change, they would be impacted negatively

Working with leading researchers, Walnut Unlimited, the National Trust has identified through qualitative and quantitative studies that having a special place enhances the Five Ways to Wellbeing, as recognised by The New Economics Foundation" Those with a special place are more likely to give both their time (63%) and money (63%) compared to those without a special place (55% and 53% respectively). The findings also reveal that having a special place affects levels of loneliness, with almost half (49%) of those without a special place stating they often feel lonely, compared to 45% of people with a connection to a place.

Furthermore, those with special places record higher levels of happiness and life satisfaction, stronger relationships with others, and better physical activity and awareness of emotions when compared those without a special place.

Christina Finlay, National Trust Director of Insight and Data, comments: "Our previous research from 2017 showed that places which are meaningful to us generate a significant response in the brain commonly associated with emotions. With our latest research we explored how this connection to place is intrinsically linked to heightened wellbeing, further unpacking how important places are to people.

"Our findings suggest that not only do people have specific positive emotional experiences when they visit favourite places, but these emotions permeate into their life back home or at work. So, whilst places that are important to us aren't the only factor in heightened wellbeing, the results explore how having somewhere that holds meaning in our lives contributes to higher levels of happiness and life satisfaction."

When it comes to the types of places that people feel strong connections to, 58% of people have stronger connections with the outdoors, including coastlines and beaches (23%), woodland and farms (10%) and mountains and hills (9%). This was followed by 23% having a connection with an urban location, including seaside towns and resorts (13%), and other towns and villages (4%).

82% of people, feel it is likely that their special place will always be there, and if it were to disappear or change, 69% say it would affect them in a negative way. This emphasises the important role organisations like the National Trust have in protecting special places forever, for everyone, and ensuring everyone can feel the benefits these places have to offer both now and in the future.

From their children's first steps to the encouraging cheers of onlookers as they learn to ride their bikes, Dunham Massey has been the backdrop for many significant family moments, something they hope will continue long into the future.

I recently had a trip to New York where everyone told me you must try the New York Cheesecake! Well I did and wasn't impressed so I've come up with this-Warrington Baked Cheesecake with salted Carmel topping!

Method

Grease 11 inch oven proof shallow dish Oven warming to gas 4 / electric 180

Base

Mix together and pat down in greased dish 1 pkt ginger nut biscuits crumbed 100g butter melted

Filling

Pkt soft cheese 200g Teaspoon vanilla essence 1 heaped teaspoon cornflour 150g Demerara sugar 400ml double cream 3 large eggs Beat well altogether

Pour over base and bake in oven low down for about hour. I would check after 40 min as different ovens will bake hotter. Take out when just a slight wobble as when it cools it sets.

Salted Caramel topping

200 g soft brown sugar or use granulated if no brown

50 g butter

1/2 teaspoon sea salt

Put all in pan heat slowly till it bubbles and sugar dissolves. Pour over cheesecake. Sprinkle with icing sugar. Try and let it cool and refrigerate before you go at it. It's very yummy with a few strawberries.

Loaded with calories but it's good a little at a time!
