



World famous car to make rare appearance at Historic Transport Day

THE word "iconic" has been much overused in recent years and been applied to everything from the Queen's hats to Donald Trump's hair!

But if the definition is "an item of distinctive excellence that symbolises a style or an era" then organisers of this years Lymm Historic Transport Day on June 23 have no hesitation in describing the star of this year's event as, truly iconic.

The mere mention of the registration plate 77 RW is enough to set the pulse of any classic motoring enthusiast racing. The number can be found on the bonnet of an immaculate 1961 E type Jaguar open two-seater. But this is not just any E type.

not just any E type.
It's the original testbed vehicle that was historically driven through the night to the Geneva motor show that year where it caused a sensation. The E-type's looks were simply stunning while its performance was unbeatable. So it was hardly surprising that the new model quickly became a glamorous symbol of the 1960s.

Today the car is on permanent loan to the Jaguar Daimler Heritage Trust thanks to the generosity of long-term owner Michael Kilgannon. Just occasionally 77 RW will grace a show or special event including, recently, Pippa Middleton's wedding. So organisers are enormously honoured to welcome

it to Lymm.

Thé appearance of this unique motor car was arranged via one of the Transport Day team – Philip Oldfield who can also be seen on the weekend of the event trundling up and down the field behind the line marker setting out the hundreds of "pitches" for visitors and exhibitors. Philip, who lives in Lymm judges at a number of car shows around the country and has been working in the background over a number of years to try and persuade the owners that Lymm would be a great place to show this unique car.

"Thanks to Phil and, of course, the owner this is another amazing coup for Lymm" said Event Director Alan Williams, "and is yet another step up for our event which just seems to keep going from strength to strength".

77 RW may be top of the bill but there are so many other reasons for making sure you don't miss this incredible event. As well as a fly past by an RAF Dakota (weather permitting) there will be hundreds of classic vehicles ranging from historic boats to traction engines, hickeles cars and militaria

Retired dentist bids to create new world record rowing Atlantic!

RETIRED Lymm dentist John Moorhouse is preparing to embark on his next adventure - bidding to break a new world record in the Talisker Whisky Atlantic Challenge!

John, who became the 37th person in the world to climb the seven highest summits in each seven highest summis in each continent and ski to both poles is now preparing for the annual Talisker Whisky Atlantic Challenge, of the continuous state of the continuous sta which departs the island of La Gomera in the Canaries to row 3,000 miles to Antigua on December 12.

Recently returning from two weeks of courses on Ocean rowing, navigation, first aid and radio communication, John will be taking part in the challenge as part of a team bidding to set a new world record.

Calling themselves the Ancient (www.ancientmariners. net) and with an average age of over 64 years they aim to set a new

world record as oldest team of 4 to

ovariated as states from 51 4 15 row across an ocean.

John said: "Many more people have climbed Everest than have rowed the Atlantic.

"We expect to take between 45 and 55 days subject to weather

and 55 days subject to weather that can range from mighty Atlantic gales to being becalmed.
"We will row a punishing schedule of two hours on and two hours off relentlessly around the clock. We will carry enough dehydrated meals and snacks

for 60 days and make our own drinking water."

The team is rowing for two charities - Blind Veterans in the UK and the Open Arms orphanage in Malawi where he used to live.

Meanwhile the team is actively

looking for sponsors.

John added: "Our boat is a blank canvas which will have massive media exposure. We are actively looking for sponsors to join us in showcasing local businesses.

Who pays inheritence tax?

Heather Lally, Associate Solicitor, Estate and Trust Practitioner and Associate member of Solicitors for the Elderly at FDR Law looks at the question, who pays inheritance tax?

Most people are aware that if you leave substantial assets to your beneficiaries on your death, that there may be inheritance tax to pay. However, with recent changes regarding owning a residence on your death and who it is left to, the inheritance tax position may not be clear to all.

The basics Individuals with assets valued at less than £325,000, generally there is no inheritance tax to pay.

Inheritance tax to pay.

If you leave all your assets to your
Spouse / Civil Partner, generally
there is no inheritance tax to pay.

If you have survived your Spouse

Civil Partner and they left all of

their assets to you and had not gifted assets / set up trusts which used up their entire inheritance tax (Nil Rate Band) allowance, a claim can be made to use their allowance also, so up to £650,000 can be

Now, if your assets comprise your residence and that residence is left to your direct descendants (including adopted, fostered and step-children), providing the property is valued at the Residence Nil Rate Band (currently £125,000 for tax year 2018/2019) or above, this additional allowance can be claimed against inheritance tax.

If your residence was passed



to you by your late Spouse / Civil Partner, a claim of up to £250,000can currently be made (using both persons' allowances). The Residence Nil Rate Band allowance is due to increase to £175,000 by 6 April 2020. At that time, up to £350,000 additional allowances can potentially be claimed by the estate of the surviving Spouse / Civil Partner, if the property is valued at that amount or more at that time.

Inheritance tax is normally charged at 40% over the Nil Rate Band and Residence Nil Rate Band allowances. Further reductions can be claimed for legacies and gifts to charity, if certain business assets agricultural assets are held or agricultural assets are held at death, along with gifts made from 3 years up to 7 years prior to death. However, estates valued at over £2 million, lose £1 of the Residence Nil Rate Band allowance for every £2 over £2 million.

Inheritance tax can be complex and each person's circumstances are different. If you are unsure as to whether your estate will pay inheritance tax, take advice and let


Plans are already in motion for next year's return visit in 2020, when English families will visit Meung. Please contact the society if you are interested in getting involved.
